#### **BEATHARD BARRELS IN**

- In Week 10 vs. NYG (11/12/17), QB C.J. Beathard scrambled for an 11-yd. TD run, registering 1 rushing TD in consecutive games [1 rushing TD vs. Arz. (11/5/17)]. He became the first 49ers QB to register consecutive games with 1-or-more rushing TDs since QB Colin Kaepernick in 2013.
- With 1 rushing TD this week vs. Sea., Beathard would become the first 49ers QB to register at least 1 rushing TD in three consecutive regular season games since QB Bob Waters accomplished the feat in 1961 [at Det. (10/1/61), vs. LAR (10/8/61) and at Min. (10/15/61)]. 49ERS OBS WITH



# **VOTING SEASON**

- Fans can vote to send their favorite 49ers to the 2018 Pro Bowl on Sunday, January 28, 2018 at Camping World Stadium in Orlando, Florida. For the first time, a new voting window will run for four weeks, which began on Tuesday, November 14 and concludes on Thursday, December 14. Voting is available online and on webenabled mobile phones by going to NFL.com/ProBowlVote.
- During the final week of 2018 Pro Bowl voting (December 7-14), fans will be able to vote directly on Twitter. Fans should tweet the first and last name of the player, or the player's official Twitter handle, along with the hashtag: #ProBowlVote.
- On Tuesday, it was announced that FB Kyle Juszczyk received the most votes among FBs in the NFL by fan vote.
