### **LOOKING AHEAD**


### With a Win vs. Seattle...

- The **49ers** would improve to 16-21 all-time against the Seahawks, including an 9-8 record at home.
- The Niners would split the season series with the Seahawks for the first time since 2013.
- **San Francisco** would win its 10th-straight regular season home finale. The team's current nine-game winning streak in home finales is the longest active streak in the NFL.


**Kerley** would set a new single season career high with his 4th TD recept. He has also set a career high in recepts. this season (58).

### FIND THE END ZONE IN THE RED ZONE

• The **49ers offense** has found the end zone 27 of 41 times (65.9%) when reaching the red zone this season, the 4th-best red zone touchdown efficiency in the NFL.

### **HIGHEST RED ZONE TD EFFICIENCY, 2016**



- **San Francisco's** current 65.9 red zone TD pct. is on pace to be the best registered by the team since 1994 (72.5% 50 of 69 trips), according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- The Niners have scored TDs on each of their last 7 trips to the red zone (5 passing & 2 rushing).
