LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win at Chicago...

- The **49ers** would improve to 34-30-1 all-time against the Bears, including a 12-17-1 record on the road.
- San Francisco would win four of the last five overall matchups against Chicago.
- The **Niners** would win at Chicago in consecutive regular seasons for the first time in the meetings between the two clubs.
- Chip Kelly would improve to 2-0 as a head coach against the Bears.

BROOKS LOOKS FOR 5.0

- Coming into the season, LB **Ahmad Brooks** was 1 of 8 players to record 5.0-or-more sacks in each of the past 7 seasons (2009-15).
- With 4.0 sacks in 2016, **Brooks** needs just 1.0 sack this week at Chi. to extend that streak to 8 consecutive seasons with 5.0-ormore sacks.

KAP GOES FOR 3 STRAIGHT

- After throwing 2 TDs vs. NE (11/20) and 3 TDs at Mia. (11/27), with 2-or-more TD passes this week at Chi., QB Colin Kaepernick would throw multiple TDs in three-consecutive games for the first time in his NFL ca-
- Over the past two weeks, **Kaepernick** has finished with passer ratings of 97.4 (vs. NE) and 94.1 (at Mia.). This week at Chi., he looks to reach a passer rating of 90-or-more in three consecutive games in a single regular season for the first time since doing so on 12/15/13 at TB (108.8), 12/23/13 vs. Atl. (108.6) and 12/29/13 at Arz. (111.2).
- Kaepernick's 373 rushing yds. in 7 games played (6 starts) this season are the 2nd-most in the NFL among QBs [Tyrod Taylor, Buf. -439 yds. (11 games)].
- In Kaepernick's 6 starts this season, he is averaging 62.2 rushing yds. per game, which leads the team over that timespan.
- In those 6 starts, Kaepernick has registered 23 rushing first downs, tied for the 11th-most in the NFL and tied for the

4th-most in the NFC over that timespan (Ezekiel Elliott, Dal. - 40; David Johnson, Arz. - 25; Jonathan Stewart, Car. - 25; Jordan Howard, Chi. - 23).

Last week at Mia. (11/27), **Kaepernick** became the 5th player since the NFL merger in 1970 to register 3 passing TDs and 100 yds. rushing in a single game.
