LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win vs. Arizona...

[1-3]

- The 49ers would improve to 30-20 all-time against the Cardinals, including an 18-9 record at home.
- **San Francisco** would move to 7-1 over their last 8 home games against Arizona.
- The **Niners** would improve to 15-4-1 at home against division opponents since 2010. The team's current .763 home winning pct. against division opponents is tied for the 4th-best in the NFL over that timespan.

• Head coach **Chip Kelly** would improve to 2-2 as a head coach against the Cardinals.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- Since moving into Levi's Stadium in 2014, the **49ers defense** has allowed 18.1 points per game, the 5th-fewest over that timespan (KC 15.7; NE 16.6; Sea. 17.0; Hou. 17.4).
- Opponents have converted 34.3% (80 of 233 atts.) of third downs at Levi's Stadium since 2014, the third lowest percentage in the NFL (Hou. - 30.5%; Det. - 32.9%).



- Since 2014, opponents are averaging 324.5 scrimmage yds. per game at Levi's Stadium, the 3rd-lowest in the NFL during that span (Sea. - 305.7; Den. - 306.1).
- Visiting teams at Levi's Stadium have thrown 21 passing TDs, tied for the 2nd-fewest in the NFL from 2014-16 (Sea. - 16; Car. - 21; Cin. - 21).

YDE PUTS UP POINT



- The **49ers** have 5 TD drives of 10-or-more plays this season, tied for the 2nd-most in the NFL this season (Dal. - 7; Pit. 5).
- This season, San Francisco's defense has registered 23 passes defensed, tied for the 5th-most in the NFL (SD - 29; LA - 29; KC - 27; Cin. - 25; Den. - 23).
- In his last meeting vs. Arz. (11/29/15), TE Vance McDonald caught 6 passes for 71 yds. and 1 TD.
- WR **Jeremy Kerley's** team-high 18 recepts. in the first 4 games of 2016 are the most to start a season in his career. Last week vs. Dal. (10/2/16), he registered 6 recepts. for 88 yds. and 1 TD. His 33-yd. TD recept. was the longest TD recept. of his NFL career.
