### LOOKING AHEAD

### With a Win at Seattle...

• **San Francisco** would move to 25-14-1 against NFC West opponents since 2009. The team's current .628 winning pct. is the highest within their own division during that timespan.

- The 49ers would improve to 16-19 all-time against the Seahawks, including a 8-11 record on the road.
- The Niners would split the season series with the Seahawks for the third time in the past four seasons.

### **GOLDEN NUGGETS**

- In three career games against the Seahawks, LB Aaron Lynch has registered 3.0 sacks, his most against any opponent. In their Week 7 matchup earlier this season, Lynch brought down Seahawks QB Russell Wilson twice on the night.
- With 6.0 sacks on the season, Lynch is one of three 49ers since 2000 to register 6-or-more sacks in each of their first two NFL seasons.
- According to TruMedia Statistics, LB NaVorro Bowman currently ranks first in the NFC with 88 tackles on the season while fellow LB Michael Wilhoite ranks 3rd with 72.
- WR Torrey Smith needs 23 rec. yds. against Sea. to reach 4,000 rec. yds. for his career.
- K Phil Dawson has made 14 consecutive field goals on the season. His 93.3 field goal percentage this year ranks t-9th in the NFL and 6th in the NFC. He has also made at least one FG in six consecutive games.

### ACKER AND BROCK ARE QUITE THE PAIR

Since 2009, the 49ers defense ranks tied for 5th in the NFL with 118 interceptions of opposing quarterbacks. In their last matchup against Seattle earlier this season, CBs **Kenneth Acker** and **Tramaine Brock** each intercepted Seahawks QB Russell Wilson. The pair have combined for six total INTs on the season, a mark that ranks tied for 5th in the NFL and tied for 3rd in the NFC this season among defensive backs.
