LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win vs. Green Bay...

- The 49ers would improve to 31-34-1 all-time against the Packers, including a 19-11-1 record at home.
- The Niners would win their fifth consecutive matchup between the two clubs. It would also mark the first time San Francisco has had a five-game winning streak against Green Bay since 12/8/56-12/7/58.

- The 49ers would move to 2-0 on the season against the NFC North, as the team defeated the Minnesota Vikings, 20-3, in the season opener on ESPN's Monday Night Football.
- QB Colin Kaepernick would improve to 4-0 as a starter against the Packers, including the postseason.

CAN'T HYDE HIM

Through the first three weeks of the 2015 season, RB Carlos Hyde ranks 3rd in the NFL with 262 rushing yds. (Adrian Peterson, Min. 291; Matt Forte, Chi. 276). Hyde currently leads the NFL with 16

rushing first downs.

- Hyde is one of just two RBs in the NFL with 250-or-more rushing yds. and two-or-more rushing TDs on the season (Adrian Peterson, Min. - 291 yds. & 2 TDs).
- Hyde's 4.85 rushing avg. ranks 2nd in the NFL (min. 50 atts.) (Adrian Peterson, Min. 4.93).

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Since 2011, WR Torrey Smith ranks 2nd in the NFL with a 16.9 rec. avg. (min. 200 recepts.).
- Since 1970, TE **Vernon Davis** has registered the most rec. TDs by a TE (7) against GB (including the postseason). He has a rec. TD in six of seven games played against the Packers.

- In his 49ers debut, WR Anquan Boldin registered 13 recepts. for 208 yds. and 1 TD vs. GB (9/8/13). His 208 rec. yds. set the 49ers franchise record for most rec. yds. on opening day. The previous mark of 169 rec. yds. was held by WR Jerry Rice [vs. LAA (9/5/94)].
- Since joining the 49ers in 2013, **Boldin** ranks 2nd in the NFL with 992 rec. yds. on 3rd down (Antonio Brown, Pit. -1,228).
- LB Aaron Lynch has registered 1.0 sack in five of his past six games at Levi's® Stadium.
- Since 2010, the **49ers** are 15-5 (.750 win pct.) in the month of October, ranking 3rd in the NFL during that timespan.

Green Bay Packers QB Aaron Rodgers on the 49ers defense...

"They've got a good mix of some veteran guys and some young guys, kind of up and coming. They've been able to push the pocket well and they're very stout against the run."

Green Bay Packers LB Clay Matthews On San Francisco 49ers QB Colin Kaepernick...

"He still has the same ability to escape the pass rush and extend plays. So, we're always mindful of that, especially in today's day of age in which quarterbacks are very good at extending plays and picking up the first down. It's just something we have to be mindful of as a pass rush."

Green Bay Packers WR James Jones on the 49ers...

"That's a good ball club over there. A lot of talented players. I know they're coming off a game where they feel they didn't play that well. So, they're going to come in with a chip on their shoulder, in their home stadium and try to give us a knockout blow."
