BUCKNER'S BID

Through the first 12 weeks of the season, DT **DeForest Buckner** has registered a career-high 7.0 sacks, ranking t-2nd in the NFL among DTs (Aaron Donald, LAR – 14.5; Geno Atkins, Cin. – 7.0; Sheldon Rankins, NO – 7.0).

• His 7.0 sacks are the most by a member of the 49ers in a single season since 2013 (LB Ahmad Brooks & LB Aldon Smith - 8.5 sacks).

• After picking up 1.0 sack vs. Oak. (11/1/18), 0.5 sack vs. NYG (11/12/18) and 1.0 sack at TB (11/25/18), Buckner has registered at least 0.5 sack in three-consecutive games for the first time in his career.

• With at least 0.5 sack this week at Sea. (12/2/18), Buckner would become the first member of the 49ers to register at least 0.5 sack in four-consecutive games since LB Aldon Smith accomplished the feat in Weeks 7-14 of the 2012 season.

RB **Matt Breida** has registered 10 rushes that have gone for 20-or-more yds., tied for the most in the NFL this season (Saquon Barkley, NYG – 10).

After registering 101 rushing yds. vs. NYG (11/12/18) and 106 rushing yds. at TB (11/25/18), **Breida** can become the first member of the 49ers with at least three-consecutive games with 100-or-more rushing yds. since RB Frank Gore accomplished the feat in Weeks 4-9 of the 2011 season.

LB **Fred Warner** has racked up 83 tackles this season, ranking 17th in the NFL, 10th in the NFC and 4th among all rookies.

With 1 PD in each of the past 3 games, **Warner** can become the first

member of the 49ers to register four-consecutive games with at least 1 PD since LB Patrick Willis in Weeks 3-6 of the 2011 season.

When updated Pro Bowl voting by fans were announced on November 21, FB **Kyle Juszczyk** was the leading FB in the NFC, while LB **Mark Nzeocha** was the leading vote-getter among NFC special teams players.

TE **George Kittle's** 823 rec. yds. on the season are the most by a 49ers TE in a single season since TE Vernon Davis in 2013 (850 rec. yds.).
