San Francisco 49ers at Arizona Cardinals Thursday, October 31, 2019

With the win...

- The **Niners** improved to 8-0 for the first time since 1990 and the 2nd time in franchise history.
- The **49ers** start the season with 5 consecutive road wins for the 5th time in franchise history and the first time since the 1990 season.

- **San Francisco's** 5 consecutive road wins are the most in a single season since the 1994 season.
- The **Niners** are now 2-0 this season against the NFC West.
- The **49ers** improved to 30-26 overall against the Cardinals, including a 13-14 record on the road.
- The **49ers** have won their *Thursday Night Football* game in back-to-back seasons [W, 34-3 vs. Oak. (11/1/18)].

Keep It Rollin'

- The **49ers offense** converted on 11 of 17 3rd down atts. (64.7 pct.), the highest conversion rate by the 49ers since 12/24/17 vs. Jax. (66.7 pct.).

Four Score And 300 Yards Ago

- QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** connected on 28 of 37 atts. for 317 yds., a career-high 4 TDs and a career-high passer rating of 136.9.
- It marks his 3rd career game with 300-or-more passing yds. and first since 12/17/17 vs. Ten. (381 yds.).
- **Garoppolo's** 4 TD passes are the most by a member of the 49ers since QB Colin Kaepernick had 4 passing TDs at NE (12/16/12).
- He now has 13 passing TDs on the season and 30 in his career.
- **Garoppolo** is now 16-2 as a starter. His 16 wins in his first 18 starts are tied for the 3rd-most by a QB through 18 career starts since 1950 (Daryle Lamonica – 17; Ben Roethlisberger – 17; Dan Marino – 16; Roger Staubach – 16).

Sanders Shines Bright

- WR **Emmanuel Sanders** hauled in 7 receipts. for 112 yds. and 1 TD, marking his 20th career 100-yd. game.
- He has now registered 1 TD receipt. in each game he's played with the 49ers. It marks the first time he registered 1 TD receipt. in back-to-back games since 10/14/18 vs. LAR & 10/18/18 at Arz., as a member of the Denver Broncos.
- **Sanders** is the first member of the 49ers with at least 1 TD receipt. in consecutive games since WR Dante Pettis 12/2/18 at Sea. (2 TDs) & 12/9/18 vs. Den. (1 TD).

George of the Jungle

- TE **George Kittle** finished the game with 6 receipts. for 79 yds. and 1 TD. His 30-yd. TD receipt. was the 2nd of the season and 9th of his career.

Bourne To Be Wild

- WR **Kendrick Bourne** saw his only catch of the game go for a 7-yd. TD, his 1st of the season and 5th of his career.

Pettis' Thriller

- WR **Dante Pettis** also saw his only catch of the game go for a 21-yd. TD, his 2nd of the season and 7th of his career.

It's One, Two, Three Sacks You're Out

- The **49ers defense** registered 3.0 sacks on the night.
- With 3.0 total sacks on the night, the **49ers defense** has registered at least 3.0-or-more sacks in 5-consecutive games [4.0 vs. Cle. (10/7/19), 4.0 at LAR (10/13/19), 3.0 at Was. (10/20/19), 7.0 vs. Car. (10/27/19) & 3.0 at Arz. (10/31/19)]. The last time San Francisco registered 3.0-or-more sacks in 5-or-more games since Weeks 9-13 of the 1997 season [4.0 at NO (10/26/97), 4.0 vs. Dal. (11/2/97), 8.0 at Phi. (11/10/97), 3.0 vs. Car. (11/16/97) & 4.0 vs. SD (11/23/97)].

Fright Night DeForest

- DL **DeForest Buckner** also sacked Murray, marking his 4th sack of the season and 25.0 for his career.

Dee-Fense

- DL **Dee Ford** brought down Cardinals QB Kyler Murray for a 12-yd. loss. He now has 5.5 sacks on the season and 36.0 for his career.

Don't Forget About Dre

- LB **Dre Greenlaw** sacked Murray for a 19-yd. loss, marking his 1st career sack.
