- According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first WR in franchise history to have 3-or-more rushing TDs in a single season. He is the first WR to have 3-or-more rushing TDs in a single season in the NFL since 2016 (WR Tyreek Hill, KC – 3 rushing TDs & WR Ty Montgomery, GB – 3 rushing TDs).
- Samuel is the 2nd player in NFL history to record 4,000-or-more rec. yds. and 1,000-or-more rushing yds. in the first 5 seasons of his career (HOF WR Charley Taylor, Was.).

2025 (WASHINGTON)

- Appeared in 16 games (12 starts) and registered 72 receipts. for 727 yds. and 5 TDs to go along with 17 carries for 75 yds. and 1 TD.
- Registered 7 receipts. for 77 yds. and took his 1 carry 19 yds. for a TD vs. NYG (9/7).
- Registered 8 receipts. for 96 yds. at LAC (10/5).

2024 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Started in 15 games and registered 51 receipts. for 670 yds. and 3 TDs to go along with 42 carries for 136 yds. and 1 TD.
- Registered 8 carries for 23 yds. and 1 TD vs. NYJ (9/9). The rushing TD marked the 20th of his career, which is the most by a WR in franchise history and the most by any player whose primary position is WR since at least 1960.
- Registered 3 receipts. for a team-high 102 yds. and 1 TD vs. Sea. (10/10). His rec. TD marked his first of the season and the 20th of his career. With 1 rec. TD, Samuel Sr. became the only WR in NFL history to register 20 rec. TDs and 20 rushing TDs in his career.
- Registered 7 receipts. for 96 yds. and 1 TD through the air to go along with 5 carries for 25 yds. on the ground at Mia. (12/22). His TD receipt. marked his 2nd of the season and the 21st of his career.

2023 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Started in 15 games and registered 60 receipts. for 892 yds. and 7 TDs to go along with 37 carries for 225 yds. and 5 TDs. Also started in all 3 postseason contests and recorded 13 receipts. for 146 yds. to pair with 6 carries for 15 yds.
- Registered 6 receipts. for 63 yds. to go along with 5 carries for 38 yds. and 1 TD on the ground at LAR (9/17).
- Tallied 6 receipts. for 129 yds. and 1 TD vs. NYG (9/21).
- Caught 4 passes for 30 yds. through the air to go along with 3 carries for 29 yds. and 1 TD on the ground at Jax. (11/12).
- Hauled in 3 receipts. for 63 yds. vs. TB (11/19).
- With 3 receipts. vs. TB (11/19), Samuel reached 250 receipts. in his career. His 250 receipts. in 59 career games tie him with WR Dwight Clark for the 3rd-fewest amount of games to reach 250 career receipts. for a WR in 49ers franchise history.

- Tallied 7 receipts. for 79 yds. through the air to go along with 4 carries for 15 yds. and 1 TD on the ground at Sea. (11/23).
- Hauled in 4 receipts. for 116 yds. and 2 TDs through the air to go along with 3 carries for 22 yds. and 1 TD on the ground at Phi. (12/3).

2023 (CONTINUED)

- With 1 rush TD at Sea. (11/23) and 1 rush TD at Phi. (12/3), it marked the first time Samuel has registered 1-or-more rushing TDs in consecutive games since 2021 [1 rush TD at Cin. (12/12/21); 1 rush TD vs. Atl. (12/19/21)].
- Samuel's 2 rec. TDs and 1 rush TD at Phi. (12/3) made him the 4th WR since 2000 with 100-or-more rec. yds., 2-or-more rec. TDs and 1-or-more rush TDs in a single game [WR Chase Claypool, Mia. (10/11/20); WR David Patten, NE (10/21/01); WR Javon Walker, Den. (11/5/06)].
- His 3 total TDs at Phi. (12/3) marked a career high.
- Hauled in 7 receipts. for 149 yds. and 1 TD through the air to go along with 1 carry for 1 TD on the ground vs. Sea. (12/10).
- With 116 rec. yds. at Phi. (12/3) and 149 rec. yds. vs. Sea. (12/10), it marked the 3rd time in Samuel's career that he has registered 100-or-more rec. yds. in back-to-back games and the first time he's accomplished the feat since 2021 [100 rec. yds. vs. Ind. (10/24/21); 171 rec. yds. at Chi. (10/31/21)].
- With 2 rec. TDs at Phi. (12/3) and 1 rec. TD vs. Sea. (12/10), it marked the 3rd time in Samuel's career that he has registered 1-or-more rec. TD in back-to-back games.
- With 116 rec. yds., 2 rec. TDs and 1 rushing TD at Phi. (12/3) and 149 rec. yds., 1 rec. TD and 1 rushing TD vs. Sea. (12/10), Samuel became just the 2nd player in NFL history to register 100-or-more rec. yds., 1-or-more rec. TD and 1-or-more rush TD in back-to-back games (RB Timmy Brown, Phi. – 1960).
- With 1 rush TD and 1 rec. TD vs. Sea. (12/10), it marked Samuel's 3rd career game with 1-or-more rush TD and 1-or-more rec. TD, which is tied for the 4th-most such games in franchise history.
- Notched 4 receipts. for 48 yds. and 2 TDs at Arz. (12/17). His rec. TD marked his 6th of the season and the 18th of his career.
- With 2 rec. TDs at Phi. (12/3), 1 rec. TD vs. Sea. (12/10) and 2 rec. TDs at Arz. (12/17), it marked the first time in Samuel's career that he has registered 1-or-more rec. TDs in 3-consecutive games.
- Registered 5 receipts. for 37 yds. and 1 TD through the air to go along with 3 carries for 35 yds. on the ground at Was. (12/31). His receiving TD marked his 7th of the season and the 19th of his career.
- Registered 2 receipts. for 21 yds. through the air to go along with 1 carry for 11 yds. on the ground vs. LAR (1/7/24).
- Registered a playoff career-high 8 receipts. for a team-high 89 yds. vs. Det. (1/28/24).

2022 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Appeared in 13 games (12 starts) and registered 56 receipts. for 632 yds. and 2 TDs to pair with 42 carries for 232 yds. and 3 TDs. Also started all 3 postseason games where he posted 13 receipts. for 211 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 13 carries for 34 yds.
- Registered 2 receipts. for 14 yds. to go along with 8 carries for 52 yds. and 1 TD at Chi. (9/11). With 52 rushing yds. on the day, it marked the 3rd time in his career that he has registered 50-or-more rushing yds. in a game [79 yds. at Jax. (11/21/21) & 66 yds. vs. Min. (11/28/21)].
- Registered 5 receipts. for 44 yds. to go along with 4 carries for 53 yds. vs. Sea. (9/18), including a career-long 51-yd. run in the 1st qtr.
- Registered 6 receipts. for 115 yds. vs. LAR (10/3), including a 57-yd. TD receipt. It marked his first TD receipt. of the season and the 11th of his career. With 115 rec. yds., Samuel has registered 100-or-more rec. yds. in a single game for the first time on the season and the 10th time in his career.
- Registered 2 receipts. for 20 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 2 carries for 12 yds. at Car. (10/9). The TD receipt. marked his 2nd of the season and the 12th of his career.
- Registered 5 receipts. for 42 yds. vs. KC (10/23). Along with WR Brandon Aiyuk and TE George Kittle, hauled in 5-or-more receipts. for the 2nd-consecutive week [8 receipts. at Atl. (10/16/22)], marking the first time since 2009 that a trio of 49ers each registered 5-or-more receipts. in back-to-back weeks.
- Tallied 2 receipts. for 24 yds. to go along with 4 carries for 27 yds vs. LAC (11/13).
- With 2 receipts., registered his 200th career receipt. in the 3rd-fewest amount of games by a member of the 49ers dating back to 1970 [TE George Kittle – 43 games & WR Jerry Rice – 44 games].
- With 24 yds., registered 3,000 career rec. yds. In just 46 career games, he registered 3,000 career rec. yds. in the 3rd-fewest amount of games by a member of the 49ers dating back to 1970 [WR Jerry Rice – 38 games & WR Vic Washington – 44 games].
- Registered 7 receipts. for 57 yds. to go along with 3 carries for 37 yds. and 1 TD at Arz. (11/21). His 39-yd. run marked the longest TD rush of his career.
- Registered 4 receipts. for 43 yds. to go along with 4 carries for 21 yds. and 1 TD vs. TB (12/11). The rushing TD marked his 3rd of the season and the 14th of his career. With 3 rushing TDs in 2022, rushed for 3-or-more TDs in 3 out of his 4 seasons in the NFL. Became 1 of 3 wide receivers in NFL history to rush for 3-or-more TDs in 3 different seasons and the first to do so since 1966 [WR Bobby Mitchell, Cle. (1959-61) and WR Charley Taylor, Was. (1964-66)].
- Registered 6 receipts. for 133 yds., including a 74-yd. receipt., and 1 TD as well as 3 carries for 32 yds. on the ground vs. Sea. (1/14/23 - NFC-WC). His 74-yd. receipt. was the 2nd longest in franchise postseason history and the longest since 1/5/03.
- With 133 rec. yds., registered 100-or-more rec. yds. in a postseason game for the first time in his career. He is the first member of the 49ers to do so since WR Anquan Boldin [136 yds. at Car. (1/12/14)].

2021 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Appeared in 16 games (15 starts) and registered 77 receipts. for 1,405 yds. and 6 TDs to go along with 59 rushes for 365 yds. and 8 TDs. Also started all 3 postseason games where he hauled in 10 receipts. for 154 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 27 carries for 137 yds. and 1 TD.
- Registered 9 receipts. for 189 yds. and 1 TD in the season opener at Det. (9/12). The 189 yds. are a career-high and the most by a member of the 49ers since TE George Kittle had 210 yds. vs. Den. (12/9/18).
- Registered 8 receipts. for 156 yds. and 2 TDs vs. Sea (10/3), marking his 1st career game with 2 TD receipts.
- Registered 100-or-more rec. yds. in each of the 3 career games he played against Sea. Through the first four games of the season, Samuel led the NFL with 490 rec. yds. which are the 2nd-most through four games in franchise history (WR Jerry Rice – 522 rec. yds. in 1995) and the most through four games in the NFL since 2018 (WR Julio Jones – 502 rec. yds. in 2018).
- Registered 3 receipts. for 58 yds. while adding 1 carry for 13 yds. and 1 TD at Arz. (10/10).
- Had 7 receipts. for 100 yds. and 1 TD vs. Ind. (10/24).
- Registered 6 receipts. for 171 yds. at Chi (10/31).
- Became the first member of the 49ers with at least 100 rec. yds. in consecutive games since he accomplished the feat in Weeks 10 & 11 of 2019. Had receipts. of 50 and 83 yds. on the day, becoming the first member of the 49ers with multiple receipts. of 50-or-more yds. in a game since TE George Kittle [52 & 85 yds. vs. Den. (12/9/18)]. The 83-yd. receipt. was a career-long. It also marked his 3rd game of the season with 150 rec. yds. [189 at Det. (9/12/21) & 156 at Sea. (10/3/21)], becoming the first member of the 49ers with 3-or-more games with 150-plus rec. yds. since WR Terrell Owens (2002).
- Hauled in 5 receipts. for 97 yds. and 1 TD vs. LAR (11/15), while adding 5 carries for 36 yds. and 1 TD on the ground. It marked the first time in his career that he had 1 rec. TD and 1 rush TD in the same game.
- Hauled in 1 receipt. for 15 yds., while adding 7 carries for a careerhigh 79 yds. and 1 TD on the ground at Jax. (11/21).
- Registered 1 rushing TD in back-to-back games for the 2nd time in his career [vs. LAR (12/21/19) & at Sea. (12/29/19)].
- His 79 rushing yds. were the most by a 49ers WR in a single game since 1960.
- Combined with his 3 rushing TDs as a rookie in 2019, Samuel is the 2nd WR ever with 3-or-more rushing TDs in 2 of his first 3 seasons in the Super Bowl Era, according to The Elias Sports Bureau [Frank Jackson (1961-62)].
- Hauled in 1 receipt. for 12 yds., while adding 6 carries for 66 yds. and 2 TDs on the ground vs. Min. (11/28). His 2 rushing TDs are the most in a single game by a 49ers WR in franchise history and the most by a WR in the NFL since Packers WR Ty Montgomery had 2 rushing TDs at Chi. (12/18/16).
- With 1,006 rec. yds. through Week 12, he became 1 of 4 players in franchise history to surpass 1,000 rec. yds. through the team's first 11 games of a season (WR Jerry Rice - 6 times; WR Terrell Owens - 2 times; WR Dave Parks – 1 time). Also became the first WR for the 49ers to reach 1,000 rec. yds. in a single season since Anquan Boldin had 1,062 rec. yds. in 2014.
- Hauled in 1 receipt. for 22 yds. at Cin. (12/12), while adding 8 carries for 37 yds. and 1 TD on the ground.

2021 (CONTINUED)

- Hauled in 4 receipts. for 60 yds., while adding 6 carries for 29 yds. and 1 TD on the ground vs. Atl. (12/19).
- Registered at least 1 rushing TD in 5-consecutive games for the 1st time in his career. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first WR with at least 1 rushing TD in 5-consecutive games in a season since the merger in 1970. Also became the first member of the 49ers with at least 1 rushing TD in 5-consecutive games played since RB Raheem Mostert accomplished the feat in Weeks 12-17 of 2019.
- Hauled in 9 receipts. for 159 yds. at Ten. (12/23), while adding 5 carries for 32 yds. With 159 rec. yds., it marked his 4th game on the season he's accumulated 150-or-more yds. in a single game, which leads the NFL and is the most by a member of the 49ers since WR Jerry Rice had 5 games with 150-or-more rec. yds. in 1995. He and Rice (5 games in 1995, 4 games in 1986) are the only two 49ers to accomplish the feat.
- Hauled in 3 receipts. for 63 yds. and 1 TD vs. Hou. (1/2/22), while adding 7 carries for 19 yds. He has also amassed 1,630 yds. from scrimmage (1,310 rec. yds. & 320 rushing yds.), which is 9th-most in a single-season in franchise history and the most since RB Frank Gore notched a franchise-record 2,180 yds. from scrimmage (1,695 rushing yds. & 485 rec. yds.) in 2006.
- Hauled in 4 receipts. for 95 yds at LAR (1/9/22), also added 8 carries for 45 yds. and 1 TD on the ground and threw a 24-yd. TD pass to WR Jauan Jennings. His 8 rushing TDs on the season were the most in a single season by a WR in NFL history.
- The 24-yd. TD pass was the first by the 49ers by a non-QB since WR Emmanuel Sanders threw a 35-yd. TD pass at NO (12/8/19). He became the first non-QB in franchise history to have at least 1 passing TD and at least 1 rushing TD in a game.
- Also finished the regular season with 14 total TDs (6 rec. & 8 rushing), the most by a member of the 49ers since WR Terrell Owens had 14 total TDs in 2002 (13 rec. TDs & 1 rushing TD).
- Hauled in 3 receipts. for 38 yds at Dal. (1/16/22 - NFC-WC). He also added 10 carries for 72 yds. and 1 TD on the ground. His 26-yd. TD run was the first postseason rushing TD of his career, while his 72 rushing yds. are the most by a WR in a postseason game in NFL History and gives him 2 of the 3 games with the most rushing yds. by a WR in a postseason game.
- Registered 4 receipts. for a postseason career-high 72 yds. and 1 TD at LAR (1/30/22 - NFC-C), including a postseason career long 44-yd. TD receipt. He also added 7 rushing atts. for 26 yds. on the ground, which made him the first member of the 49ers to lead the team in both rushing and receiving yds. in a postseason game since RB Ricky Watters did so 1/15/94 vs. NYG (NFC-D).

2020 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Appeared in 7 games (5 starts) and recorded 33 receipts. for 391 yds. and 1 TD.
- Found the endzone on the first drive of the game vs. LAR (10/18), his 1st TD of the season and 4th rec. TD of his career. Finished the game with 6 receipts. for 66 yds. and 1 TD.
- Finished the game at LAR (11/29) with a career-high 11 receipts. for 133 yds., marking his 1st 100-yd. game of the season and 4th of his career.

2019 (SAN FRANCISCO)

- Played in 15 games (11 starts) and registered 57 receipts. for 802 yds. and 3 TDs as a rookie. Also added 14 carries for 159 yds. and 3 TDs. Also started all 3 postseason games and had 10 receipts. for 127 yds. as well as 6 carries for 102 yds.
- With 802 rec. yds. in the 2019 season, he became 2nd all-time for most receiving yards by a rookie in franchise history.
- His 57 receipts. finished 2nd all-time for most receipts. by a rookie in franchise history.
- Connected with QB Jimmy Garoppolo on a 2-pt. conversion at TB (9/8).
- His first career TD receipt. came on a 3-yd. pass from QB Jimmy Garoppolo at Cin. (9/15). Finished the game with 5 receipts. for 87 yds. and 1 TD.
- Registered a 20-yd. TD run vs. Car. (10/27), the 1st rushing TD of his career. He also added 3 receipts. for 19 yds.
- Recorded 8 receipts. for a then career-high 112 yds. vs. Sea. (11/11). It marked his first career 100-yd. game and the first 100-yd. receiving game by a 49ers rookie since WR Dante Pettis registered 5 receipts. for 129 yds. and 2 TDs at Sea. (12/2/18). His 8 receipts. are tied for the 4th-most by a rookie in a game in franchise history.
- Hauled in 8 receipts. for a career-high 134 yds. vs. Arz. (11/17/19). Along with his 8 receipts. for 112 yds. the week prior vs. Sea. (11/11), he became the first rookie in franchise history to register at least 8 receipts. and 100 rec. yds. in consecutive games. The last rookie in the NFL to accomplish the feat was WR Odell Beckham Jr. in 4 consecutive weeks from 12/7/14 through 12/28/14.
- His 134 rec. yds. versus the Cardinals were the most by a 49ers rookie since WR Dante Pettis registered 129 rec. yds. at Sea. (12/2/18), and ranks 3rd in franchise history.

- Recorded 2 receipts. for 41 yds. and 1 TD at Bal. (12/1). Including his TD receipt. vs. GB (11/24), registered one TD receipt. in consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- Recorded his 2nd rushing TD of the season on a 19-yd. TD run vs. LAR (12/21).
- Registered 5 receipts. for 102 yds. and had 2 carries for 33 yds. and 1 TD at Sea. (12/29). Registered 3 games with 100-or-more rec. yds. on the season. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, his 3 games with 100-or-more rec. yds. are the most in a single season by a rookie in franchise history. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first WR in franchise history to have 3-or-more rushing TDs in a single season. He was the first WR to have 3-or-more rushing TDs in a single season in the NFL since 2016 (WR Tyreek Hill, KC – 3 rushing TDs & WR Ty Montgomery, GB – 3 rushing TDs).
- Registered 5 receipts. for 39 yds. to go along with 3 carries for 53 yds. at KC (2/2/20 - SB). His 53 rushing yds. were the most by a WR in a Super Bowl while his 32-yd. run is the longest run by a WR in a Super Bowl.



COLLEGE

Appeared in 30 games (27 starts) in five years at South Carolina (2014-18) and registered 148 receptions for 2,076 yds. and 16 TDs. As a kick returner, recorded 42 returns for 1,219 yds. (29.0 avg.) and 4 TDs. Also, notched 25 rushing attempts for 154 yds. and 7 rushing TDs and converted both passing attempts in his career for TDs. As a senior in 2018, earned First-Team All-SEC honors after hauling in 62 receptions for 882 yds. and 11 TDs in 12 games (11 starts). Also added 23 KORs for 570 yds. (24.8 avg.) and 1 TD, earning Second-Team All-America honors by the Football Writers Association of America. Started all 3 games he appeared in 2017 and recorded 15 receptions for 250 yds. and 3 TDs. As a sophomore in 2016, started all 10 games in which he appeared in and tallied 59 receptions for 783 yds. and 1 TD, while adding 15 carries for 98 yds. and 6 TDs. Appeared in 5 games (3 starts) as a redshirt freshman and had 12 receptions for 161 yds. and 1 TD. Redshirted as a freshman in 2014.
