CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2018, became the first NFL rookie since 2000 to begin his career with 4 consecutive games of at least 10 tackles, according to Gamebook Statistics.
- Finished the 2024 season with 131 tackles. Joins Baltimore Ravens LB Roquan Smith and Washington Commanders LB Bobby Wagner as the only players to register 130-or-more tackles in each of the last 4 seasons (2021-24).
- Registered 115-or-more tackles in each of his first 7 NFL seasons (2018-24), joining Baltimore Ravens LB Roquan Smith as the only players since at least 2000 to register 115-or-more tackles in each of their first 7 NFL seasons.
- With 10.0 sacks and 10 INTs in his career, joins former LB Keena Turner (11 INTs & 19.5 sacks) as the only other player in franchise history to register 10.0-or-more sacks and 10-or-more INTs in a career.
- Ranks t-1st in passes defended among LBs in franchise history.

WARNER'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- In 2020, was the recipient of the 49ers Len Eshmont Award, which is voted on by the players and is given to the 49er who best exemplifies the inspirational and courageous play of Len Eshmont, an original member of the 1946 49ers team.
- Has twice been named the recipient of the team's Bill Walsh Award (2022 & 2024), which was established in 2004 in honor of San Francisco's Hall of Fame Head Coach. The award, which is voted on by the coaching staff, is given to the 49er who has best represented the standard of professional excellence established by Walsh.
- Caught the attention of BYU coaches after a die-hard BYU fan and family friend sent Warner's highlight tape to the coaches and was later offered a scholarship.
- At BYU, was roommates with his younger brother Troy, who played cornerback for the Cougars and spent time with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers as a free agent in 2021.

GOLDMINE

- During the 2022 offseason, Warner and his fellow linebackers, were invited to throw out the first pitch at a San Francisco Giants game. The trio took a few swings at batting practice and mingled with Giants players prior to throwing out ceremonial first pitches and cheering on the hometown team.



GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

- NFL players had the opportunity to participate in the NFL's annual My Cause, My Cleats campaign during the 2019 season. Warner and his teammates represented their respective causes with custom-designed cleats in an effort to raise awareness and funding. Warner represented Cancer CAREPOINT and said, "I play to honor my grandmother who passed from breast cancer."



- The 49ers hosted the third annual Crucial Catch Fashion Show presented by Dignity Health in October of 2019, featuring cancer warriors representing all cancers as they modeled apparel donated by Levi's. Warner and his teammates were paired with each of the warriors to share their stories of strength and courage with the audience and walk the runway.



- In October of 2019, Warner teamed up with the St. Baldrick's Foundation, a volunteer-powered charity that funds childhood cancer research grants. During the fundraiser, they assisted in shaving the heads of volunteers as a symbol of support of the cancer warriors.

- Warner credits his mother, Laura, as the number one influence in his life. He notes that his mother raised him and his siblings all by herself while making sacrifices along the way. "She taught all of us about hard work," Warner said. On draft day, Laura was by Fred's side as he was selected by the 49ers in the third round. "She was right next to me," he said. "She got the first hug."

2024

- Started all 17 games and registered 131 tackles, 1.0 sack, 7 PDs, 2 INTs (1 returned for a TD) and 4 FFs.
- Registered 7 tackles and 1 FF vs. NYJ (9/9). The FF marked his first of the season and the 12th of his career. With 1 FF, he has surpassed former LB Ahmad Brooks for the 2nd-most FFs in franchise history.
- Tallied 9 tackles, 1.0 sack, 2 PDs, 1 INT of Vikings QB Sam Darnold, and a career-high 2 FFs at Min. (9/15). The FFs marked the 14th of his career.
- Registered 7 tackles, 1 PD and 1 INT, which he returned 45 yds. for a TD vs. NE (9/29). His INT marked his second of the season and the 10th of his career. With 10 career INTs, became the second player in franchise history to register 10-or-more INTs and 10.0-or-more sacks in a career, joining former LB Keena Turner (11 INTs & 19.5 sacks).
- Registered a season-high 12 tackles vs. Arz. (10/6).
- Registered a team-high 11 tackles, 1 PD and 1 FF at Sea. (10/10). The FF marked the 15th of his career, the 2nd-most in franchise history.
- Registered a team-high 8 tackles and 1 PD vs. Dal. (10/27). His PD gave him 52 in his career, which is the 2nd-most by an LB in franchise history.

2023

- Started all 17 games where he posted 132 tackles, 11 PDs, 2.5 sacks, 4 INTs and 4 FFs. Also started all 3 postseason games and added 33 tackles and 1 PD.
- Notched 11 tackles and 1.0 sack of Rams QB Matthew Stafford at LAR (9/17), giving him his 1st sack of the season and 7.5 in his career.
- Notched 8 tackles, 1.0 sack, 1 FF and 1 INT of Cowboys QB Dak Prescott vs. Dal. (10/8).
- Became the first 49ers player to register 1.0-or-more sacks, 1-or-more FFs and 1-or-more INTs in a single game since LB NaVorro Bowman did so in 2013 [1.0 sack, 1 FF, 1 INT at Arz. (12/29/13)].
- Tallied 7 tackles and 1 INT of Cleveland Browns QB P.J. Walker (10/15).
- With 1 INT the previous week vs. Dal. (10/8/23), became the first 49ers LB to record an INT in back-to-back games since LB Ray-Ray Armstrong in 2017 [1 INT Week 4 at Arz. (10/1/17) & 1 INT Week 5 at Ind. (10/8/17)].

- Registered 10 tackles and 1 FF vs. Cin. (10/29).
- Warner's 10 tackles on the day gave him 704 in his career, which passed former LB Ken Norton and former LB Derek Smith for the 2nd-most tackles in franchise history.
- Tallied 7 tackles, 1 PD and 1 INT of Jaguars QB Trevor Lawrence at Jax. (11/12).
- Notched 12 tackles, 2 PDs and split a sack of Buccaneers QB Baker Mayfield with Bosa vs. TB (11/19).
- Warner also registered 1 FF on his 0.5 sack vs. TB (11/19). The FF marked his 3rd of the season and the 10th of his career. His 10 career FFs are tied for the 3rd-most by a 49ers player since at least 2000, according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- Registered 9 tackles, 1 FF and a 0.5 sack of Cardinals QB Kyler Murray at Arz. (12/17).
- Registered 8 tackles and 1 INT of Seahawks QB Drew Lock vs. Sea. (12/10), marking his 4th INT of the season and the 8th of his career.
- Warner's 4 INTs this season are tied for the most by a non-DB in franchise history.
- Warner's 6-consecutive seasons with 100-or-more tackles surpass former LB Derek Smith for the most by a 49ers player in franchise history.
- Warner also became the 5th active NFL player to post 100-or-more tackles in 6-consecutive seasons (LB Demario Davis, NO – 6 seasons; LB Erik Kendricks, LAC – 7 seasons; LB Roquan Smith, Bal. – 6 seasons; LB Bobby Wagner, Sea. – 12 seasons).
- Registered 7 tackles vs. GB (1/20/24), giving him 71 tackles in his playoff career.
- Warner's 71 tackles in the playoffs are tied for the 3rd-most in franchise history.
- Registered a team-high and playoff career-high 13 tackles vs. Det. (1/28/24), giving him 84 tackles in his playoff career.
- Warner's 84 tackles in the playoffs are the most in franchise history.

2022

- Started all 17 games and posted a team-high 130 tackles, 10 PDs, 2.0 sacks, 1 FF and 1 INT. Also started all 3 postseason games and added 23 tackles and a 16-yd. INT.
- Recorded 9 tackles, 1 PD and 0.5 sack at Car. (10/9).
- Registered 12 tackles, 1 PD and 0.5 sack at LAR (10/30).
- Brought down Cardinals QB Colt McCoy for a 9-yd. sack at Arz. (11/21), giving him 2.0 on the season and 6.5 in his career.
- Forced a Saints RB Alvin Kamara fumble vs. NO (11/27), marking the 7th FF of his career and first since 1/2/22 vs. Hou. Finished with 7 tackles, 2 PDs and 1 FF.

(2014-18), LB Bobby Wagner - Sea. (2012-16) & LB Luke Kuechly - Car. (2012-16)].
- With a team-high 12 tackles at LV (1/1/23), registered 122 tackles in 2022. It marked the 5th-consecutive season (2018-22) that he has registered 115-or-more tackles in a single season to start his career. Warner is 1 of 2 players (LB Bobby Wagner, Sea./LAR) to have registered 115-or-more tackles in each of the past 5 seasons
- Registered a team-high 9 tackles and 1 INT of Cowboys QB Dak Prescott, which he returned for 16 yds., vs. Dal (1/22/23 – NFC-D). The INT marked the 2nd of his postseason career and first since at KC (2/2/20 – SB LIV).

- Registered 9 tackles and 1 FR vs. Ind. (10/24), recovering the fumble by Colts RB Jonathan Taylor.
- Registered 7 tackles and 1 FR at Jax. (11/21).
- Registered a team-high 9 tackles and 1 FR vs. Atl. (12/19), giving him a single season career-high 3 FRs on the season and 6 FRs in his career.

- Led the team with 7 tackles and 1 INT at NE (10/25), picking off Patriots QB Cam Newton. It marked his 2nd INT of the season and 3rd of his career.
- Recovered a Bills QB Josh Allen fumble vs. Buf. (12/7), marking the 2nd FR of his career and 1st since 10/28/18 at Arz.
- Forced and recovered a Cardinals TE Dan Arnold fumble at Arz. (12/26), his 1st FF and 2nd FR of the season. Finished the game with 14 tackles, tying his career-high [14 tackles at LAR (12/30/18)], a career-high 3 PDs, 1 FF and 1 FR.
- Brought down Seahawks QB Russell Wilson vs. Sea. (1/3/21), his 1st sack of the season.

2019

- Started all 16 games and registered 118 tackles and single-season career-highs in sacks (3.0), INTs (1), PDs (9) and FFs (3) this season. Also started all 3 postseason games and notched 20 tackles, 1 INT and 2 PDs.
- Forced a fumble by Buccaneers TE O.J. Howard which was recovered by DL Ronald Blair III (9/8), marking his 2nd-career FF. Also led the team with 9 tackles.

- Registered 10 tackles, a career-high 2.0 sacks, 1 FF and 1 PD vs. Sea. (11/11). The 2.0 sacks also marked the first two sacks of his career. Became the first player in the NFL to register at least 10 tackles, 2.0 sacks a 1 FF in a game since Chi. DL Akiem Hicks tallied 10 tackles, 2.0 sacks and 1 FF vs. SF (12/4/16). Became the first 49ers LB to register 2.0-or-more sacks in a game since LBs Ahmad Brooks and Aaron Lynch each had 2.0 sacks vs. Sea. (10/22/15).
- Sacked and striped the ball from Packers QB Aaron Rodgers vs. GB (11/24), marking his 3rd career sack and 4th FF of his career. He also led the team with 11 tackles.
- Intercepted Rams QB Jared Goff and returned the pass 46 yds. for a TD vs. LAR (12/21). It marked his 1st career INT and TD.
- Helped the 49ers defense hold the Vikings to 147 total net yds. (21 rushing and 126 passing) vs. Min. (1/11/20 - NFC-D). The 147 total net yds. allowed are the fewest allowed in a postseason game in franchise history. It also marked the fewest total net yds. allowed in an NFL postseason game since 1/3/15 [Carolina held Arz. to 78 total net yds. (27 rushing and 51 passing)]. The 21 rushing yds. allowed by the 49ers defense is the fewest allowed in a postseason game in franchise history.
- Registered 7 tackles and 1 INT at KC (2/2/20 - SB), marking his first career postseason INT.

2018

- Started all 16 games and registered 123 tackles, 6 PDs, 1 FF and 1 FR. His 122 tackles ranked 3rd in the NFL among rookies.
- Registered 12 tackles, 1 FF and 1 PD in his NFL debut at Min. (9/9). Became the first 49ers defender to register 10-or-more tackles, 1-or-more FF and 1-or-more PD in a single game since 2013 [NaVorro Bowman at Arz. (12/29/13)].
- With 10 tackles at LAC (9/30), he became the first rookie since 2000 to begin his career with four consecutive games of at least 10 tackles.
- Recovered a fumble by Cardinals TE Jermaine Gresham at Arz. (10/28), marking his 1st career FR.
- Registered a career-high 14 tackles at LAR (12/30). His 14 tackles were the 4th-most in a single game by a rookie in 2018.

COLLEGE

Played in 49 games (42 starts) in four years at BYU and registered 264 tackles, 32.0 TFLs, 6.5 sacks, 7 INTs (returning 2 for TDs), 5 FRs, 3 FFs and 13 PDs. His 7 career INTs rank 2nd in school history among LBs. In 2017, was named a team captain and started all 13 games, notching 87 tackles, 9.0 TFLs, 1.0 sack, 1 INT, 1 FF, 1 FR and 5 PDs. As a junior, started all 13 games and notched 86 tackles, 10.5 TFLs, 1.5 sacks, 3 INTs (returning 1 for a TD), 2 FFs and 6 PDs. In 2015, played in all 13 games (12 starts) and tallied 67 tackles, 11.5 TFLs, 4.0 sacks, 2 INTs, 4 FRs and 1 PD. As a freshman, played in 10 games (4 starts) and registered 24 tackles, 1.0 TFL, 1 INT which was returned for a TD and 1 PD.
