2025

- Started in all 17 games and 2 postseason contests.
- Helped allow zero sacks on 39 pass attempts by QB Mac Jones vs. LAR (11/9).
- Helped allow zero sacks on 32 pass attempts by QB Brock Purdy vs. Car. (11/24).

2024

- Started in all 17 games.
- Helped allow zero sacks on 28 pass attempts by QB Brock Purdy at Sea. (10/10) and helped the offense register 228 rushing yds. which marked the team's highest single-game rushing total since they rushed for 232 yds. vs. Car. (10/27/19).

2023

- Started in all 17 games and all 3 postseason games on the offensive line.
- Helped allow zero sacks on 28 pass attempts by QB Brock Purdy and QB Sam Darnold at Arz. (12/17).

2022

- Appeared in 13 games (1 start) and all 3 postseason games.
- Helped allow zero sacks on 27 pass attempts by QB Jimmy Garoppolo vs. LAR (10/3).

2021

- Started in the regular season finale at LAR (1/9/22) at LT. Also appeared in 2 postseason games on the offensive line and special teams.

2020

- Appeared in 13 games (3 starts) on the offensive line.
- Part of an offensive line that did not allow a sack as QB Nick Mullens threw for 316 yds. on 39 pass attempts vs. Buf. (12/7).

COLLEGE

Appeared in 50 games (47 starts) in five years at West Virginia (2015-19). Started all 12 games at LT as a senior in 2019 and was named Big 12 Conference Co-Offensive Lineman of the Year and First-Team All-Big 12 and AP Third-Team All-America. As a junior in 2018, started 12 games at right tackle and was part of an offensive line that paved the way for the Mountaineers to average 512.3 yds. of total offense per game, ranking 2nd in the Big 12 and 8th nationally. Started 13 games as a sophomore in 2017 and was part of the offensive line that helped the offense average 309.3 passing YPG, which ranked 13th nationally. Played in 13 games (10 starts) as a redshirt freshman in 2016 and was a member of an offensive line that was second in the Big 12 in fewest sacks allowed. Redshirted in 2015.

McKIVITZ'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- In addition to playing football, McKivitz was a four-year basketball player at Union Local (Jacobsburg, OH) HS, earning all-state honors as a senior in 2014.
- Didn't participate in organized football until he enrolled at Union Local before his sophomore year of high school in 2012.
- He caught his first fish, a bluegill, at age 3. McKivitz notes that the largest fish he's ever caught was an 8-pounder which he caught in the summer of 2019.
- Is a fan of country music, citing Kenny Chesney and the Zac Brown Band among his favorites.
- McKivitz hosts a youth athlete empowerment camp in San Francisco called The Trenches. The focus of the camp was for mental and emotional resilience and football development of high school linemen.

- Attended Union Local (Jacobsburg, OH) HS where he was a three-year starter and a captain for his final two seasons. Also named Associated Press Division V All-Ohio first team as a senior in 2014.
- Graduated with a bachelor's degree in wildlife and fisheries resources from West Virginia.
