DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 5 GAME VS. THE CLEVELAND BROWNS

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- In San Francisco's Week 3 game vs. Pit. (9/22/19), DL **DeForest Buckner** registered 10 tackles, 1.0 sack, 1 FF and 1 FR, becoming the first DL since Packers DL Vonnie Holliday in Week 14 of 2001 to finish a game with that stat line. Buckner looks for at least 1.0 sack in three consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- With RBs **Matt Breida** (226) and **Raheem Mostert** (202), the 49ers are 1 of 2 teams in the NFL to have at least 2 players with 200-or-more rushing yds. on the season (Bal.).

JIMMY IN RED

- QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** is 4-0 as a starter at Levi's Stadium as a member of the 49ers. In those 4 starts, he has completed 93 of 131 atts. (71.0%) for 1,106 yds., 6 TDs and an average passer rating of 102.1.
- Garoppolo is averaging 8.8 passing yds. per attempt in 2019, ranking 3rd in the NFL (Patrick Mahomes, KC - 9.7; Dak Prescott, Dal. - 9.0).

- Garoppolo's 69.0 completion percentage this season ranks 8th in the NFL and 5th in the NFC (Russell Wilson, Sea. - 72.9; Dak Prescott, Dal. - 72.4; Kyle Allen, Car. - 71.7; Matt Ryan, Atl. - 70.5).

San Francisco's 2 defensive TDs are tied for the 2nd-most in the NFL (NYJ - 3; NE - 2; TB - 2).

The Niners have registered 5 INTs, ranking t-2nd in the NFL (NE - 10; Buf. - 5; NYG - 5).

The 49ers have given up just 12 big plays (rushes of 10-or-more yds. & receipts. of 20-or-more yds.), the fewest in the NFL.

San Francisco has allowed only 26 passing 1st downs, the fewest in the NFL.

Opposing QBs have averaged a completion percentage of 57.1% against San Francisco, ranking t-3rd in the NFL (NE - 52.0%; Det. - 55.4%; Buf. - 57.1%; GB - 57.1%).

72.7

The 49ers have allowed an average passer rating of 72.7 to opposing QBs, ranking 3rd in the NFL (NE - 41.0; Buf. - 64.3).

283.3

Opponents are averaging 283.3 total yds. per game against the 49ers, the 3rd-fewest in the NFL (NE - 243.0; Buf. - 280.8).
