GAME NOTES

San Francisco 49ers vs. Los Angeles Rams Sunday, October 18, 2020

With the win...

- The **Niners** improved to 3-3 on the season.
- The **49ers** improved to 72-67-3 overall against the Rams, including a 36-34-2 record at home. The team has won 3-consecutive games against the Rams.
- **San Francisco** improved to 73-40 overall in prime time, including a 44-20 record at home. The **49ers** are now 17-14 on *Sunday Night Football*, with a 12-6 record at home.

Stone Cold Kittle

- TE **George Kittle** hauled in 7 receipts. for 109 yds. and 1 TD, including a 44-yd. TD receipt. on 4th-and-2. His 109 rec. yds. marked his 2nd 100-yd. rec. game of the season and 10th of his career.
- **Kittle's** 10 career 100-yd. games are the most by a TE in franchise history and rank t-7th among all players.
- **Kittle** has registered 100-or-more rec. yds. in 3 of his past 4 games against the Rams. He has also scored a TD in 4 of the past 5 matchups against the Rams.

Jimmy Shines On Primetime

- QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** completed 23 of 33 atts. for 268 yds., 3 TDs and a QB rating of 124.3.
- **Garoppolo** threw 3 TD passes in the first half, marking the 3rd time he has done so in his career and first time since 2019 [3 at Arz. [10/31/19]].

Deebo Finds Paydirt

- On the first drive of the game, WR **Deebo Samuel** found the endzone for his 1st TD of the season and 4th rec. TD of his career. He finished the game with 6 receipts. for 66 yds. and 1 TD.

You Always Remember Your First

- WR **Brandon Aiyuk** hauled in a 2-yd. TD receipt. on 3rd-and-goal, marking his first career TD receipt. He finished the game with 2 receipts. for 12 yds. and 1 TD.

Winning In The Trenches

- The **49ers offensive line** helped the team rush for 122 yds. on 37 carries and did not allow a sack on 33 pass atts. by QB Jimmy Garoppolo.

Gimme That

- On 4th-and-goal in the 3rd Qtr., CB **Jason Verrett** intercepted Los Angeles Rams QB Jared Goff, marking his 1st INT of the season, 5th of his career and his first since 9/11/16 as a member of the San Diego Chargers. He also added 3 tackles and 2 PDs on the night.

Not In My House

- The DL **Dion Jordan** blocked a Los Angeles Rams K Samuel Sloman PAT, marking his first career blocked kick. It marks the first time San Francisco has blocked a PAT since DL Chris Jones blocked a Sea. K Steven Hauschka PAT vs. Sea. (1/1/17).

**49ers Head Coach Kyle Shanahan
Press Conference – October 18, 2020
San Francisco 49ers vs. Los Angeles Rams**

Opening Comments:

"Alright guys, injuries. [RB] Raheem Mostert, he had an ankle, did not return. [S Jaquiski] Tarrt, groin, did not return. [T] Trent Williams had his head checked. He did return. [OL] Ben Garland, calf. Did not return."

Obviously, you were leaning on the run game early. Just wondering your initial impressions of how the offensive line blocked, especially in those key situations that you'd been talking about a lot the last couple of weeks?

"Yeah, I thought the O-Line had a hell of a game. Always wait to see the film, but I thought they cleared a bunch of good lanes for our backs. I thought they protected very well versus a very good front and the results, I think, speak for themselves. So, they did a hell of a job."

You talked last week about needing your best players to play at their best. Do you feel like that happened in a lot of areas?

"Yeah, I'll see when I look on the tape, but I thought our whole team played pretty well. That was a real good team win, I thought. Our defense played their ass off, obviously. Our goal was to get more runs than the other team. I knew both teams were trying to run the ball and I think just the whole team, for us to get 37 runs there when you're not just killing them with run average, says a lot about how everybody played."

On that fourth down touchdown to TE George Kittle, was that a fourth down call all the way? You always want to get the first down on third down, but do you almost pull the third down play to get yourself almost to that play?

"Yes, you're right there in that fringe area. I think we were out of field goal range and knew we had two downs on it, but anytime you call a run, I think it was third and six or third and five, if you call a run there and you lose some yards, then you'll end up punting. I thought at least we'd get half of it and I think we got to fourth and two and felt good about that pass call. I think they zeroed us on it. That's why we had a pretty good look and then Kittle beat the man coverage and it was a good throw, good protection and it was awesome to get the house call on it."

Can you describe the flip pass to WR Deebo Samuel? Obviously, it worked on the touchdown, worked on that third down conversion and just how much you guys have worked on that in practice and how pivotal it was tonight?

"It was huge for us tonight. Starting out the game, I think it was the second play of the game and then I think he scored on that same drive down there in the endzone. It was just the same run play we've been doing for a while, but it's always nice to get Deebo involved on it. When you do it, the difference with it is our halfbacks kind of become the fullback on the play, so I thought they did a good job too running that. That last run that Deebo had was as impressive of a run as I've ever seen. I thought we blocked it for about seven yards and then three guys just try to bring it on Deebo and he just stayed up and finished the play and got three more and allowed us to go out there and take a knee. So, he was very impressive all day on that and especially the way he finished, I thought it was his best one."

The first four throws QB Jimmy Garoppolo had we're all pretty short, guideline, scrimmage stuff. Was that a concerted effort on your part to just kind of get him established, get him in a rhythm and how do you think he fared after he got rolling there?

"Those were the run plays that we liked. So, mainly did that for that reason and just has to do a lot with what they played defensively. It's nice when you do that, you've got guys like Deebo and I think we

threw one out to, I think it was [WR Brandon] Aiyuk on one of the others. Yeah, that always helps the quarterback, too, when you're able to move down the field and have some run plays that count as pass plays. Gets you in a little bit of a rhythm and I think it helped."

A couple of running back questions. Do you know what Raheem's prognosis is with that ankle? Then the second is, you guys leaned very heavily on RB JaMycal Hasty in the last quarter there and he seemed to step up. Were you hesitant at all about giving a rookie that kind of workload, that crucial time of the game and how do you think he did?

"I thought he did a real good job when he came in. No, we don't know yet on Raheem. I'm sure we'll find out tomorrow. I know he tried to come back. I think he did at the end of the second quarter. He tried to come back in, I think he did one play in the third quarter and then he couldn't go. I thought [RB Jerick McKinnon] Jet did a good job running hard, doing what he's done for us every week, but Hasty was up for the challenge. Got some fresh legs in there and I thought he gave us some juice a little bit. We found out we didn't have [RB] Jeff [Wilson Jr.]. We found out later in the week with a tight calf and Hasty got his opportunity and from what I saw, I thought he really helped us."

Jimmy talked about there being a unique sense of urgency during the practice this week. Did this feel like a typical October game for you? I know they're all really important, but was there a heightened sense of urgency in your mind going into this game?

"I think we always have a pretty big sense of urgency, but I think when you get embarrassed like we did last week, and when you get embarrassed like that, you can find out a lot about your team. We came in Monday and it was a hard day, but usually when stuff like that happens, guys either give in because it gets too hard and they try to hide and point fingers a little bit and just go through the motions or guys try to step it up and get better. Thought we had some good meetings on Monday, but you really don't know until you see guys on the field on Wednesday. I was very impressed with the character of our team and just how the players carried themselves and the way they came out to practice on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday and really the way they responded to all of us get embarrassed. They tried to get better this week and not worry about anything else. Usually when you do that and you can put together those types of practices, usually the results are better and I'm glad that they were because I thought they really earned it throughout the week and today."

A couple of questions about the defense. Why do you think they were so effective today and how important has CB Jason Verrett been to what you guys have been able to do?

"Oh, Jason's been great. You guys could see him in his coverages today. The play he made down in the redzone, the play he almost picked. He almost had his hand on a few of them. I know he got that one, but he almost had a number of them. And not just how he covers, but Jason's a man out there. The way he carries himself, the way he likes to mix it up. He loves playing football. He loves the physicality of the game and he's a great talent in terms of covering. I'm so pumped to have him on our team and I'm just happy for him that he's been able to get out there again. It was awesome getting [CB Emmanuel Moseley] E-Man back and kind of just having a little bit more of our crew there in the secondary. I think the guys fed off it. We went against a very good offense, a very good team. I know we bent a little bit in some of the run game, but the way we played down in the redzone, keeping them out of there and stuff and would love to have us not have given that touchdown on that real deep play, but besides that, I thought the guys were pretty flawless."

How much does not having Raheem Mostert change what you can do in the offense in the second half? It was consecutive punts over and over again.

"I think Raheem's shown this league, starting last year, how special of a back he is. So, anytime you lose a special guy like that, there definitely is a change, but I've also got a lot of confidence in our other guys, too. Couldn't catch them at a surprise as much as some of the stuff we were doing. Guys kind of settled down in the second half and that makes it a little tougher with creating the holes and stuff and

some of the stuff we offset it with in the first half with getting the receivers going and things like that. So, the looks do get tougher in the second half, usually always, but it always hurts when you lose a good one like Raheem.”

Los Angeles Rams DL Aaron Donald was probably the NFL defensive MVP over the first five weeks. What did you guys do to limit him so much in this game?

“It’s a huge challenge. He’s as good of a player as you just said, everyone knows that. I thought our O-Line did a very good job. You try to avoid him as much as possible and I think we were able to do that for the most part today. Rarely does that happen, but I thought our guys were up for the challenge. They knew what was ahead of them and they came out and did as good as they could in that area.”

Given how well that you and Los Angeles Rams head coach Sean McVay know each other, how do you go about getting an edge over him and how much of a chess match does it become?

“Not much. I think that game was pretty simple from, I mean that was two teams playing sound defense on both sides and it was two teams really trying to run the ball. It was both of our players out there just getting after each other and thought it was a physical game. Two really good teams and I don’t think that game had much at all to do with Sean and I.”

There was a lot of talk this week about the team needing to find its identity. Is there a feeling in the locker room that tonight you played closer to the identity that you guys expect?

“Yeah, I believe so. I’m not sure how the whole year, but I think we got our most run carries today, which isn’t just an offensive goal. That’s a team goal. That’s what I think we did a better job of last year. I haven’t been able to find that this year. So, in order for us to do that offensively, you’ve got to do what you saw all around. Even then when we struggled on offense, we were able to keep sticking with it and things like that, which slowed the game down and I think the defense does feed off that. I think our special teams played very well, too. It’s something to build off of.”

I know you guys were confident that you’d be able to bounce back, but being able to actually go out and do it, what do you think you learned about yourselves over the last week and coming away with the win tonight?

“It was really just about coming into this game, you could feel in the locker room throughout the entire week, it was a different mindset that everyone had. The last couple of weeks before this, no one liked that feeling. It wasn’t who we are as a team and I think this week it just kind of got us back right on track.”

Can you describe the touch you have to put on those short tosses to WR Deebo Samuel, especially, just whether it was the ones at the start or the one that kind of clinched the game at the end there?

“Yeah, it’s a different type of play, but it’s all around the NFL now. Deebo, I think he’s the best in the league at it. The guy, he runs like a running back, has moves like a receiver. It’s unique what he could do with the ball in his hands. It was a great, great offensive job tonight. Great defense. I mean, it was all three phases working together.”

The Rams moved Los Angeles Rams DL Aaron Donald all around the field, like they usually do, but he was mostly lined up over OL Daniel Brunskill for this game. Obviously, this is a ‘after I seen the film’ type of question, but what was your sense of how he blocked and how he did against Aaron Donald?

"I thought the O-Line as a whole, just did a phenomenal job. In the run game, it started with the run game and then the pass game, the pockets were clean all night. There were a couple third downs where I held the ball for a little extra long, just the coverage was good and they didn't get near me. I didn't get hit very much. Felt great coming out of this game. When the O-Line plays like that, it sets the tone for our whole offense and they did it tonight."

Everybody's talked about how great practice was this week. How much did that affect what you were able to do on the field? And then also, you said goodbye to the cutouts on your way out of the stadium today. Can you talk about how much you miss the fans?

"Yeah. Well practice, I think it always starts with your Wednesday, Thursday, Friday practice. That's what sets the tone for the rest of the week and guys came in with the right mindset. I said it before, but it was just when guys come in and guys are locked in, taking it seriously, every play, every snap, it makes a difference on Sunday. As far as saying 'We miss you' to the Faithful, we really do miss you guys out there, man. It's different without fans. It's tough, but we're making the best of the situation, but just, Faithful, know that we miss you guys out there."

You looked a lot more comfortable out there tonight than you did the week earlier against the Dolphins. I'm just wondering, did it feel that way right away from the outset? And if so, was it more physical for you because of the ankle or were you just in a better rhythm from the start?

"Yeah, the ankle's definitely, it's made improvements this week. So, yeah, I could lean on it a little bit more, was able to move in the pocket a little bit, just was able to be myself really this week. It started with a good week of practice and got to thank the medical staff for doing their part."

On the fourth down pass to TE George Kittle, obviously, it gets an all-out blitz. Are you throwing it, almost having to just assume he's open or did you know he was open when you threw it and obviously you can take a hit?

"A little bit of both. We were hot on the play. They had an extra rusher, so the ball had to come out quick. George, he snapped it off and that's kind of one of those timing plays where we just have to be on the same page and we've done it so many times in practice that it really worked out. He did the rest with his feet. I didn't get to see it, but I heard it was a pretty sweet play."

You've practiced against CB Jason Verrett. So, curious what you think are his strengths as a cornerback and how much do you think his interception on that fourth down play in the end zone changed the game tonight?

"Oh, it was huge. That was a huge turning point in the game. I wasn't sure what coverage or anything we were in, but just the play he made on it, keeping his feet in bounds. I mean, it was a hell of a play. He played great tonight. JV, he's one of those guys, even if you get down on him, if he has a bad day or something like that, he has the mindset where he comes back the next day and he's ready to fight. That's what I really respect out of the guy. When a guy can do that on a day to day basis, he earns your trust as a teammate."

How much does it change not having a guy like RB Raheem Mostert on the field with you guys?

"It's definitely different. Raheem is so unique, just his speed and how he hits the hole and how he sees things. I thought [RB Jerick McKinnon] Jet and [RB JaMycal] Hasty stepped up big tonight. Hasty came in at the end there, got some carries and he was seeing things very well, especially for a guy who hadn't played the first three quarters. So, our running backs, were pretty deep there, man. So, it's a good group of guys to be around."

After your third down run to set up the field goal with the hit that you kind of delivered on your own, the camera's caught you smiling. What was going through your head at that point and how big was that play for the team?

"Well, I knew where we needed to get to. Didn't really want to slide and even make it a longer field goal, so I was trying to actually to get down a little bit. DB wanted to, I don't know, just kind of happened last second, running into each other like that. But, it was a big, big point of the game just to get us another three points to keep that lead and really help the defense out."

I know after last week you said your confidence wasn't shaken at all, but did it help you at all to get kind of those plays right at the beginning of the game that were just basically extensions of the run game, but get a couple of quick, easy completions to get you going a little bit?

"Yeah, I think that's part of our offense. When we're at our best is when we could run the ball like that, have the RPO's off of it, play action. When [head coach] Kyle's [Shanahan] mixing all that stuff up like that, it makes it hard on defenses. It's a pick your poison type of thing. Kyle did a great job tonight putting us in good positions. He was on point tonight, so it makes all of our jobs a lot easier."

You talked earlier in the week about the team having not found its identity. Do you feel like how you played tonight you guys are closer to that?

"Definitely. Yeah, definitely. We're definitely moving in the right direction. I wouldn't say we're totally there yet. There's still a lot football left in the season, but how we finished this game, it felt a lot like last year, just how we were controlling the clock at the end of the game, running the ball, converting third downs. That's when we really put teams away and that's what we did tonight."

George has talked very specifically about the offensive captains needing to raise their game, pointing to himself, obviously, but other captains. Obviously, he's a guy who plays real hard and makes big plays. How does that come across when you hear something like that?

"Good. I think it needs to be said. Whenever guys are holding each other accountable, whenever guys hold themselves accountable, I think it's a good thing. The NFL's hard. Not every week's going to be fun, not going to be pretty, but at the end of the day, you've got to find a way to get the W and then move on to next week. When the captains can have that mindset and we set the tone like that, I think it just trickles down to everyone else."

Speaking of next week, you'll be going back to Boston to play the Patriots. What are your thoughts on going back there and how much of a momentum boost is this win for that?

"It will be cool. You know, getting back to the old stomping grounds. See some familiar faces, but we'll enjoy this one tonight. Get on the field for the Patriots and everything tomorrow. Yeah, this win will definitely give us a little momentum, but next week is going to be another dog fight."

Postgame Quotes – October 18, 2020
San Francisco 49ers vs. Los Angeles Rams**

Can you run us through your evaluations of both sides of the ball tonight?

“Offensively, we just were never able to really get any sort of continuity. We had a lot of missed opportunities tonight. Some decisions that clearly I've got to do a better job with, but I think as a whole, there were just too many things that we're not accustomed to doing. You give credit to the 49ers, they did a nice job, but we made a lot of uncharacteristic decisions. We had a lot of our players that we count on that didn't come through in some situations that they typically do, but it's a great learning opportunity for us. Defensively, a little bit of a slow start. I love the way we settled in. I thought they played excellent in the second half. There was a lot of physical, tough tackling, good third down stops. They gave us every opportunity to be able to get back in that game. Then with special teams, it was up and down. There were some good things, some things that we certainly have to do a much better job of, but overall I always feel much better when I go back and look at the tape and I'm able to give you clarity on everything that occurred.”

Are you comfortable with how your team was, or was not tackling, particularly after first contact on some of those yards after the catch play?

“There were a couple plays you look at, especially early on, where [49ers WR] Deebo, Samuel did a great job of coming out of that, I thought he was down. So, there'll be a lot of things that we can learn about just wrapping up and finishing. They've got a lot of great players that do an excellent job of breaking tackles. We certainly want to tackle consistently and want to bring guys down on first contact, but you do give credit to the other guys for doing a nice job of creating those broken tackles.”

What happened with the RB Cam Akers tonight? It didn't look like he played. Can you take us through the play calls on the third down and fourth down near the goal line?

“It was more of a result of Cam not being able to get into the flow because we had such a minimal amount of drives in the first half. We got him in there a little bit in the second half, but we ended up throwing it on a one play sequence. That's where it was incomplete. Then it's second and ten and we ended up putting [RB] Malcolm [Brown] in the game. On the third down, we just had a little half roll and typically where we make that throw and catch, we dropped it. Then on the fourth down, we had a bunch concept that they did a nice job matching up on.”

Can you take us through that first couple of series? So far this season, it seems like you've really relied on the run to start the game and today it seemed like the game plan was more to pass the ball to begin with. Is that accurate?

“Not necessarily. Sometimes we have different things called that they give us different looks and we had some pretty good looks to be able to throw and catch that we didn't do in those first couple plays. We had the things that we wanted, but we've just got to be able to execute.”

What were they doing to seemingly neutralize your pass rush?

“They do a good job of really mixing it up. They balance the run with the play actions. They had some good screens early on and I think [49ers head coach] Kyle [Shanahan] does an excellent job. It was just the ability to be able to stay efficient on some of those early downs and then be able to commit a lot of guys to the protection. Then when they didn't they had some screens and some different things that put a lot of stress on defenses.”

It seemed like QB Jared Goff and WR Cooper Kupp were kind of out of sync the whole game. From what you saw, what was going on and what made it so tough for them?

"They just missed on some opportunities that typically those guys connect on. I think you really just said it. They were just a little bit out of sync. We had some opportunities in some chances. I do believe that those two guys will definitely connect on a lot of those opportunities when we get them moving forward, but tonight was kind of one of those nights for us where we missed a lot of things that we're accustomed to making happen."

Can you just talk about the production of RB Darrell Henderson and how he's been just a very patient runner waiting for the holes to open up and be able to execute that way?

"I thought he did a good job tonight. He had some tough runs. I thought he leveled his pads off really well at the end. I thought he saw the lanes pretty clearly on some different varieties that we activated. I'd love to be able to punch the one down in there in the red area. We've got a block a little bit better, but also sometimes it's being able to create on your own a little bit, but Darrell did a lot of positive things tonight."

How would you evaluate Jared Goff's game overall tonight?

"I think it was some good, some bad, some things that I think we'll want back. He did give us a chance at the end, but it's always more helpful for me to go back and look at it before I give you a true evaluation."

I know you said that no one should underestimate the 49ers, but what do you think tonight's game says about the NFC West and what's ahead for everyone in that division?

"What we've already known is that every single team is tough. We knew what kind of football team this was that we were playing and you've got to give them credit. They did a great job tonight, but I also think we had our hand in not playing up to our capabilities. You have to bring it and you have to show up and play at your best in those three and a half, four-hour windows that you get every single week. If not, these are the results that you get."

Can you run us through a little bit of a self-scout today of your game overall?

"Well clearly it wasn't my best. It was just some uncharacteristic stuff for me, missing guys open there early. It's something that I've never done in my life and don't expect to ever repeat. I've just got to be a little bit better there at being a little bit more accurate. That's probably what I do best is accuracy and I would have put us in a little better situation there and given us a chance to a better chance to win."

It was also kind of uncharacteristic for some of your receivers tonight. When someone has an uncharacteristic mistake, can those things compound throughout a team? It seems a little uncharacteristic for you guys to have so many guys have an off night.

"I don't think it was compounding of anything. I think it just happens sometimes to the best of them. It just so happens that we struggled in some areas. Again, it starts with me and if I'm accurate on a lot of those balls early on, we're not even talking about this right now. It's a good chance, like I heard [OL] Andrew [Whitworth] say for us to look in the mirror and get better and come back. We've got another big game next Monday night. There's a lot of stuff to work on, a lot of stuff to be better at."

You talked to last week about not underestimating the 49ers even with their record. What do you think tonight says, if anything, about the division and what is ahead for you guys when you get heavy into the division?

"We're in the best division in football and there's a reason for it. These guys are good. Arizona is good and Seattle's obviously undefeated. We're a great team so every time you play in this division, it's going to be a tough game and we know that coming in."

Can you take me through the pick in the end zone? What happened there? What'd you see?

"It was man coverage and they made a great play. I thought [49ers CB Jason] Verrett played a really good game and it was a great play by him. He fell off his coverage and fell up underneath the ball and made a great play."

After the Buffalo game and the Giants game, there was a sense that this was a team that could come up with a way to win or come from behind. When things weren't going perfectly, did it feel different in that regard tonight? Did you still feel that it was going to or was it somehow different?

"No, it absolutely felt like it was going to happen all night. We had our chances, our defense kept making stops in that second half. We knew it was to score game the whole time and all way to do was get one. We had our shot down low in the red zone a couple of times there and weren't able to get them off. Again, that's a reflection of how we played tonight. We've got to finish out drives. We've got make better decisions. We've got to throw and catch a little bit better and we will. We usually do and I know we will be coming out next week."

Early in the game, on the first couple of series, it seemed like you guys were throwing more than maybe you had in the past instead of running the ball. What were you seeing that made you guys want to do that?

"We liked our match-ups. We liked what we had all night and we had guys open. We had good things out there and we've just got to execute better. We've got to be a little bit better at execution. Again, I think if I'm a little bit better tonight, we have a different result and unfortunately that's the way it goes, but I'll learn from it and be better."
