CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Through his first 25 career starts, Purdy completed 477 of his 690 passing atts. (69.1%) for 6,508 yds. and 47 TDs with a passer rating of 112.6. Purdy's 69.1% completion percentage, 47 TDs and 112.6 passer rating rank first among QBs whose first 25 career starts were with the 49ers.
- Purdy's 112.6 passer rating through his first 25 career starts is the highest by an NFL QB through their first 25 career starts since at least 1970.
- Through his first three NFL seasons, Purdy set the NFL records for the most games with 2-or-more passing TDs and a passer rating of 115.0-or-higher (15) in a player's first three seasons. He also holds the NFL records for the most games with a passer rating of 120.0-or-higher (13), 130.0-or-higher (10) and 140.0-or-higher (6) in a player's first three seasons.
- Became the first rookie in the Super Bowl era with at least 2 TD passes, 1 rushing TD and a passer rating of 125-or-higher in his first career start (12/11/22 vs. TB). His 134.0 passer rating is the 6th-highest by an NFL QB in their first career start since at least 1970, while his 76.2 completion percentage is the 8th-highest by an NFL QB in their first career start since at least 1970.
- Is 1 of 7 QBs since at least 1970 to register 2-or-more passing TDs and 1-or-more rushing TD in their first NFL start [Daniel Jones (NYG), Kyle Allen (Car.), Cam Newton (Car.), Jake Delhomme (NO), Jeff Garcia (SF) & Vinny Testaverde (TB)].
- Became the only rookie QB since 1950 to win his first 3 NFL starts and throw 2-or-more TD passes in each game.

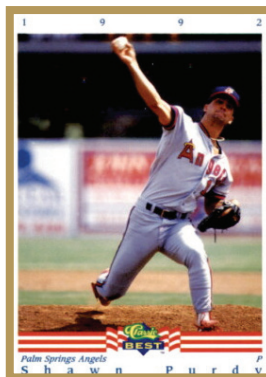

Comes from an athletic family. His father, Shawn, played baseball at the University of Miami (FL) and in the minor leagues (1991-98). His older sister, Whitney, played softball at Southeastern University and his younger brother, Chubba, is a QB at Nebraska.



Was named First-Team All-Big 12 twice (Associated Press in 2021, coaches poll in 2020) at Iowa State.



Became the first Iowa State QB to be drafted since Seneca Wallace was selected 110th overall by the Seattle Seahawks in 2003.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONTINUED)

- In his first full season as a starter, Purdy set the 49ers single season franchise record for passing yds. (4,280). He became the first 49ers QB in 23 years to throw for 4,000-or-more yds. in a season.
- Purdy set the single season franchise record for passer rating (113.0) in his first full season as a starter, posting the highest passer rating by a 49ers QB since Steve Young in 1997.
- Purdy won each of his first 10 regular season starts which are tied for the second-most wins to begin a career in NFL history.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS (CONTINUED)

- Through first 10 starts, completed 183 of his 260 passing atts. (70.4%) for 2,369 yds. and 20 TDs with a passer rating of 121.1.
- Purdy's 121.1 passer rating through his first 10 career starts marked the highest passer rating by a QB in their first 10 career starts in NFL history.
- His 70.4% completion percentage through his first 10 career starts marked the 2nd-highest completion percentage by a QB in their first 10 career starts in NFL history.
- In Week 4 of 2023 vs. Arz. (10/1/23), Purdy completed 20 of his 21 passing atts. (95.2%) for 283 yds. and 1 TD with a passer rating of 134.6. His 95.2% completion percentage marked the highest single-game completion percentage in franchise history and the fourth-highest single-game completion percentage in NFL history (min. 20 atts.).

- In his first two seasons, Purdy registered 5 games with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher [141.3 passer rating vs. Arz. (1/8/23); 144.4 passer rating vs. Dal. (10/8/23); 148.9 passer rating at Jax. (11/12/23); 158.3 passer rating vs. TB (11/19/23); 148.8 passer rating at Phi. (12/3/23). Purdy's 5 career games with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher in his first two seasons are the most by an NFL QB in their first two seasons in NFL history.
- Purdy registered 14 games with a passer rating of 110.0-or-more in his first two seasons, tied for the most games with a passer rating of 110.0-or-higher in a player's first two seasons in NFL history.

2025

- Started in all 9 games he appeared in and completed 197 of his 284 passing atts. (69.4%) for 2,167 yds. and 20 TDs with a passer rating of 100.5. Added 33 rushes for 147 yds. and 3 TDs on the ground. Also started in both postseason contests and completed 33 of his 58 passing atts. (56.9%) for 402 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 68.3 through the air to go along with 14 rushes for 61 yds. on the ground.
- Completed 26 of his 35 passing atts. for 277 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 92.2 at Sea. (9/7). His 2 passing TDs gave him 66 career passing TDs.
- Completed 22 of his 38 passing atts. for 309 yds. and 2 TDs vs. Jax. (9/28). His 2 passing TDs give him 4 on the season and 68 for his career.
- With 309 passing yards, registered his 11th career game with 300-or-more passing yds., which tied former QB Jimmy Garoppolo for the 4th-most games with 300-or-more passing yds. in franchise history.
- Completed 19 of his 26 passing atts. for 200 yds. and a season-high 3 TDs with a season high passer rating of 133.5 at Arz. (11/16). Purdy's 3 passing TDs gave him 7 on the season and 71 in his career.
- With a passer rating of 133.5, Purdy registered his 11th career game with a passer rating of at least 130.0 vs. Arz. (11/16). His 11 games with a passer rating of 130.0-or-higher are the most by any QB in their first 4 seasons since at least 1970.
- Completed 16 of his 29 passing atts. for 168 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 2 rushes for 4 yds., including a 2-yd. rushing TD at Cle. (11/30).
- With 1 passing TD and 1 rushing TD at Cle. (11/30), Purdy registered his 6th career game with at least 1 passing TD and at least 1 rushing TD and his first such game since he threw for 3 TD passes and rushed for 1 TD vs. Det. (12/30/24).
- Completed 23 of his 30 passing atts. for 295 yds. and 3 TDs with a season-high passer rating of 140.3 vs. Ten. (12/14). He also added 7 rushes for 44 yds., including a career-long 26-yd. run.
- Purdy registered a season-high 76.7% completion percentage vs. Ten. (12/14). It marked the 3rd time in his career that he has registered a completion percentage of 75.0-or-higher with 30-or-more passing atts. and his first such game since he completed 77.1% of his 35 pass atts. vs. Det. (12/30/24).
- Purdy's passer rating of 140.3 vs. Ten. (12/14) marked his 7th career game with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher and his first such game since he registered a 145.4 passer rating vs. Chi. (12/8/24).
- Purdy's 7 career games with a passer rating of at least 140.0 are tied for the most by a QB in their first 4 seasons since at least 1950, according to the Elias Sports Bureau (QB Milt Plum, Cle. – 7 games; QB Kurt Warner, StL – 7 games).
- With 3 passing TDs vs. Ten. (12/14), Purdy registered his 2nd game this season with at least 3 passing TDs and the 11th such game of his career.
- Completed 25 of his 34 passing atts. for 295 yds. and a career-high 5 TDs with a passer rating of 126.8 at Ind. (12/22).
- Purdy's 5 TD passes at Ind. (12/22) give him 17 this season and 81 in his career. He became the first 49ers QB to throw 5-or-more TD passes in a single game since HOF QB Joe Montana threw a franchise record 6 TD passes in the 1990 season at Atl. (10/14/90).

- Completed 24 of his 33 passing atts. for 303 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 118.6 to go along with 6 carries for 28 yds. and a season-high 2 TDs on the ground. Purdy's 3 TD passes give him 20 this season and 84 in his career, while his 2 rushing TDs marked his 3rd of the season and the 11th of his career.
- Purdy's 303 passing yds. marked his 12th career game with at least 300 passing yds., surpassing former QB Jimmy Garoppolo for the 4th-most games with 300-or-more passing yds. in franchise history.
- With 303 passing yds., 3 TD passes and 2 rushing TDs vs. Chi. (12/28), Purdy became the first QB in franchise history to register at least 300 passing yds., 3 TD passes and 2 rushing TDs in a single game.
- Purdy also became the first 49ers QB to register 2-or-more passing TDs and 2-or-more rushing TDs in a game since former QB Jeff Garcia threw 4 TD passes and tallied 2 rushing TDs vs. Arz. (12/7/03).
- With 2 rushing TDs vs. Chi. (12/28), Purdy registered his first game this season with at least 2 rushing TDs and the 2nd such game of his career [2 rushing TDs vs. KC (10/20/24)].
- With 3 TD passes vs. Ten. (12/14/25), 5 TD passes at Ind. (12/22/25) and 3 TD passes vs. Chi. (12/28), Purdy registered 3-consecutive games with 3-or-more TD passes for the first time in his career.
- Purdy became the first 49ers QB to register 3-consecutive games with at least 3 TD passes since former QB Jeff Garcia did so in the 2001 season [3 TD passes vs. Det. (11/4/18); 4 TD passes vs. NO (11/11/01); 3 TD passes at Car. (11/18/01)].
- With 303 passing yds. and 3 TDs vs. Chi. (12/28), Purdy also registered his 4th career game with at least 300 passing yds. and 3 TDs and his first such game since throwing for 377 yds. and 3 TDs vs. Det. (12/30/24).
- Completed 18 of his 31 passing atts. for 262 yds. and 2 TDs at Phi (1/11/26 - NYC-WC). His 2 passing TDs give him 8 in his postseason career.
- With 140 passing yds. at Sea. (1/11/26 -NFC-D), Purdy registered the 3rd-most passing yds. by a 49ers QB in postseason franchise history.

- Started in all 15 games he appeared in and completed 300 of his 455 passing atts. (65.9%) for 3,864 yds. and 20 TDs with a passer rating of 96.1. Added career-highs in rushes (66), rushing yards (323) and rushing TDs (5).
- Earned a passer rating of 101.3 after completing 28 of 36 passing atts. for 319 yds. vs. Min. (9/15). His 319 yds. on the day marks his sixth career regular-season game with 300-or-more yds. With a passer rating of 101.3 after completing his 23rd career start, became the sixth QB in NFL history to register a passer rating of 100.0-or-higher in 15 of his first 25 career starts.
- Completed 22 of his 30 passing atts. for 292 yds. and 3 TDs to earn a passer rating of 137.1 and added 10 rushes for 41 yds. on the ground vs. LAR (9/22). With a passer rating of 137.1 following his 24th career start, became tied for the 2nd-most games with a passer rating of 100.0-or-higher in a player's first 25 career starts.
- With a passer rating of 137.1 vs. LAR (9/22/24), Purdy registered his ninth career game with a passer rating of 130.0-or-higher, surpassing Baltimore Ravens QB Lamar Jackson (8 games) for the most games with a passer rating of 130.0-or-higher by a QB in his first three seasons in NFL history.
- In the 25th start of his career vs. NE (9/29), completed 15 of his 27 passing atts. for 288 yds. and 1 TD, earning a passer rating of 89.7. With 15 completions on the day, surpassed Hall Of Fame QB Joe Montana for the 2nd-most completions by a 49ers QB through their first 25 career starts in franchise history.

- Completed 19 of his 35 passing atts. for 244 yds. and 1 TD vs. Arz., (10/6). His passing TD gave him 6 this season and 50 in his career. With 50 passing TDs through his first 30 career games, he has the most by any QB through their first 30 games in franchise history.
- Completed 18 of his 28 passing atts. for 255 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 129.3 vs. Sea. (10/10). Purdy's passer rating of 129.3 marked his 12th career game with a passer rating of 120.0-or-higher, which was tied for the most such games by a QB in their first three seasons in NFL history.
- Completed 17 of his 31 passing atts. for 212 yds. through the air to go along with 8 rushes for 27 yds. and a career-high 2 TDs on the ground vs. KC (10/20). Became the first 49ers QB to register 2-or-more rushing TDs in a game since former QB Jimmy Garoppolo registered 2 rushing TDs at Chi. (10/31/21).
- Completed 18 of his 26 passing atts. for 260 yds. and 1 TD with a passer rating of 114.3 to go along with 8 carries for 56 yds. and 1 TD on the ground vs. Dal. (10/27). His passing TD marked his 10th of the season and the 54th of his career. With 2 rushing TDs vs. KC (10/20/24) and 1 rushing TD vs. Dal. (10/27), became the first 49ers QB to register consecutive games with a rushing TD since former QB C.J. Beathard in 2017 [1 rushing TD vs. Arz. (11/5/17); 1 rushing TD vs. NYG (11/12/17)].
- Completed 25 of his 36 passing atts. for 353 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 119.3 at TB (11/10). His 353 passing yds. and 2 passing TDs on the day marked the 2nd game of Purdy's career with 350-or-more passing yards and 2-or-more passing TDs in a single game [368 passing yds. & 2 passing TDs vs. Sea. (12/10/23)].
- Completed 21 of his 28 passing atts. for 159 yds., 1 TD and a passer rating of 85.3 to go along with 5 carries for 40 yds. and 1 TD on the ground vs. Sea. (11/17). Purdy's passing TD gave him 13 for the season and 57 in his career, while his rushing TD marked his career-high 4th of the season and the 7th of his career. Threw for 152 yds. in the first quarter, marking the most passing yds. by a 49ers QB in the first quarter of a game since former QB Jeff Garcia threw for 161 yds. in the first quarter at NO (1/6/02).

- Completed 26 of his 40 passing atts. for 313 yds. and 2 TDs at Mia. (12/22).
- Completed 27 of his 35 passing atts. for a career-high 377 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 116.0 to go along with 3 carries for 12 yds., including a 9-yd. rushing TD vs. Det (12/30). With 377 passing yds. on the day, Purdy registered his 10th career regular season game with 300-or-more passing yds., the 5th-most in franchise history.

Also started in all 3 postseason contests and completed 66 of his 108 passing atts. (61.1%) for 774 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 88.3 to go along with 14 carries for 74 yds.
- Completed 19 of his 29 passing atts. (65.5%) for 220 yds. and 2 TDs and a passer rating of 111.3 at Pit. (9/10).
- Completed 25 of his 37 passing atts. (67.6%) for 310 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 111.3 vs. NYG (9/21).

- Purdy completed each of his 10 passing atts. in the first half vs. Arz. (10/1). His 10-straight completions marked the first time that a 49ers QB completed all of his passing atts. in a half (min. 10 atts.) since former QB Steve Young in 1994, when he went 11/11 in the second half at SD (12/11/94), according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- Purdy started the game vs. Arz. (10/1) with 13-straight completions, which is the most consecutive completions to begin a game by a 49ers QB since QB Jimmy Garoppolo in 2021 [12 straight completions to start game vs. LAR (11/15/21)].
- Completed 17 of his 24 passing atts. (70.8%) for 252 yds. and a career-high 4 TDs with a passer rating of 144.4 vs. Dal. (10/8).
- Purdy's 4 TD passes vs. Dal. (10/8) marked his eighth career game with 2-or-more TD passes, tying him with HOF QB Kurt Warner and then Houston Texans QB Deshaun Watson for the most games with 2-or-more passing TDs in a player's first 10 career starts.
- Completed 19 of his 26 passing atts. (73.1%) for 296 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 148.9 at Jax. (11/12).
- Completed 21 of his 25 passing atts. (84.0%) for 333 yds. and 3 TDs with a career-high passer rating of 158.3, the highest attainable mark vs. TB (11/19).
- Purdy's 158.3 passer rating on 25 passing atts. made him the first 49ers QB to attain a perfect passer rating in franchise history (min. 20 atts.).
- Accomplishing this feat at 23-years-old, Purdy joined Baltimore Ravens QB Lamar Jackson and then Los Angeles Rams QB Jared Goff as the only QBs under the age of 24 in NFL history to attain a perfect passer rating.
- With a passer rating of 148.9 Week 10 at Jax. (11/12/23) and a passer rating of 158.3 vs. TB (11/19/23), Purdy became the youngest player in NFL history to post a passer rating of 145.0-or-higher in consecutive starts and the first NFL QB to post a passer rating of 145.0-or-higher in consecutive starts since former QB Drew Brees in 2018 [150.4 passer rating at Cin. (11/11/18); 153.2 passer rating vs. Phi. (11/18/18)].
