## 2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- Completed 19 of his 29 passing attempts (65.5%) for 220 yds. and 2 TDs and a passer rating of 111.3 at Pit. (9/10).
- Completed 20 of his 21 passing atts. for 283 yds. and 1 TD with a passer rating of 134.6 to go along with a 1-yd. rushing TD vs. Arz. (10/1).
- Purdy's 95.2% completion percentage vs. Arz. is the highest single-game completion percentage in franchise history (10/1).

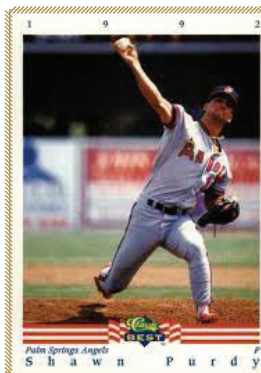

- Completed 22 of his 31 passing atts. for a career-high 365 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 6 carries for a career-high 57 yds. on the ground vs. Cin. (10/29).
- Purdy's 365 passing yds. were the most by a 49ers QB in a single game since QB Jimmy Garoppolo threw for 424 yds. vs. Arz. (11/17/19).

## PURDY'S GOLDEN NUGGETS



Comes from an athletic family. His father, Shawn, played baseball at the University of Miami (FL) and in the minor leagues (1991-98). His older sister, Whittney, played softball at Southeastern University and his younger brother, Chubba, is a QB at Nebraska.



Was named First-Team All-Big 12 twice (Associated Press in 2021, coaches poll in 2020) at Iowa State.



Became the first Iowa State QB to be drafted since Seneca Wallace was selected in 2003.

- Purdy's 95.2% completion percentage vs. Arz. (10/1) also marks the 4th-highest single-game completion percentage in NFL history (min. 20 atts.).

2023 HIGHLIGHTS (CONTINUED)

- Purdy completed each of his 10 passing atts. in the first half vs. Arz. (10/1). His 10-straight completions mark the first time that a 49ers QB has completed all of his passing atts. in a half (min. 10 atts.) since former QB Steve Young in 1994, when he went 11/11 in the second half at SD (12/11/94), according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- Purdy started the game with 13-straight completions, which is the most consecutive completions to begin a game by a 49ers QB since QB Jimmy Garoppolo in 2021 [12 straight completions to start game vs. LAR (11/15/21)].
- In his 10th career start vs. Dal. (10/8), Purdy completed 17 of his 24 passing atts. for 252 yds. and 4 TDs with a passer rating of 144.4, leading the 49ers to a 42-10 victory. His 10-consecutive wins as a starter are tied for the second-most wins to begin a career in NFL history.
- Completed 17 of his 24 passing atts. for 252 yds. and a career-high 4 TDs with a passer rating of 144.4 vs. Dal. (10/8).
- Purdy's 4 TD passes vs. Dal. (10/8) marked his eighth career game with 2-or-more TD passes, tying him with HOF QB Kurt Warner and then Houston Texans QB Deshaun Watson for the most games with 2-or-more passing TDs in a player's first 10 career starts.
- Purdy's 70.4% completion percentage through his first 10 career starts mark the 2nd-highest completion percentage by a QB in their first 10 career starts in NFL history.
- Purdy's 121.1 passer rating through his first 10 career starts marks the highest passer rating by a QB in their first 10 career starts in NFL history.
- In his 10th career start vs. Dal. (10/8), Purdy completed 17 of his 24 passing atts. for 252 yds. and 4 TDs with a passer rating of 144.4, leading the 49ers to a 42-10 victory.
- With the win vs. Dal. (10/8), Purdy has improved to 10-0 as a starter in the regular season in his career, which ties Kansas City Chiefs QB Mike Livingston and former Chicago Bears QB Mike Tomczak for the second-most consecutive wins by a quarterback to begin a career in NFL history.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Became the first rookie in the Super Bowl era with at least 2 TD passes, 1 rushing TD and a passer rating of 125-or-higher in his first career start (12/11/22 vs. TB). His 134.0 passer rating is the 6th-highest by an NFL QB in their first career start since at least 1970, while his 76.2 completion percentage is the 8th-highest by an NFL QB in their first career start since at least 1970.
- Is 1 of 7 QBs since at least 1970 to register 2-or-more passing TDs and 1-or-more rushing TD in their first NFL start [Daniel Jones (NYG), Kyle Allen (Car.), Cam Newton (Car.), Jake Delhomme (NO), Jeff Garcia (SF) & Vinny Testaverde (TB)].
- Is the only rookie QB since 1950 to win his first 3 NFL starts and throw 2-or-more TD passes in each game.

GOLDMINE

- When playing paintball in the desert with his Perry (Gilbert, AZ) HS teammates in May 2017, Purdy suffered a punctured left hand from a Saguaro Cactus. "It's something that everyone's done," Purdy said on the game in the desert. "It's one of those group things that you do to build chemistry." The team-building exercise forced Perry's starting QB to miss spring ball headed into his senior season. However, Purdy was largely unfazed by the injury to his non-throwing hand as the Queen Creek, AZ native threw for 4,405 yds. and 57 TDs that fall en route to winning Arizona Gatorade Player of the Year.
