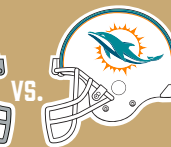

TOP OF HIS CLASS

- Last week vs. NO (11/27/22), WR **Brandon Aiyuk** registered 5 recpts. for 65 yds. It gave him 51 recpts. and 651 rec. yds. in 2022, marking the 3rd-consecutive season he's registered 50-or-more recpts., 650-or-more rec. yds. and 5-or-more TDs, joining WR Justin Jefferson, Min. and WR CeeDee Lamb, Dal. as the only members of the 2020 NFL Draft Class to do so.

- Aiyuk** has registered 5-or-more recpts. and 65-or-more yds. in 5 of his last 6 games, which is tied for the most games in the NFL in that time frame (WR Stefon Diggs - Buf., TE Travis Kelce - KC, WR Tyreek Hill, Mia., WR Davante Adams - LV, WR Justin Jefferson - Min.).

THE HALVES OF HAVE NOTS

- The **49ers defense** held the Saints to 0 pts. last week vs. NO (11/27/22), marking the team's first shutout since 2019 [W, 9-0 at Was. (10/20/19)] and the 4th shutout registered by an NFL team this season.
- San Francisco** has held their opponents to 0 pts. in the 2nd half in 4-consecutive games, becoming just 1 of 8 teams since the NFL merger to hold their opponent scoreless in a half in 4-consecutive games within a single season.
- If the **Niners** hold the Dolphins scoreless in the 2nd half this week vs. Mia. (12/4/22), it will mark the first time since 1937 (NYG - Weeks 5-10, Week 6 BYE) that an NFL team accomplished the feat.
- The **49ers defense** has held its opponents scoreless for an entire half an NFL-high 7 times in 2022, which matches the most recorded by San Francisco's defense since at least 1970 (2012 & 2001 - 7 halves).
- The unit has also prevented its opponents from scoring a TD for an entire half on 11 occasions, which is the most in the NFL in 2022 and most registered by the **49ers** since 2013 (12 halves).

FEELS GREAT, BABY!

- With a win last week vs. NO (12/4/22), QB **Jimmy Garoppolo** improved to 41-19 as a starter (play-offs included) since joining the 49ers in 2017.
- With 41 wins through his first 60 games, **Garoppolo** matched QB **Steve Young** (41 games) for the best record by a 49ers starting QB through their first 60 games with the franchise.

- Garoppolo's** .696 regular season winning percentage is the 5th-highest in the NFL among active QBs (min. 10 starts) since joining the team in 2017 (Patrick Mahomes - .797; Lamar Jackson - .733; Tom Brady - .707; Tua Tagovailoa - .700).
