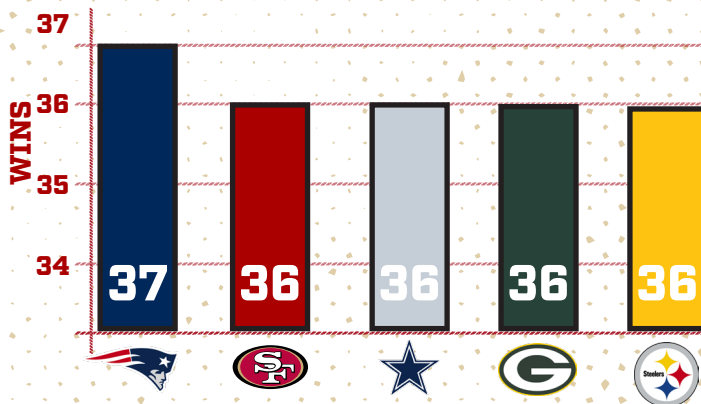

DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S NFC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME AT THE PHILADELPHIA EAGLES

WINNING WAYS

- With the win last week vs. Dal. (1/22/23 - NFC-D), **San Francisco** claimed it's 36th postseason victory, which matches the 2nd-most playoff wins by a franchise in NFL history (NE - 37, Dal. - 36, GB - 36, Pit. - 36).

MOST WINS IN THE POSTSEASON, NFL HISTORY



- Head coach **Kyle Shanahan's** 6 postseason wins are the 3rd most by a head coach in franchise history.
- With a win this week at Phi. (1/29/23 - NFC-C), **Shanahan** would improve to 7-2 in the postseason as a head coach, which would tie him with Sean McVay, LAR (7) for the 2nd-most postseason wins in the NFL since he became San Francisco's head coach in 2017 (Andy Reid, KC - 9 postseason wins).

MCCAFFREY MAKES IT HAPPEN

- RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 10 carries for 35 yds. and 1 TD to pair with 6 receipts. for 22 yds. last week vs. Dal. (1/22/23 - NFC-D). With 57 scrimmage yds. and 1 TD, it marked his 3rd-consecutive postseason game with 50-or-more scrimmage yds. and 1-or-more TD.
- With 50-or-more scrimmage yds. and 1-or-more TD this week at Phi. (1/29/23 - NFC-C), **McCaffrey** would become the 8th player and 6th RB since 1970 to accomplish the feat in at least each of his first 4 postseason games (RB Marcus Allen, LAA/KC - 7 games, RB Terrell Davis, Den. - 7, RB Curtis Martin, NE/NYJ - 5, WR Randy Moss, Min. - 5, Larry Fitzgerald, Arz. - 5, Arian Foster, Hou - 4 and Devonta Freeman, Atl. - 4).

PURDY GOOD

- With the win last week vs. Dal. (1/22/23 - NFC-D), QB **Brock Purdy** became the 3rd rookie QB in NFL history to win 2 postseason games (QB Mark Sanchez, NYJ and QB Joe Flacco, Bal.).
- With a win this week at Phi. (1/29/23 - NFC-C), **Purdy** would become the first rookie QB in NFL history to win 3 postseason games and the first rookie QB to win a Conference Championship.
- Purdy** has completed 37 of 59 passing atts. (62.7%) for 546 yds. and 3 TDs this postseason.
- With 27-or-more passing yds. this week, **Purdy** (546 passing yds.) would pass QB Russell Wilson, Sea. (572) for the most postseason passing yds. by a rookie QB since 1970.
- Purdy's** 109.9 passer rating this postseason is the highest by a rookie QB in the NFL since at least 1970. He is 1 of 3 rookie QBs since at least 1970 to register a passer rating of 100.0-or-higher in the postseason (QB Dak Prescott, Dal. - 103.2 and QB Russell Wilson, Sea. - 102.4).

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- DB **Deommodore Lenoir** registered 5 tackles and 1 INT last week vs. Dal. (1/22/23 - NFC-D). Along with 1 INT vs. Sea. (1/14/23 - NFC-WC), **Lenoir** became the 8th member of the 49ers to register 1-or-more INTs in consecutive postseason games and first to do so since CB Richard Sherman.
- With 1 INT this week at Phi. (1/29/23 - NFC-C), **Lenoir** would join DB Eric Davis as the only members of the 49ers in franchise history to register 1-or-more INTs in 3-consecutive postseason games.
- With 13 pts. last week vs. Dal. (1/22/23 - NFC-D), K **Robbie Gould** (81 pts.) passed K Mike Cofer (78) for the 2nd-most pts. in franchise postseason history. Only trailing WR Jerry Rice (114) for the franchise record.
