McCAFFREY'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Comes from a football family. His father, Ed, played WR in the NFL for 13 seasons with the New York Giants (1991-93), 49ers (1994) and Denver Broncos (1995-2003), while his brother Max played WR in the NFL for 2 seasons with the Jacksonville Jaguars (2017) and 49ers (2018). His brother Luke plays wide receiver for the Washington Commanders after being drafted by the team in 2024.
- He and Ed are 1 of 4 father-son duos to play for a father-son duo (Kyle and Mike Shanahan) in NFL History.
- Followed his parents' footsteps by attending Stanford. His mother, Lisa, played soccer and graduated in 1990. Ed played football and graduated in 1991.
- Plays the piano.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- McCaffrey claimed the NFL's rushing title in 2023 after registering 1,459 yds. on 272 carries, which were the most rushing yds. by a 49ers RB since RB Frank Gore in 2012.
- From Week 13 of 2022 vs. Mia. (12/4/22) to Week 8 of 2023 vs. Cin. (10/29/23), McCaffrey scored 1-or-more TDs in 17 consecutive games (postseason included). His 17-consecutive games with 1-or-more TDs is tied for the longest streak in NFL history.

- McCaffrey has been a member of the 49ers for 6 of those games, which gives him the most games by a 49ers player with 1-or-more rushing TD and 1-or-more rec. TD.

- In his first 30 games as a member of the 49ers (postseason included), McCaffrey scored 34 total TDs, which is tied for the 2nd-most total TDs by a player through their first 30 games with a team in NFL history, according to the Elias Sports Bureau.

- Through McCaffrey's first 7 seasons (2017-2023), he has registered the most receipts. by a RB through a players first 7 seasons in NFL history (509 receipts.). McCaffrey also holds the NFL record for most career games (11) with 10-or-more receipts. by a RB.
- McCaffrey registered 7 total TDs against the Arizona Cardinals in 2023 [4 total TDs vs. Arz. (10/1/23); 3 total TDs at Arz. (12/17/23)]. His 7 total TDs against the Cardinals are tied for the most TDs against a team in a single season in the Super Bowl Era.

- McCaffrey is 1 of 3 players in NFL history to record 2,000-or-more yds. from scrimmage in a season for two different teams (HOF RB Eric Dickerson, LAR/Ind.; HOF RB Marshall Faulk, StL/Ind.).

- McCaffrey is 1 of 3 players to register 1,000-or-more rushing yds. and 100-or-more receipts. in a single season. He has accomplished the feat twice [2018 (1,098 rushing yds. & 107 receipts.) & 2019 (1,387 rushing yds. and 116 receipts.)]. His 116 receipts. in 2019 are the most by an RB in NFL history. He is the only RB in NFL history to produce multiple seasons with 100-or-more receipts.

- McCaffrey is the only RB in NFL history to register 4 seasons with 5-or-more TD receipts. (2017-2018, 2022-2023).
- McCaffrey reeled in 1-or-more receipts. in each of his first 57 games in the NFL, tied for the longest stretch by a RB in NFL history.
- In just 57 games, McCaffrey became the fastest player in NFL history to total 3,000 career rushing yds. and 3,000 career rec. yds.
- In 2019, McCaffrey registered 287 carries for 1,387 yds. and 15 TDs as well as 116 receipts. for 1,005 yds. and 4 TDs. He became 1 of 3 RBs in NFL history to record 1,000-or-more rushing yds. and 1,000-or-more rec. yds. in a single season.

GOLDMINE

- McCaffrey founded the Christian McCaffrey Foundation shortly after entering the NFL. The foundation's mission is to serve as a catalyst for the community and country by supporting those who sacrifice daily for the benefit of many. We show up for our servicemen and women for standing at the front of the most critical challenges of our time. Since its inception, McCaffrey's foundation has expanded beyond the military. In addition to working to prevent veteran suicide, the foundation supports front line workers, serves underserved youth and provides support to children undergoing medical treatment.
- His foundation's Logan Project strives to connect children going through medical treatment through gaming in honor of Logan Hale, a fan of McCaffrey who passed away after a battle with cancer in 2021. "I found out he had been buried in my jersey, and I just kind of broke down. That hit me like a ton of bricks. I found out he wanted to do this while he was going through what he was going through. I was extremely determined to make that happen." After reading Hale's obituary, which mentioned his video game dream, McCaffrey decided to put his vision into action. "I know Logan would be over the moon, to see this actually come true," Hale's mother, Kristina, said. "But most of all because his favorite player, the person he admired the most, is making it come true."

**GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)**

- McCaffrey returns home to Denver annually each June to help staff his father's Dare to Play football camp. Dare to Play partners with the Global Down Syndrome Foundation to ensure people with Down Syndrome have the ability to play the game of football. McCaffrey has been a counselor at Dare to Play since he was a freshman in high school in 2010. Since then, the camp has given hundreds of people with down syndrome an opportunity to play.

- Started in 16 games and registered 272 carries for 1,459 yds. and 14 TDs on the ground to go along with 67 receipts. for 564 yds. and 7 TDs through the air.
- Registered 22 carries for a season-high 152 yds. and 1 TD at Pit. (9/10).
- Tallied 20 carries for 116 yds. and 1 TD. at LAR (9/17), marking the 6th time in his career that he rushed for 100-or-more yds. in back-to-back games.
- Registered 18 carries for 85 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 5 receipts. for 30 yds. vs. NYG (9/21).

- With 3 rushing TDs and 1 rec. TD vs. Arz. (10/1), McCaffrey joined former RB Tevin Coleman as 1 of 2 players in franchise history to score 3 rushing TDs and 1 rec. TD in the same game.
- McCaffrey's 4 TDs vs. Arz. (10/1) marked a career-high and the most TDs recorded in a single game by a 49ers player since RB Tevin Coleman in 2019 [4 TDs vs. Car. (10/27/19)].
- McCaffrey's 3 TDs in the first half vs. Arz. (10/1) marked the first time in his career that he has scored 3-or-more TDs in one half.

- With 177 yds. from scrimmage and 4 TDs vs. Arz. (10/1), McCaffrey became the first player in 49ers franchise history to tally 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage and 1 TD in each game in Weeks 1-4 and the first NFL player to accomplish the feat since former Dallas Cowboys RB DeMarco Murray in 2014.
- Became 1 of 4 NFL players in the Super Bowl Era to post 70-or-more rushing yds., 3-or-more rushing TDs, 70-or-more rec. yds. and 1-or-more rec. TDs in the same game after his performance vs. Arz. (10/1).
- Registered 19 carries for 51 yds. and 1 TD on the ground to go along with 2 receipts. for 27 yds. through the air vs. Dal (10/8).

- With a 13-yd. rec. TD at Cle. (10/15/23), a 35-yd. rec. TD at Min. (10/23/23) and a 4-yd. rec. TD vs. Cin. (10/29), McCaffrey became the first 49ers RB to register 1-or-more rec. TDs in 3-consecutive games since RB Jeff Moore in 1982 [1 rec. TD vs. NO (11/28/92); 2 rec. TDs at LAR (12/2/1982); 1 rec. TD vs. SD (12/11/82)].
- With a rushing TD and rec. TD at Min. (10/23/23) and 1 rushing TD and 1 rec. TD vs. Cin. (10/29), McCaffrey became the 1st member of the 49ers to register 1-or-more rushing TDs and 1-or-more rec. TDs in back-to-back games in franchise history.

- Registered 19 carries for 114 yds. and 2 TDs on the ground to go along with 5 catches for 25 yds. through the air at Sea. (11/23).
- His 114 yds. at Sea. (11/23) gave him 4 games in 2023 with 100-or-more rushing yds. and mark the 19th such game of his career.
- McCaffrey's rush TDs marked his 11th of the season and gave him 49 in his career. It also marked his 2nd game in 2023 with 2-or-more rush TDs and the 10th such game of his career.
