

San Francisco 49ers at Jacksonville Jaguars Game Notes Sunday, October 27, 2013

With the Win...

- The 49ers improved to 14-6 on the road since head coach Jim Harbaugh took over in 2011, tying New England Patriots head coach, Bill Belichick, for 1st in the NFL in road win percentage during that span (.700).
- The **49ers** improved their all-time record against the Jaguars to 2-2, and moved to 2-0 all-time at Wembley Stadium, becoming only the second NFL team ever to win multiple games in London (New England 2).
- The 49ers recorded their fifth consecutive double-digit victory for the first time since 1995.
- The **49ers**' five-game winning streak is the second-longest active winning streak in the NFL (Kansas City 8).
- Head coach **Jim Harbaugh** improved his record against AFC South opponents to 3-1.
- **Harbaugh** improved his overall record to 30-9-1 as a head coach, since he made his NFL head-coaching debut in 2011, becoming the fourth-fastest head coach to reach 30 wins since the merger in 1970.

- **Harbaugh** improved to 10-2 in his coaching career against the AFC, giving him the best record by a current NFC head coach against the AFC.
- Harbaugh improved to 11-1 in the month of October since taking over in 2011.

Double Duty

QB Colin Kaepernick and RB Frank Gore each registered 2 rushing TDs, marking the first time the 49ers had a quarterback and running each run for 2 TDs in the same game since 10/1/61 (QB Billy Kilmer – 2 TDs and HB-FB J.D. Smith – 2 TDs). The last time it happened in the NFL was on 11/9/03 (SD QB Doug Flutie – 2 TDs and RB LaDainian Tomlinson – 2 TDs).

Turning Takeaways Into Points

- Over the past five games, the 49ers have forced 13 turnovers and have scored off of every takeaway (9 TDs, 4 FGs).
- LB **Patrick Willis** tallied his 2nd FF of the season, 16th of his career, as he stripped the ball from TE Marcedes Lewis. The fumble was picked up by LB **Dan Skuta** and returned 33-yds. for a TD. It marked Skuta's first career TD and first career FR.

Owning The Red Zone

• The **49ers offense** scored a TD on all 5 trips to the red zone (4 rushing, 1 passing). It marks the most red zone TDs in a single game by the 49ers since 11/16/08 (5 TDs on 5 trips to the red zone vs. StL).

Lighting Up The Scoreboard

• The **49ers** have scored 30-or-more points in each of the last 5 games, tying the franchise record. The team also accomplished this feat in 1994 and 1997.

The 49ers scored 28 points in the first half, the most by the team in the first half since 12/12/10 vs. Sea. (30 points). The 28 points are the most by the 49ers in either half since 10/7/12 vs. Buf. (28 points – 2nd half).

Moving The Chains

- The **49ers** converted 6 of 9 third down conversions (66.7 pct.), the highest third down percentage by the team since 12/14/03 (6 for 9 66.7 pct. at Cin.).
- San Francisco also converted 2 of 2 attempts on 4th down.

Ground & Pound

• The **49ers** rushed for 221 yds. and 4 TDs on 38 carries at Jax., the most rushing yds. in a game by the team this season and the 4th most in the NFL.

• The **49ers** 4 rushing TDs are the most by any team in a game in the NFL season.

Keeping 'Em Clean

• The 49ers offensive line did not allow a sack on 17 total attempts by QB Colin Kaepernick and QB Colt McCoy. The last time the 49ers did not allow a sack was 11/25/12 at NO.

Gore Keeps Making History

- RB **Frank Gore** rushed for 71 yds. and 2 TDs on 19 carries, marking his 10th-career game with 2 rushing TDs. It also marked the first time in his career that Gore registered 2 rushing TDs in consecutive games.
- With 71 rushing yds., **Gore** now has 9,457 career rushing yds., and ranks 29th in NFL history, moving past RB **Shaun Alexander** (9,452) and RB **Earl Campbell** (9,407).

Kapitalizing

- QB **Colin Kaepernick** completed 10 of 16 passes for 164 yds. with 1 TD and a passer rating of 117.7. The 49ers are 10-0 when Kaepernick has a passer rating of 90.0 or higher (min. 10 atts.).
- **Kaepernick** also had 7 carries for 54 yds. (7.7 avg.) and 2 TDs, marking his first career game with 2 rushing TDs.

Kendall Notches Career-High

• RB **Kendall Hunter** rushed for a career-high 84 yds. on 9 carries (9.3 avg.). His previous career-high was 81 yds. vs. Buf. (10/7/12).

Miller High Life

• FB **Bruce Miller** set a career-high with 56 rec. yds. on the day. He hauled in a 43-yd. recept., setting a new career-long. His previous career-long came on a 30-yd. TD recept. at Was. (11/6/11).
