## Turning Takeaways Into Points

• Over the past 7 games, the **49ers** have forced 18 takeaways and have converted each one into points (11 TDs, 7 FGs).

# Special Teams Takeaways

- The 49ers special teams unit has registered a takeaway in 3 of the last 4 games.
- S Bubba Ventrone recovered a muffed punt by Saints WR Lance Moore at the Saints 11-yd. line. It marked Ventrone's first special teams FR of the season and 2<sup>nd</sup> of his career. The takeaway led to an 11-yd. TD pass by QB Colin Kaepernick to WR Anguan Boldin.

# Brooks Gets Picky In The Big Easy

• LB **Ahmad Brooks** picked off Saints QB Drew Brees, marking his first INT of the season and 3<sup>rd</sup> of his career. Brooks' last INT came last season at NO (11/25/12). The INT led to a 17-yd. TD pass from QB **Colin Kaepernick** to TE **Vernon Davis**.

#### Dawson's Big Boot

Following a fumble by Saints CB Corey White out of the end zone, the 49ers engineered a 6-play, 43-yd. drive that was capped off by a 55-yd. FG by K Phil Dawson. The 55-yd. FG was the longest of the season for Dawson and 2<sup>nd</sup> longest of his career [56-yd. FG at Buf. (11/17/08)].

#### Davis Climbs The Charts

- TE **Vernon Davis** notched his 8<sup>th</sup> TD of the season on a 17-yd. pass from QB **Colin Kaepernick**.
- Davis now has 48 career TD recepts. and is tied with WR Dwight Clark (48) for the most receiving TDs in franchise history.

With a start against the Saints, RB Frank Gore has now started 38 consecutive games, which is the longest current streak among active RBs. He also broke a tie and moved past RB Ken Willard for the 2<sup>nd</sup> most games played by a RB in franchise history with 125 games.
