With The Win...

- The **49ers** improved to 66-64-3 all-time against the Rams, including a 33-32-2 record at home.
- The **Niners** have now won their ninth-consecutive regular season home finale, the longest winning streak in home finales in the NFL.

- **San Francisco** has split the season series with St. Louis for the second consecutive season.

Overtime Victory

- The **49ers** registered their second overtime win of the season, marking the first time the team has won two overtime games in the same season since 2004 [31-28 vs. Arz. (10/10/04); 31-28 at Arz. (12/12/04)].

Racking Up The Yards

- The **49ers offense** amassed 458 net yds. of total offense (108 rushing, 350 passing), the most by the 49ers since 9/8/13 vs. GB (494 net yds. – 90 rushing, 404 passing).

Harris Fills Up The Stat Box

- RB **DuJuan Harris** rushed for a team-high 67 yds. on 16 carries and also set career highs in repts. (8) and rec. yds. (86). He became the first player to lead the team in both rushing and receiving yds. in the same game since RB Frank Gore vs. Sea. [16-131 rushing & 5-51 receiving (10/18/12)].

Blaine's Big Day

- QB **Blaine Gabbert** completed 28 of 44 atts., for a career-high 354 yds. and 1 TD.

Q Goes For 6

- WR **Anquan Boldin** caught a 33-yd. TD pass from QB Blaine Gabbert for his 4th TD recept. of the season and 74th of his career.
- **Boldin** finished the game with 5 receipts. for 71 yds. and 1 TD.

Bowman Forces His First of the Year

- LB **NaVorro Bowman** forced a Rams RB Tre Mason fumble on the first series of the game. It marked his first FF of the season and 6th of his career.

Dawson Continues To Climb Record Books

- K **Phil Dawson** connected on all 4 FGAs, including the 23-yd. FG in overtime to win the game. **Dawson** has now made 386 career FGs, ranking t-9th in NFL history.

**Head Coach Jim Tomsula
Press Conference – January 3, 2016
San Francisco 49ers vs. St. Louis Rams**

Opening comments:

"We don't have any injuries to report. The only thing we had was [FB] Bruce Miller had a thigh contusion and got him out there, they rubbed it out and got it loosened up and he went back in there."

Obviously there's a lot of stuff out there, reports, about your future. Have you talked to ownership? Do you know what your future is?

"I have not talked to ownership. Haven't had any conversations of the such. Wouldn't expect to until the season is over. What I would like to say to everybody is: I'm not going to make this about Jim and Jim's job status here today. OK? I've got a group of guys here, players that just won a football game. They've been through a very tough season. They've stuck together and went and won a game in overtime and they fought like crazy. Today is all about those players. My job status and anything going forward there can be handled throughout the rest of the week."

Did you have to address any of that with your players to get them in the frame of mind to play?

"Zero. Nothing."

Just for the record, do you have a meeting scheduled with ownership tonight or tomorrow?

"I do not. So, I'll have to talk about the players."

What did today say about the character of your players in a game that for all intents and purposes is meaningless, the way they fought to the very end?

"That's what has excited me with the multitude of questions I've gotten about the team and the guys. A lot of you aren't there to see it in practice, but that is one really good group of players. The intangibles in that locker room are where the San Francisco 49ers want to be. There is a core group of individuals that this game is really important to them. The 49ers organization is extremely important to them and their fan base is extremely important to them and the game of football is extremely important to them. They get along really well. They enjoy working together and they are growing together. So, what you saw there in the fight and the way they work, that's what we see Monday through Saturday with that group of guys."

Would you say that their effort today reflects well on the coaching staff?

"I really believe in this coaching staff, the guys that are here. They are very good people. Again, when you go through tough seasons, which we all do or have if you've coach in this thing, what happens is you start getting one-offs and spinoffs. The season pulls at you. What we see all the time in the media is the breaks in the dam. There are no breaks in that dam, whether it be players or coaches."

You had a chance to kick a 55-yard field goal in overtime. You went with a punt instead. What went into that thinking? Did K Phil Dawson's maximum--?

"We probably could have. But, kicking that way with the wind, we had talked about that before the game. So, I didn't want to do that."

What's your evaluation of what you saw with QB Blaine Gabbert, especially this game, but just the last several weeks?

"Well, my opinion of Blaine Gabbert is two-fold. The first thing that I say about Blaine Gabbert is the way he works and the way he goes after it. His skill level, I think is there. He's the kind of guy you want to go to work with every day. Secondly, I will say he has still got a high ceiling. He's not maxed out. So, he's a guy that can continue to improve."

What'd you see from RB DuJuan Harris today?

"He ran like heck. I don't know how many yards he had, but catching and running. That's the thing I'll say too is here this guy comes in two weeks ago. The personnel department did a nice job with [RB Shaun] Draughn coming in. We've had guys come in, talented guys and the right kind of guys. Last week he was running the ball he had been working for three days trying to learn the offense and the alerts and all that stuff and worked hard at it. Again, this week, getting after it, you saw him more in the passing game. So, hats off to him and his efforts."

It seemed like LB Ahmad Brooks had some time on the bench after his penalty. What was the thinking there and was anything said to him?

"Just calm down."

Do you miss not having a game next week or are you ready for this season to end and what have you enjoyed most about coaching this team despite the record?

"Well, what I enjoyed most about coaching, to me football is people. Everybody makes the game and talks about football and the game and all that kind of stuff. It's the people that make up the game and there's a lot of good people at the San Francisco 49ers."

Will you miss not having a game to coach next week?

"Yeah, you do this to coach."

What does that mean to you to finish off the season on this winning note?

"Well, my first initial reaction to that is it's what we talk about in games all the time. Starting fast and ending strong is good, but everything in the middle counts too. That's the way we approach it. But, these guys, again, just the journey and the way they've stuck together and the way they've worked through. I mean, heck they were getting blasted before the season started. It was last June they were getting hammered. Talked about how bad they were going to be and this and that. They really just kept fighting and working together. So, it's a really good group."

Is this organization and this team in a better spot now than when the season started?

"Oh, I think so. That's my opinion. Yeah."

How so?

"Well, it's the growth, the growth of the guys. Again, lessons learned. We always talk about the sword being sharp on both sides. So, you've got to make sure that you know what you're doing."

I was just going to say, a lot of young guys auditioning today. That seemed to exemplify itself in the way the hitting was going on out there. A lot of hard hits. A lot of emotion.

"Yeah. I don't know that we had anybody in there playing that hadn't played most of the year. We've had our struggles in different areas that we've had to keep cleaning up and work through. But, these guys, they work hard. They work at it. It's important to them."

Do you deserve a chance to come back for a second season and see this process through?

"Well, you're a coach. You always think that. How you think about that and those things, that's irrelevant."

49ers QB Blaine Gabbert

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Second overtime win this season, what did you take away from this one?

“It was a lot of fun. I’m just so proud of the guys, the way they fought the entire game. There’s a lot of ups and downs, adversity. I didn’t play particularly well at times but our offense, defense and specials teams really stepped up big time when we needed to.”

On the big 3rd down receptions by WR Torrey Smith and WR Anquan Boldin. What was it about the passing game this game?

“They did a tremendous job getting open in man coverage. Like I said, when a play needed to be made, those guys stepped up huge, especially at the end and in overtime. [WR] Quinton [Patton] catching the screen against that blitz and taking it down to the five-yard line and [K] Phil [Dawson] kicking a nice field goal. But, yeah, there’s going to be, like I said, ups and downs in the game but the guys just have to trust me that I’ll deliver the ball in the right spot at the right time and they made huge plays when it counted.”

That was a tricky situation when you were taking the kneel down and you’re so close to your end zone. What was going through your mind and what was discussed then?

“Yeah, we were on like the six-inch line, that’s being conservative, but I just couldn’t lose any yards. So, it really wasn’t a kneel, it was kind of diving through [G/C] Daniel’s [Kilgore] legs. Luckily, we got it down. There were trying to burn timeouts to push us back. We ended getting a 15-yard penalty, which made it a lot easier. But, our offensive line did a tremendous job protecting me in that situation.”

What did you learn about yourself returning to action after basically two years on the sideline and getting these eight starts late in the season?

“A lot. It just came down to going out there and doing it. I trusted my guys, they played extremely well. I just wanted to go out there and lead them to the best of my ability, provide a little spark to this football team, a little juice to this offense. The season didn’t go the way we wanted it to but the way we finished strong, came out there, finished the season with the win, speaks volumes for our players.”

You started eight games but you’ve had three different running backs start with you. Has that been difficult, kind of establishing chemistry, rapport with those guys? It seemed like you had that today with RB DuJuan Harris.

“Yeah, DuJuan did a tremendous job. [RB] Mike Davis came back, played well. [RB] Kendall Gaskins, [FB] Bruce Miller, the guys stepped up and really made the most of their opportunities. DuJuan had a tremendous game today and it’s always that mindset of the next man up. Injuries are always going to happen in the NFL. We know that but like I said, when your opportunity presents itself, you’ve got to make the most of it and our running backs definitely did that.”

What did head coach Jim Tomsula say to you guys in the locker room after this one?

“He was just proud of the way we fought, the way we won the game and the way we finished the season on a high note. And that’s big for this football team getting momentum going into the offseason.”

Did he address his own status with you guys?

“No, and I’m not going to address any of the rumors or speculations. Nothing has been said. Biggest thing is I don’t want make light of the fact we got a win today and that’s huge against a good division opponent. We definitely don’t take wins for granted. I want that to be the focal point leaving here.”

What do you enjoy about playing for Jim and his staff this year?

"I'm just appreciative of the opportunity that they gave me. They trusted me. That takes a lot, especially coming into this situation. When he told me I was getting the nod heading into that Atlanta week, I was ready to roll and I didn't want to let those guys down because they put their necks on the line for me. I'm extremely appreciative of that and I just tried to make the most of my opportunity."

Consensus in the locker room seems to be that you guys all like Jim and want him back. What is it about him as a coach that makes you guys--?

"He's a fiery coach. Provides the energy and enthusiasm on a daily basis that the players thrive off of. The competitive nature that he instills in us that we try and take to the football field. It's been a lot of fun to play for, and I'm just thankful that he gave me the opportunity to start for the 49ers."

Do you expect to be the starting quarterback next year?

"Like I said, I'm just glad we got a win today and all the future things that are going to happen are unknown. But, I just wanted to put the best player that I could out on the field today and get a win and whatever happens, happens."

How much would you like to be here and at least have a chance to compete for that start?

"I'm going to compete. That's in my blood, that's who I am as a person: I'm going to be the starting quarterback, I'm going to be a starting quarterback, and that's the way I'm approaching this offseason. Regardless of what happens, that's my mindset moving forward and I'm going to take this team and run with it."

What does this win say about the team?

"It says that we have a team that's going to keep fighting. A team that's willing to play whenever we need to. I just wanted to relate to the guys to come out today and play for one another and that's what we did."

Obviously there was a lot of talk in the past day about the future of San Francisco 49ers head coach Jim Tomsula. Do you have any thoughts if this were his final game?

"I'll leave that to upstairs. It's all about the game today. I've been with Jimmy my whole career and it's always been a good time with him. Today we won a game and let's give him some praise for that. Let's not talk about the rumor or whatever was said."

Do you feel like this franchise is a little bit in limbo until you know or do you feel comfortable with the direction of the franchise?

"I'm always comfortable with the direction. I trust the 49ers operation and I'm always going to give it 110-percent every time I step on the field."

With all the turnover that you guys had from last year to this year do you feel that throughout the season there was a lot of progress made?

"Yes, I definitely did. That's what I've been saying all year. The expectation was so high due to what we've built in the past years. Trying to express that to the young guys as the season was going on, that was a stepping stool for us as a team. We were so young but we kept fighting and kept studying that I believe progress was made."

You had a pretty long chat with San Francisco 49ers general manager Trent Baalke on the practice field a couple days ago. What was the context of that?

"Just keep working and we will get it right in his words. I trust in Trent and I know that he will."

What does this mean to you to have the kind of season you had coming back from such a serious injury?

"It meant a lot. To get out there and move the way I was moving prior to the injury and receive the respect I've received from players throughout the league continued to motivate me and drive me. I didn't get down on the missed tackles that I made. I had several missed tackles this year where I felt I could have made them but I didn't. Guys were still pushing me and saying that I was doing a good job. All of those things continue to drive me to fight throughout the year."

Did Tomsula bring up the situation to you guys at all today or the last few days or even tell you not to think about it?

"No."

You mentioned the progress you thought you made. Do you think Jim Tomsula is the right guy to be back in 2016?

"I love him. He's been with me my whole career like I said and we won the last game. The way things have been going for the team to come out and play like we did today, I think it says a lot about his direction throughout this process. As the season has been going up and down, the players have responded to how he has coached throughout the week. The evidence we got was today."

You played every game, darn near every snap. Have you given yourself a chance to look ahead and think of what type of player you could be in 2016?

"Probably since Week 8 I've put the pressure on myself to go into this offseason and get back to the form I was once at and this body will be put through a tremendous workout every single day."

What do you think happened this season that the record ended up like this?

"It was 16 games so there are 16 different reasons. We finished strong today and kept our heads forward. It's not about how you start it's about how you finish and I'm proud of my guys today."

Did you feel like you saved your best for last of the four field goals?

"No, that's just the job. Some days you're out there once or twice and some days you're out there more. Today was one of those days where the offense got it down there. I have to credit the offense. I think three of the kicks came on the tough end today and they understood that and got it in there to make it a more high percentage kick, so they deserve a lot of credit today."

Is that why you guys didn't attempt a field goal at the end of regulation, because that was the tougher end?

"Correct. 55 yards into the wind, St. Louis had two timeouts, a minute something else. That's a low percentage kick. Not saying you can't get it there but that's a low percentage kick. If you miss that now they're two first downs away from kicking a 50 yard field goal with the wind at their back and they have a strong leg kicker. It's not always as simple as whether your guy can make it. You have to think about how much time is on the clock, what the conditions are today and who the other team's kicker is. I think it was absolutely the right call."

You've been there many times before trotting out there knowing the game hinges on what you do and it was a chip shot but still what goes through your mind at that moment?

"That particular kick, given the fact that it was way down in there, it was to get it up and get it out fast. [TE/LS] Kyle [Nelson] gave a perfect snap and [P] Bradley [Pinion] literally had to put the ball down, didn't have to spin it or anything. That allowed me to really come at it with some tempo and get it up in the air quickly so those guys deserve a lot of credit."

Is there any thinking when you trot out there that this could be it for you?

"No. I'm just trying to make the next kick. It's all about the next kick. I've missed kicks shorter than that and obviously didn't want to do that today so I just focused on what I needed to do and the guys around me did a great job and were able to execute."

"Well, that's a tough way to end it. You know, as I said in practice, if you play hard in games like this you've got to find a way to make plays and they made plays. There were good opportunities to catch the ball, we had opportunities to kick a winning field goal, and it didn't happen. I'm disappointed for the players because of the work they put in, especially over the last couple of weeks. We had a huge win for us last week, and then the focus that we got out of them this week in preparation it's just one of those things that happened. And, you congratulate [San Francisco 49ers head] coach Jim [Tomsula] and the good job that they did. Their team raised the bar in all three phases, and we gave up plays in all three phases. We dropped balls. We gave up big plays defensively and had a couple special teams' penalties, and then we had difficulty kicking field goals. That's pretty much the difference. We're going to regroup tomorrow. We have our exit physicals and then we will have our final team meeting at 1

o'clock, and go from there. So, just a little bit of detail on [St. Louis Rams RB] Todd [Gurley] and his status, he's got a mild turf toe. Nothing that's going to set him back, nothing that's going to be a problem for him, but we didn't feel like it was necessary to mess with it and create the possibility where we could damage the joint a little bit more. So, we decided to hold him today."

How much did it hurt not having Todd out there today?

"Well, I mean we missed a lot of players out there today. We missed a lot of players. No more excuses, but [St. Louis Rams DE] Rob Quinn's a good football player, so is [St. Louis Rams LB Alec] Ogletree and [St. Louis Rams CB Trumaine Johnson] TJ. So, it's hard to say. I don't know. They're a stout front. Disregard their rankings, their rushing defense, they're a stout front. They're hard to move. When they anticipate run, they play it well. They're sturdy. We ran the ball, and we had over 100 yards rushing. We had the big play by [St. Louis Rams HB] Benny Cunningham. It's just hard. I'm just disappointed for them, because once [St. Louis Rams WR] Kenny [Britt] made the catch, we got down there and said, 'Okay, let's run three times and not give up any minus yards and kick the field goal and go home' and we weren't able to do it."

What happened on that field goal, any breakdowns?

"I know a guy came off the edge and made a great play. So, I don't know if they, I'll have to look at it. And, [St. Louis Rams DE] Will [Hayes]'s still upset, because he said he was pushed off the block and pushed into the quarterback's legs, so we'll look at it and see."

How disappointing is it for you and your team to not get to that 800, 8-8 threshold?

"Well, it's very disappointing. We've had numerous opportunities earlier in the year, and we didn't get it done. We lost close games. So, we've got to get past that."

How do you paint the picture? How do you describe the season? 7-9, didn't make the playoffs, some bright spots, and obviously--?

"Yeah, there's a lot of bright spots. We had a good group of young players. An offensive line for the future, a running back for the future. We've got a really good special teams typically. [St. Louis Rams K] Greg [Zuerlein] had a rough year, but a lot of his were over 50, and that's what the one earlier today, but we got a good group, good core. You look back and you say, 'Alright, I'm fine being 4-2 in the division and I'm not alright with some of the other losses that took place.' I never will be."

A lot of big plays on defense, any general--?

"We gave up, defense gave up big plays? Yeah we did. We did give up some plays. That's not characteristic of us."

Now that the season is over, it just ended, can you kind of shed a little light on what it's been like for you and your staff to calm down the LA talk over the course of the season, because it's been everywhere else.

"It's been everywhere else but in our building. We've not addressed it. Until we know what's going on there's no need to discuss. So, we'll just wait and see what happens. I've been through this before. That's how you handle these things. You just don't let it be a distraction. It wasn't a distraction for our players. It's not a distraction nor was it since."

Do you allow yourself to think about it now, now that you're done with the games?

"This game ended about 20 minutes ago. So, I've got injury issues, and check out physicals, and all those things we have to deal with. And we'll see where we are."

Was St. Louis Rams DT Michael Brockers okay?

"Yes, he came back. He just rolled his ankle."
