San Francisco 49ers vs. Los Angeles Rams

Game Notes

Thursday, September 21, 2017

Putting Up Points

- The **49ers offense** scored 39 points on the day, the most by the team since 10/27/13 at Jax. (London - 42 points).
- The **49ers** also scored 26 points in the second half, the most second half points scored by the team since 12/23/13 vs. Atl. (31 points in the second half).

Hoyer Throws For 300

- QB **Brian Hoyer** completed 23 of 37 atts. for 332 yds., 2 TDs, 1 INT and a QB rating of 98.0. His 332 passing yds. marked the second-highest single-game total in his career [397 yds. at Ind. (10/9/16)]. It also marked **Hoyer's** 10th career 300-yd. passing game and first as a member of the 49ers.
- **Hoyer** also registered a 9-yd. TD run in the 1st qtr. It marked the 2nd rushing TD of his career, and first since his NFL debut with the New England Patriots (10/18/09 – 1 yd. TD).

Garçon Shines Under The Lights

- WR **Pierre Garçon** hauled in 7 receipts. for 142 yds., the sixth-best single-game total of his career.

- It marked his 16th career 100-yd. game and first since 11/20/16 vs. GB.

Hyde Matches Career High

- RB **Carlos Hyde** finished the game with 25 carries for 84 yds. and 2 TDs, tying his career high. It marked the 4th time Hyde rushed for 2 TDs in a game and the first time since 9/25/16 at Sea.

Trent “The Touchdown” Taylor

- WR **Trent Taylor** registered his first-career TD on a 3-yd. pass from QB **Brian Hoyer**. Taylor finished the game with 3 receipts. for 32 yds. a 1 TD.

Celek Finds Paydirt

- QB **Brian Hoyer** connected with TE **Garrett Celek** for a 1-yd. TD receipt. It marked Celek's 1st TD receipt. of the season and 7th of his career.

Juice Gets To 100

- FB **Kyle Juszczyk** notched a 34-yd. receipt., marking the 100th receipt. of his career.

Special Plays On Special Teams

- LS **Kyle Nelson** recovered a muffed punt by Rams WR Tavon Austin, marking the first special teams FR of his career. Nelson's FR led to a K **Robbie Gould** 36-yd. FG.
- WR **Victor Bolden Jr.** notched his first-career special teams FF, knocking the ball loose from Rams WR Pharoah Cooper. The fumble was recovered by WR **Aldrick Robinson**, marking his first-career special teams FR. The takeaway led to a 1-yd. TD run by RB **Carlos Hyde**.
- RB **Raheem Mostert** also recovered the onside kick on the ensuing kickoff after Hyde's TD. It marked the first successful onside kick by the 49ers since 9/20/15 (Phil Dawson kick recovered by LB Nick Bellore vs. Cin.).

Buckner Forces The Issue

- DL **DeForest Buckner** forced a Rams RB Todd Gurley III fumble, the first FF of his career.

On the two-point play, was it strictly called for WR Trent Taylor or were there other options on that?

"No. [WR] Pierre [Garçon] was number one in the progression. They played it pretty good. [WR] Marquise [Goodwin] was number two. Trent was number three."

You had to call a timeout before that and the play before that. Were you having a hard time getting the play call? What was going on there?

"No, the last one, [QB] Brian [Hoyer] slowed down with the clock. The receiver came out on the wrong side, so I wanted to make sure to get him right. It was too big of a call to trust that they were on the same page, so I called a timeout."

The offensive pass interference call (on WR Trent Taylor), critical to the game. Did you see it? Did you watch it?

"No, I didn't see it. They didn't show it up on the screen, so I never saw it."

After Brian's interception to start the game, you had an exchange with him on the sideline. Can you, what was your message to him at that point in the game?

"I just told him, 'Let's start over.' It was the first play of the game. We were hoping to get him a completion early, get one to Marquise there but the corner made a great play. He jumped it. He made a good play on it and we had to go back to work. We didn't change anything. Went right on with the script. It was a tough way to start out, but I thought he did a good job leading us down on the score and making a play to get us in the end zone on that next drive."

What did he show you maybe the whole rest of the game? The way he bounced back from that?

"It was a tough way to start, the situation we were in, especially after Sunday vs. Seattle. I knew it was going to be tough. We wanted to come out here and play well. To start out with the first play as a pick, basically a pick six, I think they took it to the two. I knew that was going to be tough, so I just went up and talked to him, looked in his eyes, he looked fine. He said, 'I'm ready to go. I'll be alright.' He responded pretty well the next drive."

Do you think the Seattle game had an effect on this game? Did you see your guys sluggish or not quite ready to begin the game?

"I don't know. You never know what the reasons are. We definitely didn't begin the game well. I don't know exactly why that was, we got off to that turnover. I know they scored on most of their early drives to start the game. So, I know we started pretty slow on defense too, but the guys kept fighting and I was proud of the guys in the locker room. I thought they battled to the end, but definitely didn't get the result we wanted."

A whole lot of big plays after not getting much offense the first couple weeks. What was the difference this game?

"We had more opportunities, had some better looks, guys made some big plays. It's a matter of time. We went against a couple tough defenses the first two weeks. This was a challenge too. They have a lot of good players over there. They made plays also, but our guys responded. I think our guys felt pretty strongly that we didn't play to our capabilities the first couple weeks. By no means did we today either, but I thought we did improve at least on the offensive side of the ball."

There was a sequence in the first half when you were inside the five, gave the ball to RB Carlos Hyde three straight times. You guys didn't make it. How much did that influence later sequences when you seemed to mix it up a little bit more with the play calling?

"Everything influences everything throughout the game. Each play matters, how they play stuff. We lost our fullback in the second half, which changes some stuff up too. The type of runs you can run. When you get into the redzone, especially inside the five-yard line there's lots of fronts and coverages people can play and send all out blitzes. And if you don't have a fullback then you're going to be outnumbered. Or if you don't use your quarterback as runner, you're going to be outnumbered. They put you in a bind in some spots where they force you to pass and you still aren't going to do it every time, but you've got to mix it up based off some of the looks you're getting."

End of the first quarter into the second, where QB C.J. Beathard really looked like he was warming up and you did talk to Hoyer. Was there any thought of making a change?

"No, there was never a thought of making a change. I didn't even see that Beathard warmed up. I'm sure he did because after the personal foul, Brian was on the ground for a little bit. We didn't know if he was alright when he was laying there. You don't have much time. I don't know, I'm sure [quarterbacks coach] Rich [Scangarello] told our backup to warm up. So, I'm sure that's what happened, but Brian popped back and was able to finish the game."

Do you have a sense of the seriousness Juszczyk's injury?

"I think it was a concussion. I'm not sure. I know they told me that he was out. I don't get much information on it. I just know that it was a concussion and I'll find out when I go back in. I'm sure it'll be in the protocol."

Do you think playing these games on Thursday after a short week of preparation, do you think that leads to more injuries or is it just kind of a coincidence today that there were so many?

"I don't know. I'm sure if we keep doing this for 20 more years, we can have the right stats that can show that, but I don't know what the reasons are. We lost a lot of guys during the second half, but it's a physical game, so it happens on Sundays also. I can't tell you why that is."

To lose after a miraculous fourth quarter comeback. What do you tell the guys after this game?

"I was proud of the guys, how they fought. We just need to get better. We've got 10 days until our next game. It's a division opponent in Arizona. I know we're all excited for that. Right now, it is a grind to play on Thursday, but the benefit of it is you get a little bit more time to recover. I think we do need that now, so we're going to have rehab for the guys to get healthy and try to get the players away from us for about three days. I just really challenge them to use those three days away to get their bodies and minds right, because we plan on them coming back Monday and we plan on getting better each week. I told them, 'When you're 0-3 and you're facing some adversity, you either get better or worse.' If you have mentally strong people, I believe we can get better from all this stuff and I believe we do have the right guys in that room. I don't really care about the record right now. I care about how guys are responding to it and I want these guys to come back Monday ready to go and ready to fight to get our first win."

What do you think the issue was on defense, you seemed to have a tough time generating pass rush?

"I'm not sure. Obviously, they must have blocked us well. We've got to be more relentless. We've got to get after the quarterback. I thought they did a good job of that versus Seattle. I can answer that better after I watch the tape, exactly why. It didn't seem like we did that as well today. He had a little bit more time and didn't tackle as well either."

When you miss the extra point, how does that change the dynamic of the rest of the game?

"It changes it huge. That's why we ended up having to go for two there to try to tie it up and we didn't get that done. It definitely affects it. We missed the extra point, but our special teams also did a hell of a job getting us a couple turnovers and getting that onsides kick. They were one of the reasons we were in that game."

Brian there was a third and 18 play in the 2nd quarter where you guys ran the ball for two yards to set up the field goal. Was that Head Coach Kyle Shanahan's call or did you see something at the line and check?

"It was the play call."

Any frustration?

"It's 3rd and 18 in the red area. Your chances of converting that are probably pretty low. They know that you're just trying to take the field goal. I really don't know a play that anyone could call. Maybe you bust a screen. But, that's a smart call."

On the two-point conversion there at the end Kyle said that WR Pierre Garçon was the first look there. He was covered well. Did you see WR Trent Taylor slip on that play?

"That was the same route that Trent scored on earlier. He sells an out and comes back in. He actually beat the guy out. So the guy, when he came back to run back in the guy was kind of there waiting for him. He beat the guy so well going on the out route that when he came back in I think that's kind of why the guy was there waiting for it."

Did Taylor not see that he had the out?

"It's not like a two-way go. You know what I mean. So, unfortunately he beat him on the way out and the guy when you beat him on the way out he's usually there waiting for it."

Kyle said Taylor was the third read on that particular play, why did you go there?

"Pierre was covered I think. I mean, I have to go watch the film but I'm pretty sure they had someone underneath him. He was kind of going to the back of the end zone. And, really Pierre is kind of the second read too. You're reading the first guy as he's clearing it out hoping that they jump him and get Pierre. I think both those two guys were covered. So, worked Trent. He had already scored a touchdown on that route in man-to-man coverage. He's usually pretty good at it. It was just unfortunate that he beat him outside and the guy was inside waiting for him."

To have only scored fifteen points in the first two weeks, what's it like to finally get that footing offensively?

"Well, we should've scored more. You'd like to score more touchdowns when you get in the red area. But, that was just the way it was going. We knew we had to score touchdowns. We saw that was how the game was being played. When that's the case, obviously you always want to score points when it's a close game and it's nine to six or whatever it was. You know that's the kind of game that's being played. When you go out there tonight and you know that you're going to have to score 41 just to tie it up, then that's what you have to do. Maybe you take some more chances with throwing the ball. Throwing it up to [WR] Marquise [Goodwin], letting him make a play. Calling a go to Pierre and letting him run underneath it. We just knew that we didn't have a lot of time and we had to take some big plays."

Brian you guys are built to be a run-first team really in a lot of ways. But, some of those sequences in the second half inside the five Kyle gave you an opportunity to throw as well. How much do you appreciate that confidence and how much is that due for the offense when it's making it a little hard?

"You have to do both just to keep the defense on their toes. We also knew that the defense that they play down there was tough to run against. I think that was part of it. They kind of crowd the box and man everybody up. They have a lot of people in there to try to stuff the run. We scored one of the touchdowns in goal line, and another one with [RB] Carlos [Hyde] out of the gun with a good run call. So, I think we're mixing it up well enough."

Brian what happened on that first throw of the game?

"The guy made a good play. He guessed right. We're thinking with Marquise going over there, the speed that he has, the guy's going to back way off. He just decided to sit on it so you chalk it up the guy making a good play. Making a good guess. I think that's also why we knew we were going to be able to throw it deep later because they were squatting on a lot of stuff. You chalk it up. You move on, and go play the rest of the game."

Did you tell yourself anything? Did you talk to Shanahan?

"No. Not at all. Literally, you just look at it. Tip your cap to the guy. Good guess, you made the right play. Then you go and play the rest of the game."

Did you feel like you're playing catch up the rest of the game after that play?

"Not at all. No. Obviously we don't want to put our defense in that situation on the first play of the game. That's not fair to them. But, you just go and you keep playing. The one thing that I'm proud of and that I learned is we have the right guys. We have guys that are going to give it their all. It's definitely not for lack of effort. And, we played until the end. That's what you've got to do. Especially when you're a young team. You're trying to learn how to win. It takes time. Unfortunately, it's been three games and we still haven't got a win. I think we have the right people in that locker room and the right coaches. Once we put it together it'll be good. We have to play a complete game. When the defense plays well, we've got to score points. When we play well, we all got to play together and figure out a way to win. Whatever it takes."

What's your view on the play when Trent Taylor was called for offensive pass interference?

"I don't want to get fined."

Just what you saw--?

"I don't see it because I'm thrown into a spot. In that time of the game I would think you would let people play. But I haven't seen it. I have to go and watch the film. You know what, you don't want to leave it up to the refs hands anyways. You hope you make a few plays earlier in the game to change the outcome. If it comes down to that, then that's what it is. That's what the guys job is to do."

You seem to be slinging it a lot more this game. Was that the nature of the game or did you find some level of comfort where you're like 'Hey, let's chuck it'?

"I think that was the nature of the game. The plays that were being called, just trying to execute them."

Pretty good spike when you got the first touchdown when you ran it in. Some emotion there?

"That's, I think my first rushing touchdown in eight years. The last one was a quarterback sneak. Also too, that was our first touchdown on the entire year. So, capping a long drive off and scoring, I think that was good for the whole offense really and just pumped everybody up."

You can be hard on yourself as a coach, but some of these things we have to do a better job of if we're going to consistently try to win football games. Credit to the 49ers. They did a handful of things that created our mistakes to get them back in it. It was an excellent game with a lot of good things on both sides, but there are certainly some things that we can clean up overall with our team, and I know the players will respond the right way."

What's going through your mind down the stretch when all the craziness is happening in the 4th quarter?

"Really it was just the next play. There's not a lot we can do. We talk about with our players all the time is 'what about that next play.' There are a lot of things that happen during the course of a game, but all you can control is what's next. I thought our defense did a nice job at the end. [Los Angeles Rams DT] Aaron Donald ends up making a sack and we get the ball back, and then for [Los Angeles Rams RB] Todd Gurley close out the game like he did without us having to punt in that situation was excellent. I'm really pleased with our team tonight coming away with the win, and credit to our players."

Are you exhausted right now?

"I am. That takes a toll on you. Just getting ready on a short week, and then that emotional up-and-down right there certainly wears you out. I know that I'll sleep very well tonight."

When you look at the big façade there and your name is on there with your grandfather and you get your first road win as a head coach, what does that mean to you?

Sammy on that deep ball, it was something we have worked on in practice for a long time now. For him to make that play is huge. There's a reason we went and got him and that's one of the main reasons. He's a great player and I expect him to continue to do things like that."
