



MIGUEL REVELES

OFFENSIVE ASSISTANT

4TH NFL SEASON × 4TH WITH 49ERS

Miguel Reveles is in his fourth season with the 49ers and third as an offensive assistant after initially joining the team in 2022 under the Bill Walsh Diversity Coaching Fellowship. He joined the 49ers after four seasons (2018-22) on the offensive staff at the University of La Verne.

Since joining San Francisco in 2022, Reveles has helped the offensive unit rank fifth in scoring offense (26.1 points per game), second in total offense (380.1 yards per game), sixth in rushing offense (135.5 yards per game) and seventh in passing offense (244.6 yards per game).

In his role, Reveles assists the running backs group with practice and gameplan execution. In 2024, Reveles worked closely with RB Jordan Mason and rookie draft pick RB Isaac Guerendo. Mason registered career highs in carries (153), rushing yards (789) and tied his career high with three rushing touchdowns. Guerendo appeared in 16 games and made three starts, registering 84 rushing attempts for 420 yards and four touchdowns on the ground to go along with 15 receptions for 152 yards through the air.

In 2023, Reveles worked with RB Christian McCaffrey, who earned Associated Press First-Team All-Pro honors and was named Offensive Player of the Year after leading the NFL in rushing yards (1,459), yards from scrimmage (2,023) and finishing the season tied for the most total touchdowns (21). The 49ers rushing attack averaged 140.5 yards per game that season, ranking third in the NFL.



Prior to joining the 49ers, Reveles spent four seasons (2018-21) at the University of La Verne, serving as the offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach and assistant head coach. He joined La Verne after multiple stints as a Bill Walsh Fellow, serving in the program with the Tennessee Titans (2021), Los Angeles Chargers (2019), Carolina Panthers (2014) and New York Jets (2013). Reveles also served as a quality control coach at the University of Arizona (2013-16) and the University of California, Berkeley (2017-18).

A native of Upland, CA, Reveles earned his bachelor's degree in liberal arts and his master's degree in leadership management from the University of La Verne. He currently resides in Sunnyvale, CA.
