COLLEGE

Appeared in 64 games (28 starts) over 5 seasons at Texas (2020-24) and registered 142 tackles, 18.0 TFLs, 7.5 sacks, 13 PDs, 1 INT and 2 FFs. In 2024, started in 16 games and registered 55 tackles, 5.5 TFLs, 1.0 sack, 7 PDs and 1 FF, earning Associated Press Second-Team All-American honors. In 2023, appeared in 14 games (6 starts) and notched 22 tackles, 2.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks, and 2 PDs, earning Honorable Mention All-Big 12 honors. In 2022, appeared in 12 games (1 start) and registered 17 tackles, 3.0 TFLs and 1.0 sack. In 2021, appeared in 12 games (4 starts) and notched 25 tackles, 5.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and 1 FF. In 2020, appeared in 10 games (1 start) during the shortened COVID-19 season and registered 23 tackles, 2.5 TFLs, 1.5 sacks, 4 PDs and 1 INT.
