### PROFESSION SOMETHING SPECIA

In 2025, the 49ers have ranked among the NFL's best in multiple special teams categories.

K Eddy Piñeiro has converted on each of his 19 FGAs this season, making him 1 of 2 kickers in the NFL to have converted on 100% of their FGAs [min. 10 FGAs] (K Nick Folk, NYJ - 19/19).

P. Thomas Morstead has placed 15 of his 29 punts (51.7%) inside-the-20 this season, the 3rd-highest inside-the-20 percentage in the NFL [min. 15 punts] (P Mitch Wishnowsky, Buf. - 61.1%; P Matt Araiza, KC - 54.5%).

The **49ers** kickoff return unit has given the 49ers offense an average starting position at the 32.8 yd. line, the 2nd-highest average starting position in the NFL (NYJ - 33.8).

LB Luke Gifford has registered 13 total special teams tackles this season, tied for the 5th-most in the NFL (S Devon Key, Den. - 16; S Dane Belton, NYG - 15; LB Akeem Davis-Gaither, Arz. - 15; S Rayshawn Jenkins, Cle. - 14; S Tycen Anderson, Cin. - 13; LB Shaun Dolac, LAR - 13; WR Ben Skowronek, Pit. - 13).

#### ............. TACKLING MACHIN

- Since Week 6, LB Tatum Bethune has recorded 60 tackles, the most by any player in the NFL during that span.
- Bethune has recorded at least 10 tackles in each game during that span, tying HOF LB Patrick Willis for the most consecutive games (5) with at least 10 tackles by a 49ers player since at least 2000.

With 10-or-more tackles this week at Arz. (11/16/25), Bethune would become the 2nd player in the NFL since 2022 to record 6-consecutive games with 10-or-more tackles (LB Daiyan Henley, LAC - 6 games in 2024).

### CMC = VERSAT

RB Christian McCaffrey has registered 69 recepts. for 692 yds. and 4 TDs this season. His 69 recepts. and 692 rec. yds. lead all NFL RBs, while his 4 rec. TDs are tied for the most among RBs (RB De'Von Achane, Mia. - 4; RB RJ Harvey, Den. - 4).

McCaffrey has recorded at least 75 recepts, in 4 seasons during his career (2017-19, 2022). With 6-or-more recepts. this week at Arz. (11/16/25), McCaffrey would become the 4th RB in NFL history to register at least 75 recepts. in 5 career seasons, joining former NFL RB Larry Centers, HOF RB Marshall Faulk and New Orleans Saints RB Alvin Kamara.

McCaffrey has also recorded at least 50 rec. yds. in 9 games this season, the most by any RB in the NFL, and 49 such games in his career. With 50-or-more rec. vds. this week at

Arz. (11/16/25), McCaffrey would join Centers (55 games) and Faulk (50 games) as the only RBs in NFL history with 50 career games with at least 50 rec. yds.

- Last week vs. LAR (11/9/25), TE George Kittle hauled in 9 recepts, for a team-high 84 yds, and 1 TD. His TD recept. marked the 48th of his career.
- Since entering the NFL in 2017, Kittle's 48 rec. TDs are the 3rd-most by a TE during that span.

With 1-or-more TD recept. this week at Arz. (11/16/25), Kittle would tie or surpass, former WR Billy Wilson for the 5th-most rec. TDs by any player in franchise history. It would also give Kittle 1-or-more TD recept. in consecutive games for the first

time this season.
