J.J. STACKING TDs

- Since Week 9, WR **Jauan Jennings** has registered 26 receipts for 283 yds. and 6 TDs. His 6 TD receipts are tied for the 2nd-most among all players during that span.

- Last week vs. Ten. (12/14/25), **Jennings** recorded 3 catches for 37 yds. and 2 TDs, marking his 3rd-consecutive game with at least 1 TD receipt. [1 TD receipt vs. Car. (11/24/25); 1 TD receipt at Cle. (11/30/25)].
- With 2-or-more TD receipts this week at Ind. (12/22/25), **Jennings** would become the first 49ers player to register consecutive games with at least 2 TD receipts, since TE **George Kittle** in 2022 [2 TD receipts at Sea. (12/15/22); 2 TD receipts vs. Was. (12/24/22)], and the first 49ers WR to accomplish the feat since HOF WR **Terrell Owens** did so in the 2002 season [2 TD receipts at SD (11/17/02); 2 TD receipts vs. Phi. (11/25/02)].

THE LONG GAME

32

The **49ers offense** has registered 32 drives of 10-or-more plays this season, tied for the most in the NFL (Hou. - 32; KC - 32; NO - 32).

30

San Francisco has also registered 30 drives of 5:00-or-more minutes this season, the most in the NFL.

139

On drives of 10-or-more plays this season, the **49ers offense** has scored 139 total points, the most in the NFL.

127

On drives of 5:00-or-more minutes this season, the **49ers offense** has scored 127 points, the 2nd-most in the NFL (Buf. - 129).

San Francisco ranks t-2nd in TDs scored on drives of at least 10 plays (LAR - 15; SF - 14; Phi. - 14) and ranks 2nd in TDs scored on drives of at least 5:00 minutes this season (Buf. - 15; SF - 14).

EFFICIENCY IS KEY

- Last week vs. Ten. (12/14/25), QB **Brock Purdy** completed 23 of his 30 passing atts. for 295 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 140.3.
- **Purdy's** 140.3 passer rating marked his 7th career game with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher. His 7 games with a passer rating of at least 140.0 are the 2nd-most among all QBs since he entered the NFL in 2022.
- With a passer rating of 140.0 this week at Ind. (12/22/25), **Purdy** would surpass former QB **John Brodie** and HOF QB **Joe Montana** for the 2nd-most games with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher in franchise history.

- **Purdy** can also register consecutive games with a passer rating of at least 140.0 for the 2nd time in his career, which would make him the first QB in franchise history to record two separate streaks of games with a passer rating of 140.0-or-higher. He previously did so in the 2023 season [148.9 passer rating Week 10 at Jax. (11/12/23); 158.3 passer rating Week 11 vs. TB (11/19/23)].

COMMUNITY CORNER

- Last week, **49ers players** spent their Community Tuesday at San Quentin State Rehabilitation Center as part of the NFL's Inspire Change initiative. The **49ers** have visited San Quentin every year since 1997, with the exception of the two years during the pandemic. The visit started with a social-justice discussion featuring 16 current 49ers players including DL **Nick Bosa** and Walter Payton Man of the Year team winner LB **Curtis Robinson**, alumni RB **Frank Gore** and LB **Patrick Willis**, and team Pastor Earl Smith and Jordan Brand executive Larry Miller.
- After the discussion, the group toured the facility and had a special visitation lunch in the community room, where players joined the incarcerated men and their families to connect and hand out **49ers** gift bags.
