1 OF THE BEST

- In 2025, WR **Ricky Pearsall** has registered 16 recepts. for 281 yds. (17.6 avg.) and has tallied 14 recepts. for a 1st down.
- With 281 rec. yds., 17.6 yds. per recept. and 14 recepts. that have resulted in a 1st down, **Pearsall** is the only player in the NFL to rank in the top 5 in each of these categories.

Pearsall's 281 rec. yds. are the 3rd-most in the NFL (WR Puka Nacua, LAR - 333; WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba, Sea. - 323).

Pearsall's 17.6 yds. per recept. are the 4th-highest in the NFL (WR Jameson Williams, Det. - 21.8; WR Alec Pierce, Ind. - 19.0; WR Tyquan Thornton, KC - 19.0).

Pearsall's 14 recepts. for a 1st down are tied for the 3rd-most in the NFL (WR Puka Nacua, LAR - 18; WR Amon-Ra St. Brown, Det. - 16; WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba, Sea. - 14).

- Last week vs. Arz. (9/21/25), **Pearsall** recorded 8 recepts. for 117 yds., marking his 2nd game of the season with 100-or-more rec. yds. and the 3rd such game of his career.
- Pearsall** is 1 of 4 players in the NFL to register multiple games with 100-or-more rec. yds. this season.



NOTHING EASY

- San Francisco's defense** has held its opponents to scoring just 49 points this season, the 3rd-fewest in the NFL (GB - 44; Sea. - 47).
- The unit's 49 points allowed mark the fewest that the team has allowed through the first 3 weeks of a season since 2023 (42 points allowed).
- Since 2021, the **49ers defense** has held its opponents to 20.1 points per game, the 3rd-fewest in the NFL during that span.
