RETURN SPECIALISTS


- In 2025, the **49ers** kickoff return unit is averaging 28.1 yds. per kickoff return, the 5th-highest yds. per return in the NFL.
- The unit's 28.1 yd. KOR average provides the **49ers offense** with an average starting position at the 34.5 yd. line after kickoffs, which leads the NFL.

- WR **Skyy Moore** is averaging 28.3 yds. per KOR, which ranks 4th in the NFL among returners with at least 15 returns (RB Ray Davis, Buf. - 34.4; RB Raheem Mostert, LV - 30.5; WR Luke McCaffrey, Was. - 29.6).
- RB **Brian Robinson Jr.** has tallied 3 KORs of 40-or-more yds., tied for the most in the NFL (WR Luke McCaffrey, Was. - 3; WR Malik Washington, Mia. - 3).
- Both **Moore** and **Robinson Jr.** have registered back-to-back games with a long KOR of 40-or-more yds. this season, making them the first 49ers duo to each register a kickoff return long of at least 40 yds. in back-to-back games in the same season since former DBs **Kermit Alexander** and **Abe Woodson** in 1963, according to the Elias Sports Bureau.

BIG NIGHT FOR TIG

- Last week vs. Car. (11/24/25), S **Ji'Air Brown** registered 5 tackles and a career-high 2 INTs of Panthers QB Bryce Young, helping him earn NFC Defensive Player of the Week (Week 12) honors.



- This marked **Brown's** first DPOW honor and makes him the first 49ers safety to earn the award since former S **Antoine Bethea** in Week 4 of the 2014 season.
- With 5 tackles and 2 INTs vs. Car. (11/24/25), **Brown** became 1 of 4 safeties in the NFL to register at least 5 tackles and 2 INTs in a single game this season (S Calen Bullock, Hou.; S Kevin Byard, Chi.; S Kam Curl, LAR).
- Brown** also became the first 49ers player to register at least 5 tackles and 2 INTs in a single game since former LB **Chris Borland** did so in 2014 [13 tackles & 2 INTs at NYG (11/16/14)].
- With 2-or-more INTs this week at Cle. (11/30/25), the **49ers defense** will have registered at least 2 INTs in 3-consecutive games for the first time since doing so in the 2024 season [2 INTs at Sea. (10/10/24); 2 INTs vs. KC (10/20/24); 2 INTs vs. Dal. (10/27/24)].

- Last week, **49ers players** spent their Community Tuesday at the team's annual Feast with the Niners event presented by Graton Resort & Casino.
