KEEPING UP WITH KITTLE

- Since entering the NFL in 2017, TE **George Kittle** has registered 546 receptions, for 7,448 yds. and 47 TDs. His 7,448 rec. yds. are the 2nd-most by any TE in the NFL during that span (TE Travis Kelce, KC - 9,763 rec. yds.).
- With 52-or-more rec. yds. this week at NYG (11/2/25), **Kittle** would reach 7,500 rec. yds. in his 117th career game, which would make him the 3rd-fastest TE in NFL history to reach 7,500 rec. yds. in a career.

- K Eddy Piñeiro** was named the NFC Special Teams Player of the Month for the month of October after converting on all 10 of his FGAs and each of his 6 PATs. This marks the first Special Teams Player of the Month honor of his career.
- Piñeiro** scored 36 points during October, tied for the most in the NFC (K Brandon Aubrey, Dal. - 36) and was the only kicker in the NFC to register 10 FGM during the month.

- Last week at Hou. (10/26/25), RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 25 rushing yds. and 43 rec. yds., which put him at 6,877 rushing yds. and 5,025 rec. yds. in his career.
- McCaffrey's** 43 rec. yds. at Hou. (10/26/25) made him the 5th player in NFL history to record at least 5,000 rushing yds. and 5,000 rec. yds. in a career.
