



San Francisco 49ers at New Orleans Saints Sunday, September 14, 2025

With The Win...

- The **San Francisco 49ers** have improved to 51-27-2 all-time against the Saints, including a 26-15 record on the road.
- The 49ers have won five of the last eight matchups against the Saints and have won consecutive games against the Saints for the first time since the 2001 season when the two teams were both members of the NFC West [W, 28-27 vs. NO (11/11/01); W, 38-0 at NO (1/6/02)].
- The **Niners** have won consecutive road games to start the season for the first time since 2023 [Week 1, 30-7 at Pit. (9/10/23); Week 2, 30-23 at LAR (9/17/23)].
- The **49ers** became the first team to open the season with consecutive road wins with two different starting quarterbacks since the team previously accomplished the feat in 1988, according to the Elias Sports Bureau [QB Joe Montana 34-33 at NO (9/4/88) & QB Steve Young 20-17 at NYG (9/11/88)].
- The Niners are the first team to start the season 2-0 with two different starting quarterbacks since the Minnesota Vikings in 2016, according to the Elias Sports Bureau [QB Shaun Hill 25-16 at Ten. (9/11/16) & QB Sam Bradford 17-14 vs. GB (9/18/16)].
- San Francisco improved to 1-0 against the NFC South this season and 10-5 under head coach Kyle Shanahan.
- **Shanahan** earned his 72nd career regular season win, surpassing Lawrence "Buck" Shaw (1946-54) for the third-most wins by a head coach in franchise history.

The Mac Attack

- QB **Mac Jones** completed 26 of his 39 passing atts. for 279 yds. and 3 TDs with a passer rating of 113.1. His 3 passing TDs marked his first of the season and give him 57 in his career.
- With 3 TD passes on the day, Jones registered his 5th career game with 3-or-more passing TDs and his first since he threw 3 TDs vs. Phi. (9/10/23) as a member of the New England Patriots.
- With 279 passing yds., 3 TDs and 0 INTs, Jones became the third QB in franchise history to throw for 250-or-more yds., 3-or-more TDs and no INTs in his first start as a member of the 49ers, joining former QB Nick Mullens [262 passing yds., 3 TDs and zero INTs vs. Oak (11/1/18)] and former QB Matt Cavanaugh [252 yds., 3 TDs and zero INTs at Phi. (9/23/84)].

More Records For CMC

- RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 13 carries for 55 yds. on the ground to go along with 6 recepts. for 52 yds. and 1 TD through the air.
- McCaffrey's TD recept. marked his first of the season and the 30th of his career. With 1 TD recept. on the day, McCaffrey joins HOF RB Marshall Faulk and HOF RB Lenny Moore as the only players in NFL history to register at least 50 rushing TDs and 30 TD recepts. in a career.

- With 107 yds. from scrimmage, McCaffrey registered his 59th career game with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage and his 22nd such game as a member of the 49ers.
- McCaffrey's 59 games with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage are the 2nd-most among active NFL RBs.

- McCaffrey's 55 rushing yds. and 52 rec. yds. marked his 32nd career game with 50-or-more rushing yds. and 50-or-more rec. yds., which is the 2nd-most such games in NFL history (RB Marshall Faulk, Ind./StL – 41 games).
- Of those 32 games, McCaffrey has recorded 8 as a member of the 49ers. His 8 games with 50-or-more rushing yds. and 50-or-more rec. yds. are tied for the 3rd-most in franchise history.

- WR **Jauan Jennings** registered 5 recepts. for a team-high 89 yds. and 1 TD on the day. Jennings' TD recept. marked his first of the season and the 14th of his career.
- Jennings' 42-yd. TD recept. also marked the longest TD recept. of his career.

• TE **Luke Farrell** tallied 2 recepts. for 15-yds., including an 11-yd. TD recept., marking the first of his career.

The Boogeyman Strikes Again

- LB Fred Warner registered a team-high 11 tackles, 1 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR on the day.
- Warner's PD gives him 54 in his career, which surpass Hall of Fame LB Patrick Willis for the most PDs by a 49ers LB since PDs became an official statistic in 1994.

• With 1 FF on the day, Warner registered the 16th FF of his career, which is tied for the most FFs by a 49ers player since FFs became an official statistic in 1994.

- Warner's FR marked the 7th of his career and his first since the 2021 season [1 FR vs. Atl. (12/19/21)].
- With 11 tackles, 1 PD, 1 FF and 1 FR, Warner became the first player in the NFL to register 10-or-more tackles, 1-or-more PDs, 1-or-more FFs and 1-or-more FRs in a single game since he accomplished the feat in 2020 [14 tackles, 3 PDs, 1 FF & 1 FR at Arz. (12/26/20)].

Beware Of Bosa

- DL **Nick Bosa** registered a career-high 9 tackles and 1.0 sack of Saints QB Spencer Rattler. His sack gives him 2.0 this season and 64.5 in his career.
- With 1.0 sack last week at Sea. (9/7/25) and 1.0 sack on the day, Bosa has registered back-to-back games with 1.0-or-more sacks for the 23rd time in his career.

Huffin', Puffin', And Sackin' The QB

- DL **Bryce Huff** tallied 4 tackles, 1.0 sack and 1 FF on the day. His sack marked his first of the season and gives him 21.0 in his career.
- Huff's FF marked his first as a member of the 49ers and gives him 3 in his career.
 It marked his first FF since he registered 1 FF at Dal. (11/10/24) as a member of the Philadelphia Eagles.

Strong And Stout

• CB **Upton Stout** registered 5 tackles and 1.0 sack of Rattler, marking the first sack of his career.
