San Francisco 49ers at Los Angeles Rams Thursday, October 2, 2025

With The Win...

- **San Francisco** has improved to 79-71-3 all-time against the Rams, including a 41-35-1 record on the road.
- The **49ers** have won their 5th game on Amazon Prime's *Thursday Night Football* since 2022, tying the Buffalo Bills (5) for the most wins on *TNF* during that span. The team has won four of their last five games on *TNF*.
- The **49ers** have won seven of their previous nine matchups against the Rams when playing at SoFi Stadium.
- The **Niners** have started the season 3-0 in the NFC West for the sixth time since 2002 (2002, 2009, 2011, 2022, 2023) and the first time since the 2023 season.
- Head coach **Kyle Shanahan** improved to 11-6 in the regular season vs. the Rams and 27-24 against the NFC West as head coach of the **49ers**.

Whatever It Takes

- The **49ers** beat the Rams by a score of 26-23 in overtime, marking the team's first overtime win since defeating the Las Vegas Raiders by a score of 37-34 at LV (1/1/23).

Grind It Out

- On the 49ers 2nd offensive possession of the game, the unit registered a 17-play, 91-yd. drive that resulted in a 1-yd. TD recept. by RB **Christian McCaffrey**.
- The unit's 17-play drive marked the most plays in a scoring drive that resulted in a TD since the unit registered an 18-play TD drive vs. LAR (11/15/21).
- It also marked the most plays in a scoring drive that resulted in any points since 11/21/21 at Jax., when the unit registered a 20-play drive that resulted in a FG.

Mac Who? Mac Jones!

- QB **Mac Jones** completed 33 of his 49 passing atts. for 342 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 100.9 on the night. His passing TDs gave him 6 this season and 60 in his career.
- Jones' 342 passing yds. marked his 6th career game with 300-or-more passing yds. and his first since he threw for 316 passing yds. vs. Phi. (9/10/23) as a member of the New England Patriots.
- It also marked the 5th time in Jones' career that he has registered 300-or-more passing yds. and 2-or-more passing TDs. In addition to his 316 passing yds. vs. Phi. (9/10/23), Jones also threw 3 passing TDs.

- Jones opened the game by leading an 8-play, 72-yd. scoring drive that resulted in a 6-yd. TD pass to TE Jake Tonges. Jones completed all of 5 of his passing atts. for 77 yds. on that drive, marking the 3rd-most passing yds. by a 49ers QB on an opening drive since at least 2000 [QB Jimmy Garoppolo, 81 yds. at NO (12/8/19); QB Colin Kaepernick, 79 yds. vs. Arz. (12/28/24)].

CMC Does It All

- RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 22 carries for 57 yds. on the ground to go along with 8 receipts. for 82 yds. and 1 TD through the air.
- McCaffrey's TD receipt. marked his 3rd of the season and the 32nd of his career. With 1 TD receipt. last week vs. Jax. (9/28/25) and 1 TD receipt. on the night, it marked the 7th time in McCaffrey's career that he has registered 1-or-more TD receipts. in back-to-back games and his first time doing so since he registered 3-consecutive games in 2023 [1 TD receipt. at Cle. (10/15/23); 1 TD receipt. at Min. (10/23/23); 1 TD receipt. vs. Cin. (10/29/23)].
- Tonight's game marked the 100th game of McCaffrey's career. In 100 career games, McCaffrey has recorded 11,522 yds. from scrimmage and 84 total TDs. He is 1 of 6 players in NFL history to record 11,000-or-more TDs and 80-or-more TDs through 100 career games.

- With 88 rec. yds. vs. Arz. (9/21/25), 92 rec. yds. vs. Jax. (9/28/25) and 82 rec. yds. on the night, McCaffrey registered his 3rd-consecutive game with 80-or-more rec. yds., making him the first 49ers RB to register 3-consecutive games with 80-or-more rec. yds. in a single season.
- With 139 yds. from scrimmage, McCaffrey registered his 62nd career game with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage and his 25th such game as a member of the 49ers.
- McCaffrey's 62 games with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage are the most among active NFL RBs

- With 142 yds. from scrimmage Week 1 at Sea. (9/7/25), 107 yds. from scrimmage Week 2 at NO (9/14/25), 140 yds. from scrimmage Week 3 vs. Arz. (9/21/25), 141 yds. from scrimmage Week 4 vs. Jax. (9/28/25) and 139 yds. from scrimmage on the night, McCaffrey became the third 49ers player in franchise history to begin a season with 5-consecutive games with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage and the first to accomplish the feat since former RB Roger Craig in the 1988 season.

- With 57 rushing yds. and 82 rec. yds., McCaffrey registered his 34th career game with 50-or-more rushing yds. and 50-or-more rec. yds., which is the 2nd-most such games in NFL history (RB Marshall Faulk, Ind./StL – 41 games).

- Of those 34 games, McCaffrey has recorded 10 as a member of the 49ers. His 10 games with 50-or-more rushing yds. and 50-or-more rec. yds. are the 3rd-most in franchise history.

Bourne Again

- WR **Kendrick Bourne** tied his career-high with 10 receipts. for a career-high 142 yds. on the night. His 142 yds. mark his 2nd career game with 100-or-more rec. yds. and his first since recording 100 rec. yds. vs. Cin. (12/24/22) as a member of the New England Patriots.

Los Gatos' Finest

- TE **Jake Tonges** notched a career-high 7 receipts. for 41 yds. and 1 TD on the night. His TD receipt. marked the 3rd of his career.
- With 1 TD receipt. last week vs. Jax. (9/28/25) and 1 TD receipts. on the night, it marked the first time in Tonges' career that he had registered back-to-back games with 1-or-more TD receipts.
- Tonges also became the first 49ers TE to register consecutive games with 1-or-more TD receipts. since TE George Kittle tallied 3-consecutive games with 1-or-more TD receipts. in 2024 [1 TD receipt. vs. Dal. (10/27/24); 1 TD receipt. at TB (11/10/24); 1 TD receipt. at GB (11/24/24)].

Bryce Rolls The Dice

- DL **Bryce Huff** registered 2 tackles and 1.0 sack of Rams QB Matthew Stafford. His sack of Stafford gives him 3.0 this season and 23.0 in his career.

Someone Turn On The A.C.

- DL **Alfred Collins** registered 2 tackles, 1 FF and 1 FR on the night. His FF and FR both marked the first of his career.

Get On The Ball, Gip!

- DL **Trevis Gipson** registered 1 FR on the night, marking his first FR of the season and the 2nd of his career [1 FR at Det. (11/25/21) as a member of the Chicago Bears].

Jumpin' Like Jordan

- DL **Jordan Elliott** registered 1 tackle and blocked a Rams PAT, marking the 2nd blocked PAT of his career and the team's first since Elliott blocked a PAT vs. Det. (12/30/24).

The Fly-est Sigle Around

- S **Marques Sigle** registered a career-high 13 tackles and 1 PD on the night.
- Sigle's 13 tackles mark the most in a game by a 49ers rookie since former LB Dre Greenlaw recorded 13 tackles at Sea. (12/29/19).

Piñeiro Is Dinero

- K **Eddy Piñeiro** converted on all 4 of his FGAs (37, 20, 59 & 41) and both of his PATs.
- Piñeiro's 59-yd. FG marked the longest FGM of his career and his longest FGM since converting on a 56-yd. FG vs. Min. (10/1/23) as a member of the Carolina Panthers.
- It also marked the 2nd-longest FGM in franchise history.
