



# Game Notes



## San Francisco 49ers at New York Giants Sunday, November 2, 2025

### *With The Win...*

- The **San Francisco 49ers** improved to 23-21 all-time against the New York Giants.
- The **49ers** have won four of the previous five matchups against the Giants, including each of the previous three matchups.
- Dating back to the 2021 season, the **Niners** have won eight-consecutive regular season games against NFC East opponents.
- Head coach **Kyle Shanahan** improved to 4-1 against the Giants and 11-7 against the NFC East as head coach of the **49ers**.

### *Mac In The Big Apple*

- QB **Mac Jones** completed 19 of his 24 passing atts. for 235 yds. and 2 TDs with a passer rating of 135.2 on the day. Jones' 2 TD passes give him 10 this season and 64 in his career.
- Jones' passer rating of 135.2 marked his highest single game passer rating since he registered a 142.1 passer rating vs. Cle. (11/14/21) as a member of the New England Patriots.
- Jones completed each of his first 14 passing atts. to start the game. His 14-consecutive completions mark the most consecutive completions by a 49ers QB to begin a game since QB Brock Purdy completed his first 13 passing atts. vs. Arz. (10/1/23).
- Jones' 14-consecutive completions to begin the game also tied HOF QB Steve Young for the 4<sup>th</sup>-most consecutive completions to begin a game by a 49ers QB since at least 1978, according to the Elias Sports Bureau.

- Jones' 2 TD passes marked his 4<sup>th</sup> game this season with 2-or-more TD passes [3 TD passes at NO (9/14/25); 2 TD passes at LAR (10/2/25); 2 TD passes at Hou. (10/26/25)] and the 21<sup>st</sup> such game of his career.
- With 2 TD passes last week at Hou. (10/26/25) and 2 TD passes on the day, Jones has thrown 2-or-more TD passes in consecutive games for the 6<sup>th</sup> time in his career and for the first time since the 2023 season when he did so as a member of the New England Patriots [2 TD passes vs. Buf. (10/22/23); 2 TD passes at Mia. (10/29/23)].

#### **More NFL History For CMC**

- RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 28 carries for 106 yds. and 1 TD on the ground to go along with 5 receipts. for 67 yds. and 1 TD through the air.
- With 1 rushing TD and 1 TD receipt. on the day, McCaffrey recorded his 16<sup>th</sup> career game with 1-or-more rushing TDs and 1-or-more TD receipts., which surpasses HOF RB Marshall Faulk for the most such games in NFL history.

- McCaffrey's rushing TD gives him 4 this season and 56 in his career, while his TD recept. also gives him 4 this season and 33 in his career. McCaffrey's 33 career TD recepts. are the 2<sup>nd</sup>-most by a RB in the Super Bowl Era.

- With 106 rushing yds. and 67 rec. yds. on the day, McCaffrey has registered 596 rushing yds. and 626 rec. yds. on the season, making him the 2<sup>nd</sup> player since 2015 to record 500-or-more rushing yds. and 500-or-more rec. yds. in the first 9 games of a season (RB Saquon Barkely, 2018). He also became the 2<sup>nd</sup> 49ers player to accomplish the feat, joining RB Roger Craig in 1985.
- McCaffrey also registered his 10<sup>th</sup> career game with 100-or-more rushing yds. and 50-or-more rec. yds. He joins HOF RB Marshall Faulk (15 games) and HOF RB Walter Payton (10 games) as the only players in NFL history to record 10 career games with at least 100 rushing yds. and at least 50 rec. yds.
- With 173 yds. from scrimmage, McCaffrey registered his 8<sup>th</sup> game this season with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage, which is the most by any player in the NFL. He also registered his 65<sup>th</sup> career game with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage and his 28<sup>th</sup> such game as a member of the 49ers.
- McCaffrey's 65 games with 100-or-more yds. from scrimmage are the most among active NFL RBs.

### ***Third-And-Jauan***

- WR **Jauan Jennings** registered 4 receipts. for 41 yds. and 1 TD on the day. His TD receipt. marked his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the season and the 15<sup>th</sup> of his career.

### ***Kittle Over The Middle***

- TE **George Kittle** caught 4 receipts. for 32 yds. on the day. With 4 receipts., Kittle has now registered 550 receipts. in his 117<sup>th</sup> career game, which ties former TE Jimmy Graham and former TE Jason Witten for the 3<sup>rd</sup>-fewest games to reach 550 receipts. by a TE in NFL history.

### ***Welcome Back, Cle!***

- DL **Clelin Ferrell** registered 3 tackles and 1.0 sack of Giants QB Jaxson Dart, marking his first sack of the season and giving him 18.0 in his career.

### ***Sam I Am***

- DL **Sam Okuayinonu** tallied 4 tackles and 1.0 sack of Dart, giving him 2.0 sacks this season and 5.5 in his career.

#### **More Tackles For Tatum**

- LB **Tatum Bethune** tallied a career-high 16 tackles on the day.
- Bethune's 16 tackles are the most in a single game by a 49ers player since former LBs NaVorro Bowman and Michael Wilhoite recorded 16 tackles each at NYG (10/11/15).

#### **Eddy Is Still Steady**

- K **Eddy Piñeiro** converted on both of his FGAs (54 & 33) and each of his 4 PATs.
- With 2-consecutive FGM on the day, Piñeiro has converted on each of his first 19 FGAs since joining the team in Week 2, continuing his streak for the most FGM by any kicker to begin their first season with the 49ers.
- With 19-consecutive FGM, Piñeiro also tied former K Phil Dawson for the 4<sup>th</sup>-most consecutive FGM in franchise history.
