San Francisco 49ers at Philadelphia Eagles NFC Wild Card Game Notes Sunday, January 11, 2026

With the Win...

- The **San Francisco 49ers** have improved to 7-2 all-time in the Wild Card round and have won each of their previous five Wild Card matchups [W, 39-38 vs. NYG (1/5/03 – NFC-WC); W, 23-20 at GB (1/5/14 – NFC-WC); W, 23-17 at Dal. (1/16/22 – NFC-WC); W, 41-23 vs. Sea. (1/14/23 – NFC-WC)].
- The **49ers** have won their 40th playoff game all-time, the most in NFL history.
- **San Francisco** has advanced to the Divisional Round of the playoffs for the 26th time in franchise history.
- The **49ers** have improved to 22-15-1 all-time against the Eagles, including a 13-6-1 record on the road and a 2-1 record in the postseason. The win also marked San Francisco's first road victory in the postseason at Philadelphia.
- Head coach **Kyle Shanahan** has improved to 9-4 in the postseason as head coach of the **49ers**, including a 1-1 record against the Eagles and a 3-0 record in the Wild Card Round.

Yards On Yards

- The **49ers offense** registered 361 total yds. of offense (6.2 yds. per play) on the day, marking the most total net yds. the unit has recorded in a road playoff game since registering 381 yds. at GB (1/5/14 – NFC-WC).
- The unit's 6.2 yds. per play marked the most the team has registered in a road playoff game since averaging 7.3 yds. per play at Atl. (1/20/13 – NFC-C).

The Ol' Razzle Dazzle

- WR **Juan Jennings** registered 1 recept. for 45 yds. on the day and added a 29-yd. TD pass to RB **Christian McCaffrey**.
- Jennings' TD pass marked the 2nd of his postseason career and his first since throwing a 21-yd. TD pass to McCaffrey at KC (2/11/24 – SBLVIII).
- With 2 career postseason TD passes, Jennings became the only non-QB in the Super Bowl Era to register multiple TD passes in a postseason career.

Open It Up

- On the **49ers** first offensive possession, QB **Brock Purdy** connected with WR **Demarcus Robinson** on a 61-yd. pass play, marking the longest play the unit has registered in the postseason since recording a 74-yd. TD pass from Purdy to former WR Deebo Samuel Sr. vs. Sea. (1/14/23 – NFC-WC).

Purdy At The Linc

- QB **Brock Purdy** completed 18 of his 31 passing atts. for 262 yds. and 2 TDs. His 2 passing TDs give him 8 in his postseason career.
- With 262 passing yds. on the day, Purdy surpassed former QB Colin Kaepernick for the 3rd-most passing yds. by a 49ers QB in postseason franchise history.

- With 2 passing TDs, Purdy also surpassed Kaepernick for the 3rd-most passing TDs in postseason franchise history.

Fly Christian Fly

- RB **Christian McCaffrey** registered 15 carries for 48 yds. on the ground to go along with 6 receipts. for 66 yds. and 2 TDs through the air. McCaffrey's 2 TD receipts. give him 5 in his postseason career (4 with 49ers), which is tied for the 6th-most in franchise history.

- With 2 TD receipts. on the day, McCaffrey became the first 49ers player to register at least 2 TD receipts. in a postseason game since former WR Michael Crabtree recorded 2 TD receipts. vs. GB (1/12/13 – NFC-D).
- McCaffrey also became the first 49ers RB to record 2-or-more TD receipts. in a postseason game since former RB Ricky Watters tallied 2 TD receipts. at LAC (1/29/95 – SBXXIX).
- Today's game marked the 8th postseason game of McCaffrey's career (7th with 49ers). With 2 TDs on the day, McCaffrey has now scored at least 1 TD in 8-consecutive playoff games and joins HOF RBs Emmitt Smith and Thurman Thomas and HOF WR John Stallworth as the only players in NFL history to register at least 1 TD in 8-consecutive playoff games.

- With 48 rushing yds. on the day, McCaffrey has now registered 554 rushing yds. in the playoffs as a member of the 49ers. His 554 rushing yds. surpass former QB Colin Kaepernick for the 4th-most in postseason franchise history.

- With 114 yds. from scrimmage and 2 total TDs on the day, McCaffrey recorded his 5th-consecutive playoff game with at least 100 yds. from scrimmage and at least 1 TD. He becomes the 4th player in NFL history to register at least 100 yds. from scrimmage and at least 1 TD in 5-consecutive playoff games (RB Terrell Davis, Den. – 7 games; RB Marcus Allen, L.A. Raiders – 5 games; RB John Riggins, Was. – 5 games).

We Got 5 On It

- WR **Demarcus Robinson** registered 6 receipts. for a postseason career-high 111 yds. and 1 TD on the day.
- His TD receipt. marked the 3rd of his postseason career and his first since registering a 41-yd. TD receipt. in 2022 as a member of the Baltimore Ravens [at Cin. (1/15/23 – AFC-WC)].
- With 111 rec. yds. on the day, Robinson became the first 49ers WR to register 100-or-more rec. yds. in a postseason game since former WR Deebo Samuel Sr. recorded 133 rec. yds. vs. Sea. (1/14/23 – NFC-WC).

LB Duo

- LB **Garrett Wallow** led the team in tackles in his first career postseason game and first start as a member of the 49ers with 11, while LB **Eric Kendricks** tallied 10 tackles, tying his postseason career high [10 tackles vs. NO (1/14/18 – NFC-D)].

Give Him The Keys

- DL **Keion White** registered 3 tackles and 1.0 sack of Eagles QB Jalen Hurts on the day, marking the first sack of his postseason career.

Eddy P For Three

- K **Eddy Piñeiro** converted on his lone FGA (36) on the day, marking the first FGM of his postseason career.
