



## 2026 TRAINING CAMP

The San Francisco 49ers officially begin the 2026 season with the start of Training Camp presented by VISA.

San Francisco enters the 2026 season under President of Football Operations/General Manager John Lynch and head coach Kyle Shanahan, marking their 10th season leading the team.



## DATES TO REMEMBER

**Saturday, July 25:** Veterans and rookies report to SAP Performance Facility in Santa Clara, CA.

**Sunday, July 26:** First full-squad practice

**Friday, July 31:** First full-squad padded practice

**Tuesday, August 11:** Ahead of the 49ers preseason matchup against the Tennessee Titans, the teams will hold a joint practice at SAP Performance Facility. This marks the first time under President of Football Operations/General Manager John Lynch and head coach Kyle Shanahan's tenure that the 49ers will host the Titans prior to their preseason matchup and the first time they've faced the Titans in the preseason since the 2024 season.

**Thursday, August 13:** San Francisco hosts the Tennessee Titans in the first preseason game of 2026 at Levi's Stadium at 6:00 p.m. PT.



**Thursday, August 14:** Ahead of the 49ers exhibition game against the Los Angeles Chargers, the teams will hold a joint practice at The Bolt in El Segundo, CA. This marks the second joint practice session with the Chargers in the last six seasons (2021).

**Thursday, August 20:** San Francisco takes on the Los Angeles Chargers in the second preseason matchup of 2026 at SoFi Stadium at 7:00 p.m. PT.



**Thursday, August 27:** San Francisco heads to Allegiant Stadium to face the Las Vegas Raiders for the third and final preseason game of 2026 at 5:00 p.m. PT.



**Sunday, August 30:** Roster cut-down to maximum of 53 players by 3:00 p.m. PT.

**Monday, August 31:** After 10 a.m. PT, clubs may establish a Practice Squad of 17 players.

**September 9-10, 13-14:** Week 1 of the 2026 regular season opens as the 49ers travel to Australia to take on the Los Angeles Rams at Melbourne Cricket Ground on Thursday, September 10, at 5:35 p.m. PT.

## MEDIA ACCESS & POLICIES

### TRAINING CAMP MEDIA WRISTBANDS

- There will be no admittance without an official training camp media wristband. No guests are permitted to use media wristbands and are subject to revocation.
- Media wristbands can be acquired when checking into the stadium at the Toyota Gate F entrance.
- All media members must contact the 49ers communications department to be granted permission to attend training camp. A member of your outlet must email your requests to [Caleigh Elkin \(caleigh.elkin@49ers.com\)](mailto:caleigh.elkin@49ers.com).

### 49ERS MEDIA WORKROOM

- All attending media must park in the Yellow Lot, enter through the Toyota Gate F entrance and check in with 49ers Security (See useful maps on following pages for specific directions).
- The 49ers communications department will provide head coach and coordinator transcripts as well as up-to-date rosters throughout training camp.

### 49ERS 2026 SINGLE-GAME CREDENTIALS

- The deadline to apply for single-game credentials is **5:00 p.m. PT 5 days prior to the requested game.**

### PRACTICE REGULATIONS

- Only media regularly covering the 49ers will be allowed to attend the open portions of practice. If a media member from outside the local area wishes to attend practice it is subject to approval from the 49ers communications department.
- For practices held at the SAP Performance Facility, media are instructed to remain on the extreme sideline perimeter of all of the practice fields at all times, pending field layout. Unless otherwise instructed by the 49ers football communications staff and dependent upon the specific practice period, **media are not permitted to stand behind the end zones and must remain at least 15 yards away from any drills or workouts occurring on the sidelines for safety reasons.**
- All media are **prohibited from quoting, broadcasting or posting on social media the dialogue between coaches, players and staff, including all medical personnel.** No member of the media is allowed at any time to initiate a conversation with a player, coach or football staff during practice that would distract them from doing their job.

- **As has been team policy, and in accordance with NFL regulations, media cannot report on strategic and tactical information (i.e. formations, a unique position where a player is lining up and specific plays run, trick plays, etc.). Specifically, reports on player participation with respect to individual units (first-team, second-team) should be based on general observations. Quantifying players' individual repetitions or description of personnel groupings/sub-packages (nickel defense, goal line unit, etc.,) is strictly prohibited. Generally, any information that could help an opponent prepare to play the 49ers is off limits. Strategy is defined by the head coach.**

- Rather than immediately posting speculation on topics such as why a player may not be practicing or an injury that occurs during practice, the media are asked to consult a member of the 49ers football communications staff for accurate information before posting.

### CAMERA POLICY

- Media are only allowed to record video and photographs during the designated filming period at the beginning of practice. This policy includes content collected via personal mobile devices.
- For safety reasons, tripods are not recommended on the practice fields during the allotted filming period. Instead, monopods are encouraged to be used during practice.
- When a player incurs an injury on the practice field, still and video photography of the player is to halt immediately. Cameras are directed not to film or photograph any player being treated by the medical staff.

### CELL PHONE POLICY

- All members of the media must turn their cell phones to vibrate while attending practice. Media are not permitted to conduct phone conversations from the practice fields.

### LIVE BROADCASTING POLICY

- Media are not permitted to live broadcast any 49ers media availabilities, practice sessions or team events without prior written approval from the 49ers football communications department, including the use of social media applications with live streaming functionality.
- Please direct all live requests to the Executive Vice President of Communications, **Corry Rush** ([corry@49ers.com](mailto:corry@49ers.com)) at least 24 hours in advance.

### SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

- Media are not permitted to post on any social media platforms from the practice fields.
- Media are permitted to post video or photos from the open camera period only once they have left the practice fields. As we instruct all media not to quote or broadcast the dialogue between coaches, staff and players, the same rule applies for all social media posts.

**Failure to adhere to the conditions could result in suspension/loss of credentials for members of the media.**

## KNOW YOUR OPPONENT

The 49ers will face the NFC East and AFC West in cross-divisional play, while continuing to battle their NFC West opponents twice a year. San Francisco opens the regular season on the road as they visit the Los Angeles Rams in the NFL's first-ever regular season game in Melbourne, Australia. The 49ers will also host the Miami Dolphins (Week 2), Washington Commanders (Week 6) and will serve as the designated home team against the Minnesota Vikings in Mexico City (Week 11). The team is scheduled to play in five prime time games during the regular season, including two at Levi's Stadium, with one on Monday night (Week 6 vs. Washington Commanders), two on Sunday night (Week 11 vs. Minnesota Vikings in Mexico City & Week 17 vs. Philadelphia Eagles) and two on Thursday night (Week 1 at Los Angeles Rams & Week 15 at Los Angeles Chargers).

### **WEEK 1 - THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10** **AT LOS ANGELES RAMS (MELBOURNE) - 5:35 P.M.**

- San Francisco will open the regular season on the road (at Los Angeles Rams) for the fifth time in six seasons and doing so in three-consecutive seasons from 2021-23 [Week 1 at Det. (9/12/21), Week 1 at Chi. (9/11/22) & Week 1 at Pit. (9/10/23)].
- The 49ers own the all-time series against the Los Angeles Rams 79-72-3, with a 41-35-1 record on the road.
- The Niners have won 10 of the last 13 regular season games on the road against the Rams.
- The 49ers are 3-1 in international play, as the team's most recent trip abroad in 2022 resulted in a 38-10 win over the Arizona Cardinals in Mexico City's Estadio Banorte.

### **WEEK 2 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20** **VS. MIAMI - 1:25 P.M.**

- San Francisco is 7-9 all-time against the Miami Dolphins and 4-4 at home.
- The 49ers have split the previous two regular season meetings.
- The Niners look to win their second-consecutive matchup at home against the Dolphins [W, 33-17 vs. Mia. (12/4/22)].
- San Francisco looks to earn a victory in their fifth-consecutive home opener and improve to 7-3 in home openers under head coach Kyle Shanahan.

### **WEEK 3 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 27** **VS. ARIZONA - 1:05 P.M.**

- San Francisco leads the all-time series against the Arizona Cardinals 38-31, including a 21-15 record at home.
- The 49ers have won three of the last four matchups against the Cardinals at home.
- The Niners will face the Cardinals in Week 3 of the regular season for the fourth time since the 2014 season and in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2014 and 2015 seasons [Week 3 at Arz. (9/21/14) & Week 3 at Arz. (9/27/15)].

### **WEEK 4 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4** **VS. DENVER - 1:25 P.M.**

- The 49ers are 8-8 all-time against the Denver Broncos, including a 5-3 record at home.
- San Francisco will host Denver for the first time since the 2018 season [W, 20-14 vs. Den. (12/9/18)].
- The 49ers have won three of the last five matchups against the Broncos and four of the last four matchups at home.



### **WEEK 5 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11** **AT SEATTLE - 1:25 P.M.**



- San Francisco is 24-33 all-time against the Seahawks, with a 12-18 record on the road.
- The 49ers have won six of the previous eight regular season matchups against the Seahawks.
- The Niners have won four-consecutive regular season matchups against the Seahawks at Lumen Field.



### **WEEK 6 - MONDAY, OCTOBER 19** **VS. WASHINGTON - 5:15 P.M.**



- The 49ers lead the all-time series 23-12-1 against the Washington Commanders.
- San Francisco will host the Commanders for the first time since the 2022 season [W, 37-20 vs. Was. (12/24/22)].
- The 49ers have won seven of the last 10 matchups against Washington, including four of the previous six matchups at home.
- The Niners will face the Commanders on ESPN's Monday Night Football for the sixth time in series history and for the first time since the 2013 season [W, 27-6 at Was. (11/25/13)].
- The 49ers are 4-1 when facing the Commanders on MNF.
- San Francisco's 55 wins on Monday Night Football are tied for the most wins on MNF in NFL history.



### **WEEK 7 - SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25** **AT ATLANTA - 10:00 A.M.**



- San Francisco leads the all-time series against the Atlanta Falcons 49-33-1, with a 19-21-1 record on the road.
- The 49ers will face off against the Falcons in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2021 and 2022 seasons and will travel to Mercedes-Benz Stadium for the second time overall and the first time since the 2022 season.
- San Francisco looks for their first victory on the road against the Falcons since the 2012 NFC Championship Game [W, 28-24 at Atl. (1/20/13)] and their first regular season win in Atlanta since the 2001 season [W, 37-31 at Atl. (10/14/01)].



### **WEEK 8 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 1 - BYE**



- This marks the first season that the 49ers have had their BYE week in Week 8 since 2016 and the fifth time the team has a Week 8 BYE since BYE Weeks were introduced in 1990.



### **WEEK 9 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 8** **VS. LAS VEGAS - 1:05 P.M.**



- The 49ers lead the all-time series 8-7 against the Las Vegas Raiders and are 4-4 at home.
- The Niners will host the Raiders at Levi's Stadium for the first time since the 2018 season [W, 34-3 vs. LV (11/1/18)] and the first time since the franchise moved to Las Vegas.
- San Francisco looks to earn their fourth-consecutive home victory against the Raiders.
- The 49ers look to earn their fifth-consecutive victory coming off the BYE Week and improve to 7-3 after the BYE under head coach Kyle Shanahan.

### **WEEK 10 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15** **AT DALLAS - 1:25 P.M.**



- The 49ers own the overall series record against the Dallas Cowboys 21-19-1, including a 9-9-1 record on the road.
- The 49ers have won three of the last six regular season matchups against the Cowboys and two of the last four meetings on the road.
- The Niners look for their third-consecutive regular season victory against the Cowboys.
- San Francisco will travel to Dallas for a regular season matchup for the first time since the 2020 season and for the first time since the 49ers defeated the Cowboys 23-17 in the NFC Wild Card Round [at Dal. (1/16/22)].



### **WEEK 11 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 22** **VS. MINNESOTA (MEXICO CITY) 5:20 P.M.**



- The 49ers are 25-25-1 all-time against the Minnesota Vikings, including a 16-8-1 record at home.
- San Francisco will host Minnesota for the first time since the 2021 season [W, 34-26 vs. Min. (11/28/21)].
- The Niners look for their third-consecutive victory at home against the Vikings.
- The 49ers will face the Vikings on NBC's Sunday Night Football for the first time in series history.
- San Francisco has split each of the previous two primetime matchups against Minnesota.
- This matchup marks the third time in franchise history that the 49ers have played a regular season game in Mexico City's Estadio Banorte, where they hold a record of 1-1.



### **WEEK 12 - SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 29** **VS. SEATTLE - 1:25 P.M.**



- San Francisco holds a 12-15 record at home against the Seahawks.



### **WEEK 13 - SUNDAY, DECEMBER 6** **AT NEW YORK GIANTS - 10:00 A.M.**



- The 49ers own the overall series record against the New York Giants 23-21, with a 10-11 record on the road.
- San Francisco will travel to play the Giants on the road in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2014 and 2015 seasons [W, 34-24 at NYG (11/2/25)].
- The 49ers have won four of the last five matchups against the Giants, including three-straight, and look to earn their third-consecutive victory against the team at MetLife Stadium.



### **WEEK 14 - SUNDAY, DECEMBER 13** **VS. LOS ANGELES RAMS - 1:25 P.M.**



- The 49ers own a 38-37-2 record at home against the Rams.



### **WEEK 15 - THURSDAY, DECEMBER 17** **AT LOS ANGELES CHARGERS - 5:15 P.M.**



- The 49ers are 8-8 all-time against the Los Angeles Chargers, including a 3-5 record on the road.
- San Francisco will face the Chargers in the regular season for the first time since the 2022 season [W, 22-16 vs. LAC (11/13/22)].
- The Niners will face the Chargers on Thursday Night Football for the second time in series history and the first time since the 2010 season.



### **WEEK 16 - SUNDAY, DECEMBER 27** **AT KANSAS CITY - 1:25 P.M.**



- San Francisco is 7-10 all-time against the Kansas City Chiefs.
- The Niners will play on the road against the Chiefs for the first time since the 2018 season.



### **WEEK 17 - SUNDAY, JANUARY 3** **VS. PHILADELPHIA - 5:20 P.M.**



- San Francisco leads the all-time series 22-15-1 against the Philadelphia Eagles, with a 9-9 record at home.
- The 49ers will host the Eagles at Levi's Stadium for the first time since the 2020 season.
- San Francisco looks to win at home against Philadelphia for the first time since 2014 [W, 26-21 vs. Phi. (9/28/14)].



### **WEEK 18 - TBD** **AT ARIZONA - TBD**



- San Francisco owns a 17-16 record on the road against Arizona.
- The 49ers have won five of the last seven road games against the Cardinals.

## DRAFT CLASS OF 2026

The San Francisco 49ers added eight players this offseason through the 2026 NFL Draft. The team also signed nine undrafted rookie free agents to the roster.

### **WR DE'ZHAUN STRIBLING – 2ND ROUND (33RD OVERALL)**

- Originally a 2nd-round (33rd overall) draft choice by SF in 2026.
- Appeared in 56 games (55 starts) over 5 seasons at Mississippi (2025), Oklahoma State (2023-24) and Washington State (2021-22) and finished with 216 receptions for 2,964 yds. (13.7 avg.) and 23 TDs.
- In 2025 at Mississippi, started all 15 games he appeared in and recorded 55 receptions for 811 yds. (14.8 avg.) and 6 TDs.
- In 2024 at Oklahoma State, appeared in 12 games (11 starts) and tallied 52 receptions for 882 yds. (17.0 avg.) and 6 TDs.
- In 2023, appeared in 4 games (all starts) and recorded 14 receptions for 198 yds. (14.1 avg.) and 1 TD before redshirting.
- In 2022 at Washington State, started all 12 games he appeared in and tallied 51 receptions for 602 yds. (11.8 avg.) and 5 TDs.
- In 2021, started all 13 games he appeared in and recorded 44 receptions for 471 yds. (10.7 avg.) and 5 TDs, earning Honorable Mention All-Pac-12 honors.



### **DL ROMELLO HEIGHT – 3RD ROUND (70TH OVERALL)**

- Originally the first of two 3rd-round (70th overall) draft choices by SF in 2026.
- Appeared in 50 games (28 starts) over 6 seasons at Texas Tech (2025), Georgia Tech (2024), Southern California (2022-23) and Auburn (2020-21) and finished with 111 tackles, 26.5 TFLs, 16.0 sacks, 4 FFs, 2 PDs and 1 INT.
- In 2025 at Texas Tech, started all 14 games he appeared in and tallied 38 tackles, 11.0 TFLs, 9.5 sacks, 2 FFs and 1 PD, earning First-Team All-Big 12 honors.
- In 2024 at Georgia Tech, appeared in 12 games (all starts) and recorded 34 tackles, 6.5 TFLs, 2.5 sacks, 2 FFs, 1 PD and 1 INT.
- In 2023 at Southern California, appeared in 12 games and tallied 20 tackles, 6.0 TFLs and 4.0 sacks.
- In 2022, started in 2 games. In 2021 at Auburn, appeared in 9 games and recorded 19 tackles and 3.0 TFLs.
- Redshirted in 2020 after appearing in 1 game.



### **RB KAELOH BLACK – 3RD ROUND (90TH OVERALL)**

- Originally the second of two third-round (90th overall) draft choices by SF in 2026.
- Appeared in 56 games (16 starts) over 6 seasons at Indiana (2024-25) and James Madison (2020-23) and registered 496 carries for 2,595 yds. and 17 TDs on the ground to go along with 55 receptions for 528 yds. and 6 TDs through the air.
- In 2025 at Indiana, appeared in all 16 games and tallied 187 carries for 1,039 yds. and 10 TDs while adding 4 receptions for 36 yds. through the air.
- In 2024, appeared in all 13 games and recorded 46 carries for 251 yds. and 2 TDs on the ground to go along with 4 receptions for 6 yds. through the air.
- In 2023 at James Madison, appeared in 13 games (12 starts) and tallied 142 carries for 637 yds. and 1 TD with 27 receptions for 254 yds. and 4 TDs through the air.
- In 2022, appeared in 9 games (1 start) and recorded 69 carries for 333 yds. and 3 TDs on the ground to go along with 17 receptions for 177 yds. and 2 TDs through the air.

- Redshirted in 2021.





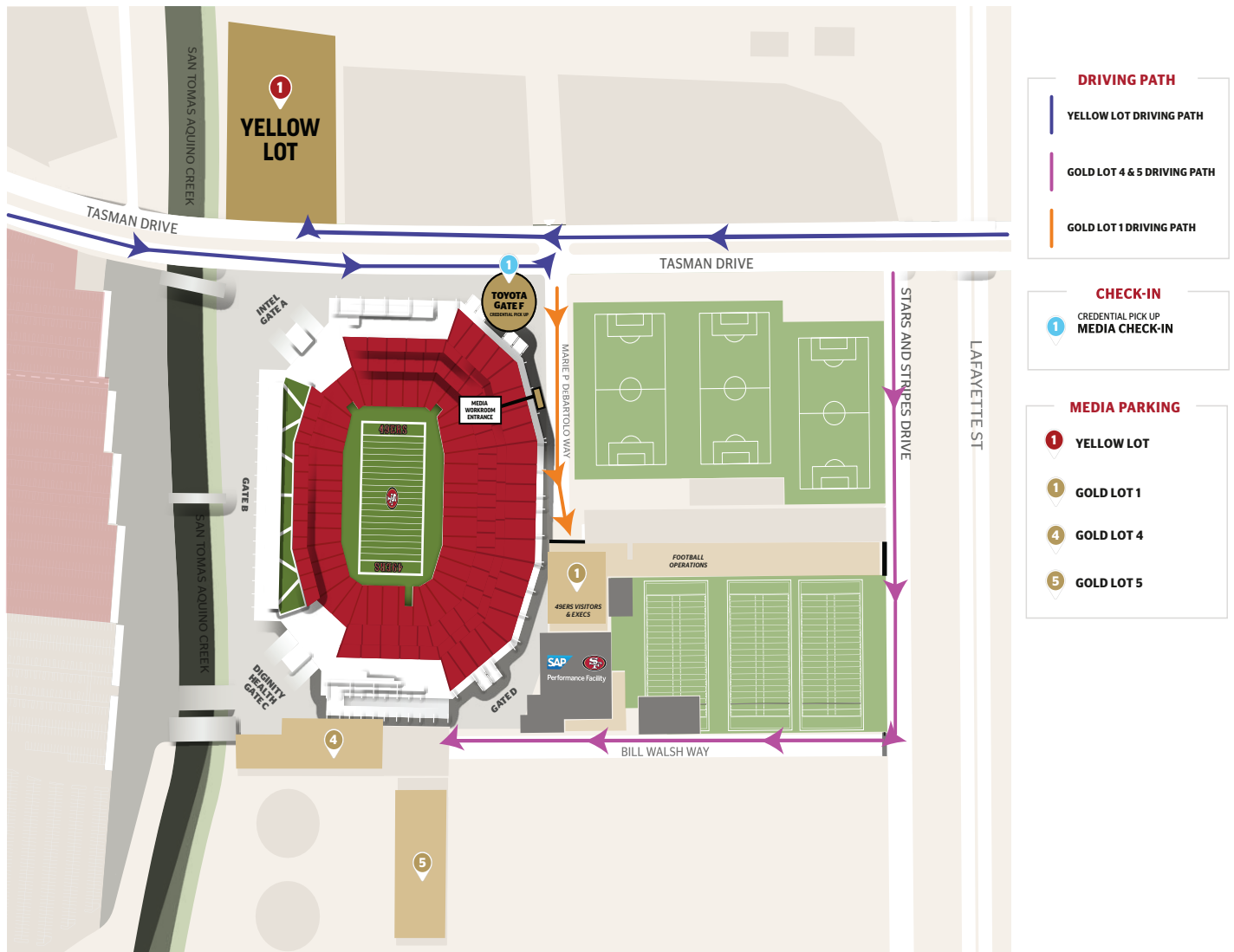
